MINUTES OF MEETING
BETWEEN THE JAPANESE IMPLEMENTATION SURVEY TEAM
AND THE AUTHORITIES CONCERNED OF
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN
ON THE JAPANESE PROJECT-TYPE TECHNICAL COOPERATION
FOR THE PROJECT ON
GEOSCIENCE LABORATORY IN THE GEOLOGICAL SURVEY OF PAKISTAN

The Japanese Implementation Survey Team, headed by Dr. Kenji Tomita, Special Technical Advisor of JICA, visited the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Islamabad from March 21 to March 27, 1990 for the purpose of completing and signing the Record of Discussions, Tentative Schedule of Implementation and Technical Cooperation Program.

The Minutes of Meeting is intended to record the understandings reached between both sides concerning some of the provisions in the Record of Discussions.

1. The Pakistani side agreed that, through the normal procedures under the Colombo Plan Technical Cooperation Scheme, it would submit the following document for 1990 fiscal year to the Japanese side.

(1) A-1 Form for the Japanese long-term experts (Chief Advisor and Coordinator) will be submitted by the end of June in 1990.

(2) As for the equipment to be requested for 1990 fiscal year, A-4 Form will be submitted by the end of June in 1990.


(3) As for counterpart training in Japan for 1990 fiscal year, A-2 and A-3 Form for 2 persons (one for Electron Probe Microanalysis, one for X-Ray Fluorescence Analysis) will be submitted by the end of June in 1990.

2. The Pakistani side agreed that it will inform JICA Pakistan Office of the number and names of the counterpart personnel by the end of September in 1990.

3. The Pakistani side agreed that it will provide suitable office space for the Japanese experts (Chief Advisor and Coordinator) by the end of September in 1990.

4. The Japanese side expressed that the equipment for field survey as listed in Annex I will be considered on the condition that necessary budget will be allocated by the Government of Japan.


