

IN THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI

In response to the request of the Government of the Republic of Fiji, the Government of Japan decided to conduct a Basic Design Study on the Project for the Redevelopment of the Fiji School of Medicine and the Colonial War Memorial Hospital ( the Project ) and entrusted the study to the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). JICA sent a Study Team ( the Team ) headed by Dr. ATSUAKI GUNJI, Director of the Department of Public Health Administration, the Institute of Public Health, Ministry of Health and Welfare to the Republic of Fiji from April 9 to May 8, 1990.

The Team held a series of discussions on the Project with the officials concerned of the Government of Fiji and conducted a field survey in the Project site.

As a result of study, both parties agreed to recommend to their respective Governments that the major points of understanding reached between them, as attached herewith, should be examined towards the realization of the Project.

## ATTACHMENT

### 1. OBJECTIVE

In order to promote the WHO objective "HEALTH FOR ALL 2000", the Regional Committee for the Western Pacific passed the resolution for "Reorientation of Health Personnel" on 15th of September, 1988.

According to the resolution, the Western Pacific Regional Office of WHO held a series of meeting and crystallized "the Plan for Action for the development of the Fiji School of Medicine as a centre for education of health personnel in the South Pacific region".

The Government of Fiji is taking a positive role in this region by strengthening educational functions of the Fiji School of Medicine. The objective of the Project intends to contribute to this plan by improving and renovating clinical functions and teaching facilities of the Colonial War Memorial Hospital/the Fiji School of Medicine complex for health development in Fiji and its regional neighbours.

### 2. PROJECT SITE

The Project site is at Extension Street, Suva, the Republic of Fiji, as shown in ANNEX I.

### 3. EXECUTING AGENCY

The Ministry of Health, the Government of Fiji shall be responsible for the management and operation of the Project.

#### 7. UNDERTAKING OF THE GOVERNMENT OF FIJI

The Government of Fiji will take necessary measures listed in ANNEX II, as proposed by the Team on the condition that the Japan's Grant Aid would be extended to the Project.

