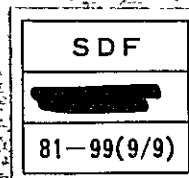
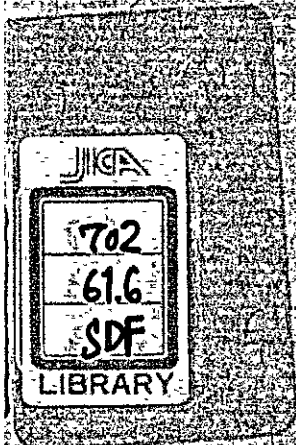

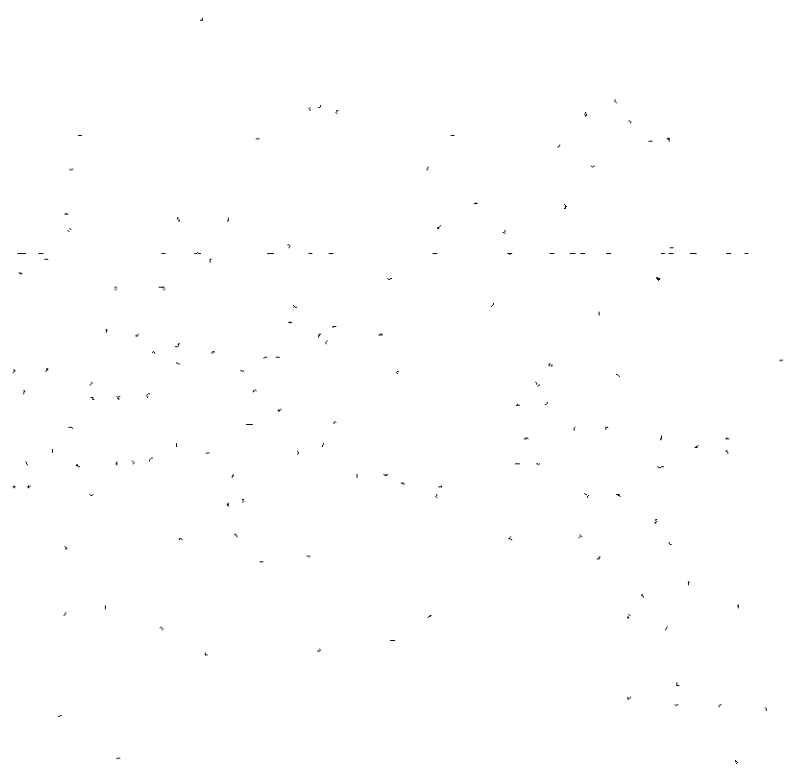

THIS AGREEMENT made the _____ day of _____ 19__

WHEREAS the Employer is desirous that certain Works should be executed, viz. _____
_____ and has accepted a Tender by the Contractor
for the execution completion and maintenance of such Works.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows: —

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively
assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.

2. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this
Agreement, viz.: —

- (a) The Said Tender
- (b) The Instructions to Bidders
- (c) General Conditions of Contract
- (d) General, Technical and Special Specifications
- (e) The Priced Bill of Estimated Quantities and Amount for Tendering
- (f) Drawings
- (g) The Schedule of Rates and Prices
- (h) The Letter of Acceptance

3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Employer to the Contractor as here-
inafter mentioned the Contractor hereby convenants with the Employer to execute complete and main-
tain the Works in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.

4. The Employer hereby convenants to pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution
completion and maintenance of the Works the Contract Price at the times and in the manner prescribed
by the Contract.

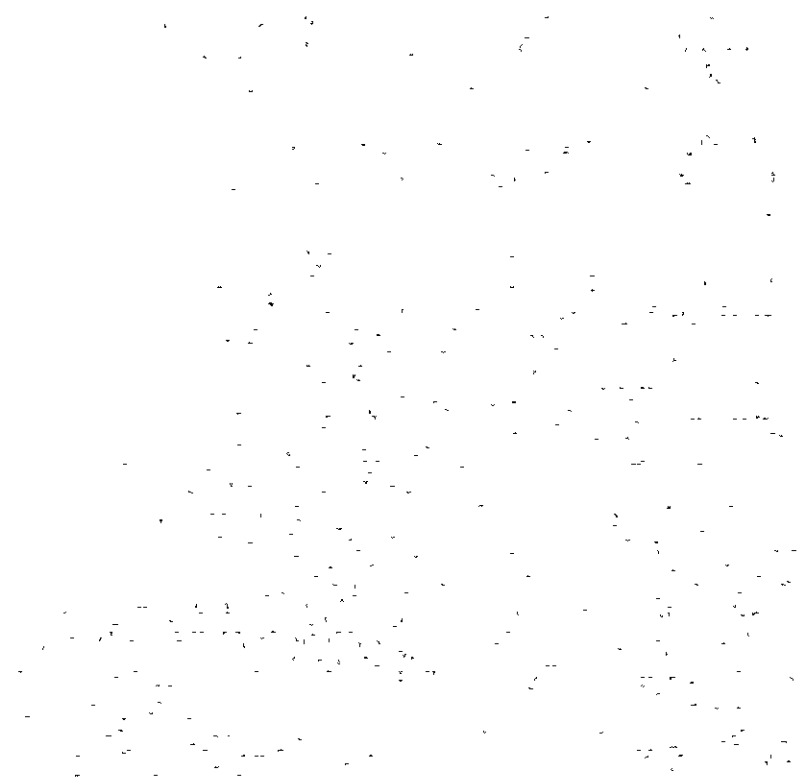
