1. The Objectives of the Project

- (2) The Government of the Sudan will take the neccesary measures described in Annex [] for smooth implementation of the Project on condition that the Grant Aid Assistance by the Government of Japan is extended to the Project.

7. Operation and Maintenance Plan

The Government of the Sudan will establish an operation and maintenance plan as:

- Ministry of Health and Central Medical Supplies will be responsible for operation and maintenance of medical equipment for the Project.
- (2) The responsibility of operation of ambulance will be met by the Ministry of Health and maintenance thereof will be met by the Mechanical Transportation Department of Ministry of Transport and Communication.


