

- (1) Japanese Technical Cooperation Schemes (Colombo Plan, etc.)
- (2) The Japan Overseas Cooperation Volunteers Program commenced in 1965.
- B. The Technical Cooperation Schemes partly financed by Japanese Government.
- (1) Honour Countries Independent Founding Scheme (The G.G. Base Plan)
- (2) Technical Cooperation Schemes by the United Nations (U. N. Plants; including IAEA (Type 1), program and F.A.O. etc.) (Note : Japan started to take part in U.N. scheme in 1954.)
- (3) Others
- The Japan U.S. Third Country Training Program; started in 1954 (completed on 31st March, 1965)

Indonesian Reparation Program; stated in 1960.(completed on 31st March, 1968) .

Apart from the above-mentioned schemes, Japan is extending such Technical Cooperation under the reparation agreement to Philippines and other countries as listed below: Philippines Reparation Program; started in 1963. Agreement between the Government of Japan and the Government of Royal Cambodge for Economic and Technical Cooperation; in 1959. The Agreement on the Settlement of Problem Concerning Property and Claims and on the Economic Cooperation between the Republic of Korea and Japan; started in 1967. (claim Fund) Recommendation of Technical Experts requested by Developing Countries (Others); started in 1965.




