

PREFACE

In response to the request of the Government of the Republic of Rwanda, the Japanese Government decided to conduct a feasibility study on the Rural Water Supply Project in the Eastern Region (Kibungo Prefecture) of Rwanda, excluding the Akagera National Park and two cities of Kibungo and Rwamagana.

The study was entrusted to the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) which sent to Rwanda a study team led by Hiroatsu NARITA of Chuo Kaihatsu Corporation. Based on the Preliminary survey made in two stage in 1983, the team carried out surveys from October 1984 to March 1985, and from May 1985 to November 1985.
