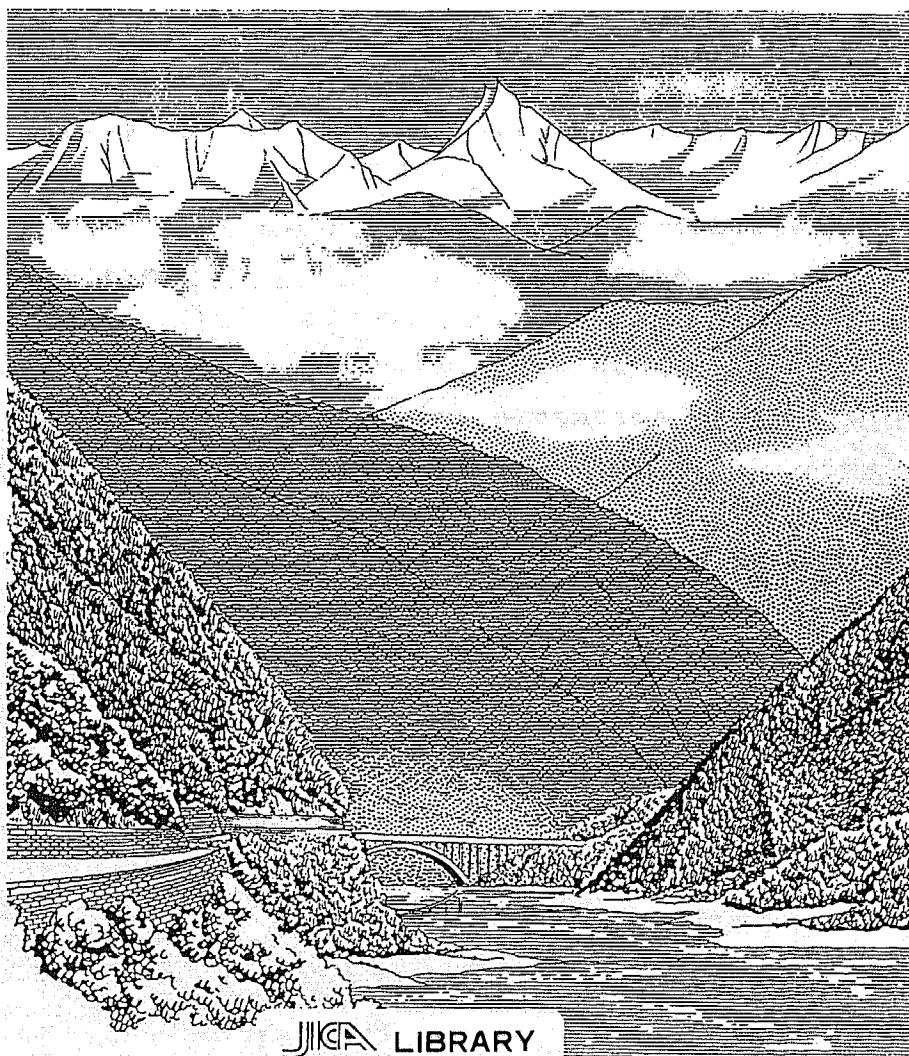


The team exchanged views with the officials concerned of His Majesty's Government of Nepal about the Project and conducted a field survey in the project site in Nepal.

I wish to express my deep appreciation to the officials concerned of His Majesty's Government of Nepal for their close cooperation extended to the study team.

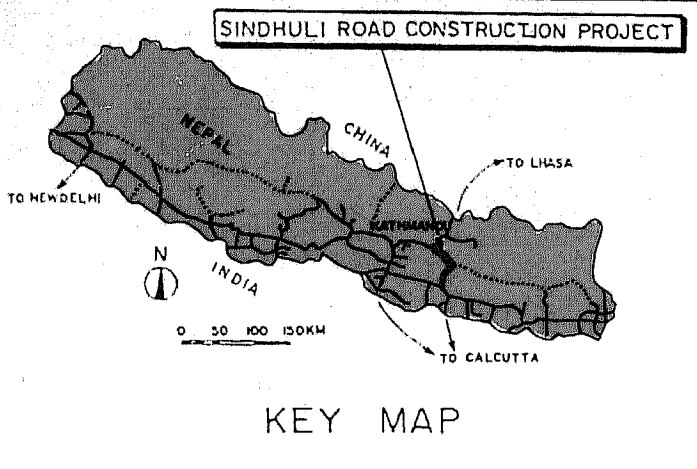