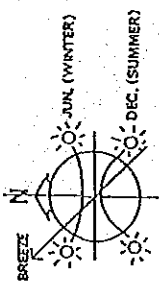
TITLE : SITE PLAN

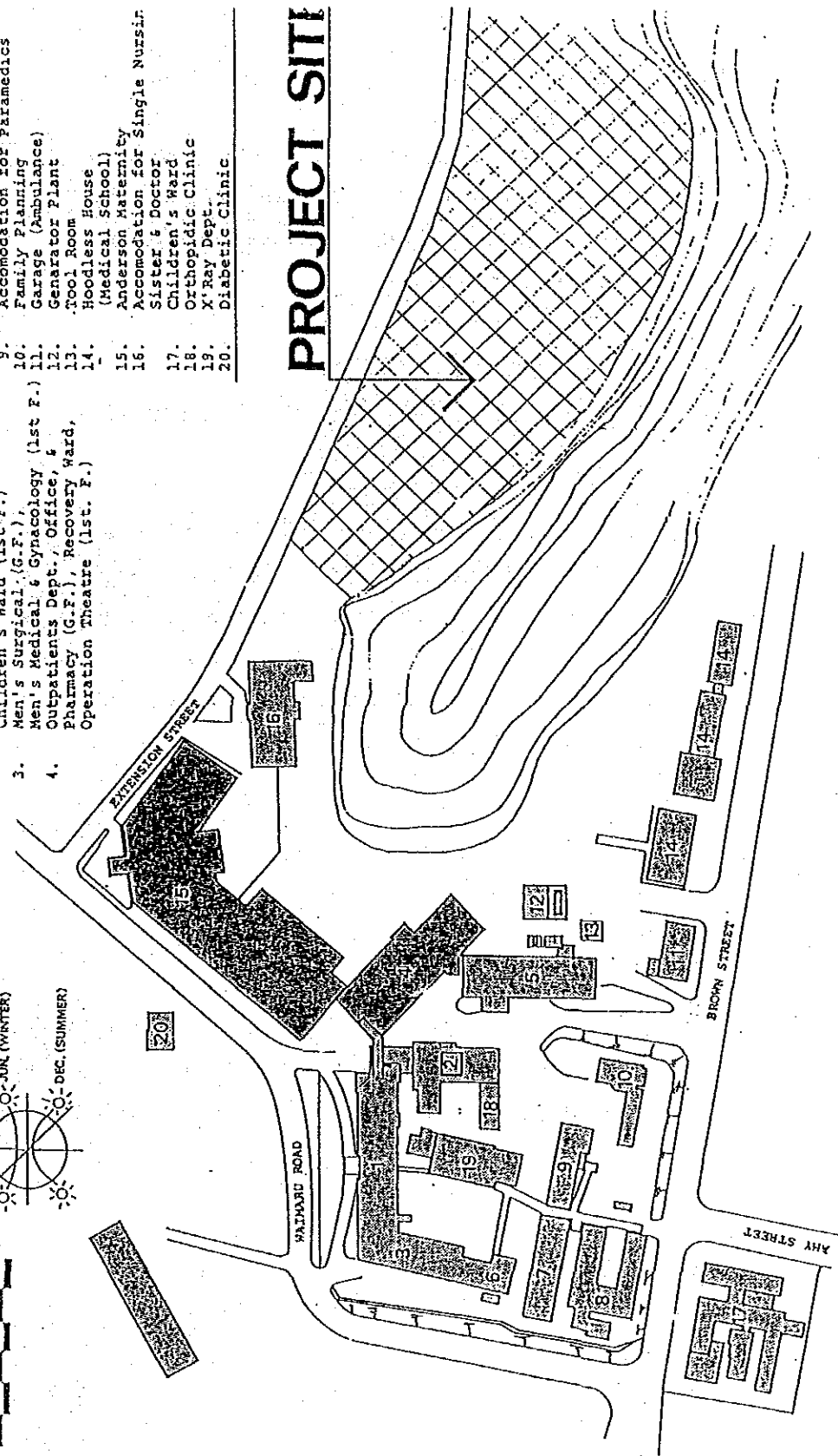

ANNEX II

1. To secure the land for the Project and to clear, level and reclaim the project site when needed;
2. To provide facilities for the distribution of electricity, water supply, drainage, gas supply, telephone system and other incidental facilities to the project site;
3. To ensure necessary budget and personnel for proper and effective operation and maintenance of facilities and equipment provided under the Project;
4. To exempt import duties and incidental expenses which may be imposed in Fiji and to take necessary measures for customs clearance of the products brought in for the implementation of the Project;
5. To assume commissions the Japanese foreign exchange bank for banking services based on the banking arrangement;
6. To accord Japanese nationals whose services may be required in connection with the supply of products and services under the verified contracts, such facilities as may be necessary for their entry into and stay in Fiji for the performance of their work;
7. To exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and other fiscal levies which may be imposed in Fiji with respect to the supply of products and services under the verified contracts;  
and
8. To bear all the expenses, other than those to be borne by the Grant Aid, necessary for the implementation of the Project.




In the response to the request made by the Government of the Republic of Fiji, the Government of Japan decided to conduct a Basic Design Study on the Project for the Redevelopment of the Fiji School of Medicine and the Colonial War Memorial Hospital ( hereinafter referred to as "the Project " ) and entrusted the study to the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). JICA sent to the Republic of Fiji the study team from April 9 to May 8, 1990.

As the result of the survey and discussions, JICA prepared a Draft Final Report on the study and dispatched the second mission headed by Dr. Atsuaki Gunji, Director, Department of Public Health Administration, the National Institute of Public Health, Ministry of Health and Welfare, to explain and discuss it from July 3 to 10, 1990.

Both parties had a series of discussions on the Report and have agreed to recommend to their respective Governments that the major points of understanding reached between them, attached herewith, should be examined towards the realization of the Project.

1. The Government of the Republic of Fiji has agreed in principle to the basic design proposed in the Draft Final Report. The appropriate alterations including the following items agreed by both sides in the course of discussions will be incorporated in the Final Report.

2. The Government of Fiji agreed that the Central Medical Library will be established in the existing building of the Organ Imaging Dept. of the CWM Hospital by remodelling its interior.

3. The Team will convey to the Japanese Government the strong request of the Government of Fiji to include a C.T. Scanner in the Project.

4. The WHO representative for the South Pacific has participated in the series of discussions on the Project and expressed that the WHO will make efforts to support the development of the FSM and the Teaching Hospital by coordinating international efforts, according to "the Plan for Action for the development of the Fiji School of Medicine".
