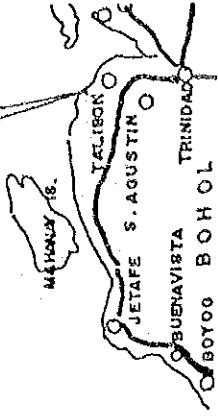
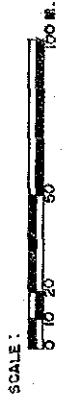
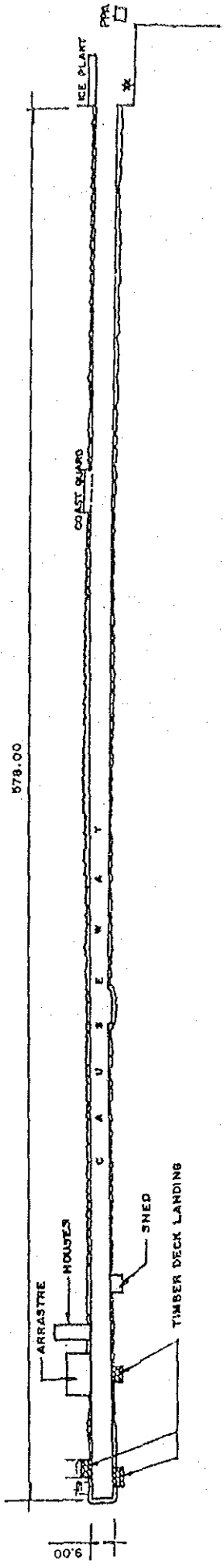

VICINITY MAP



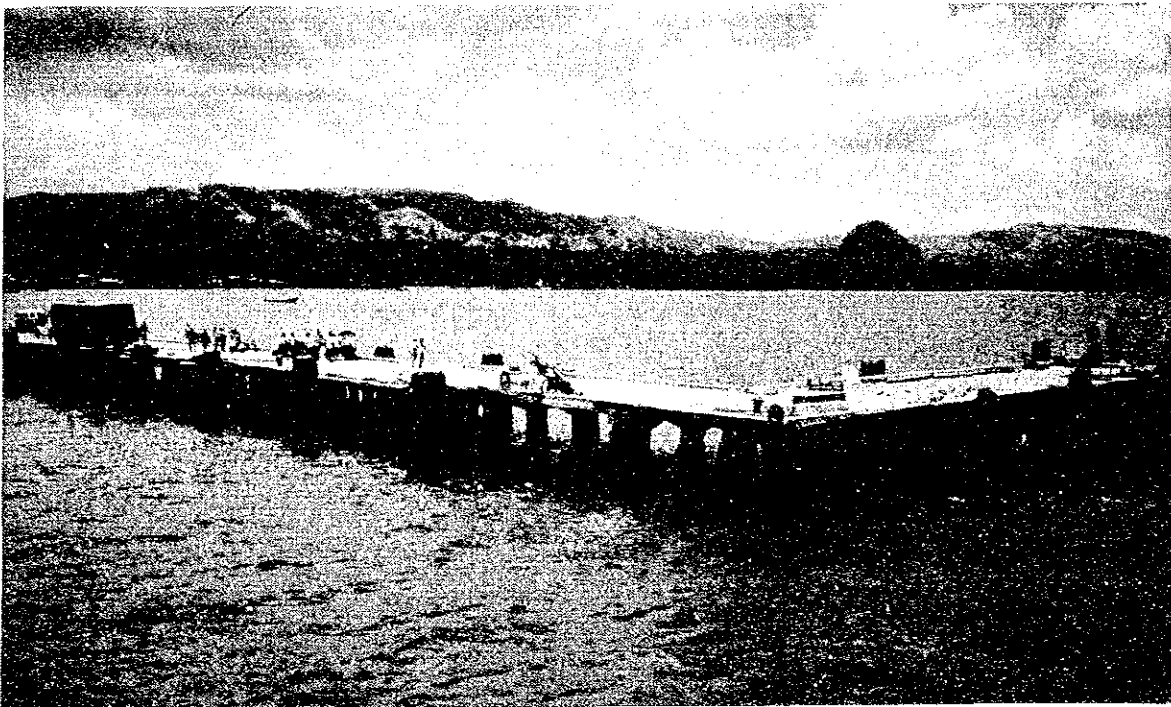
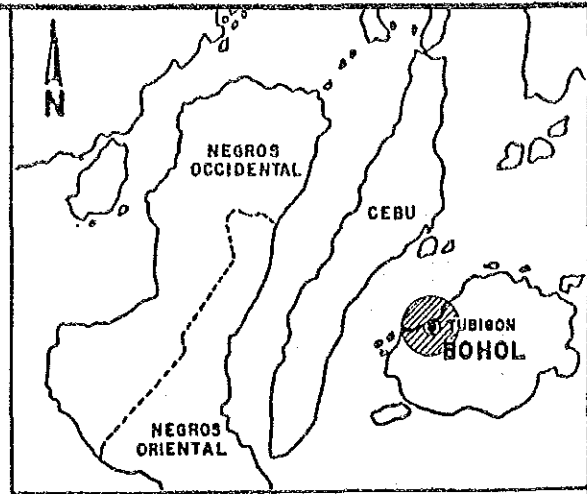

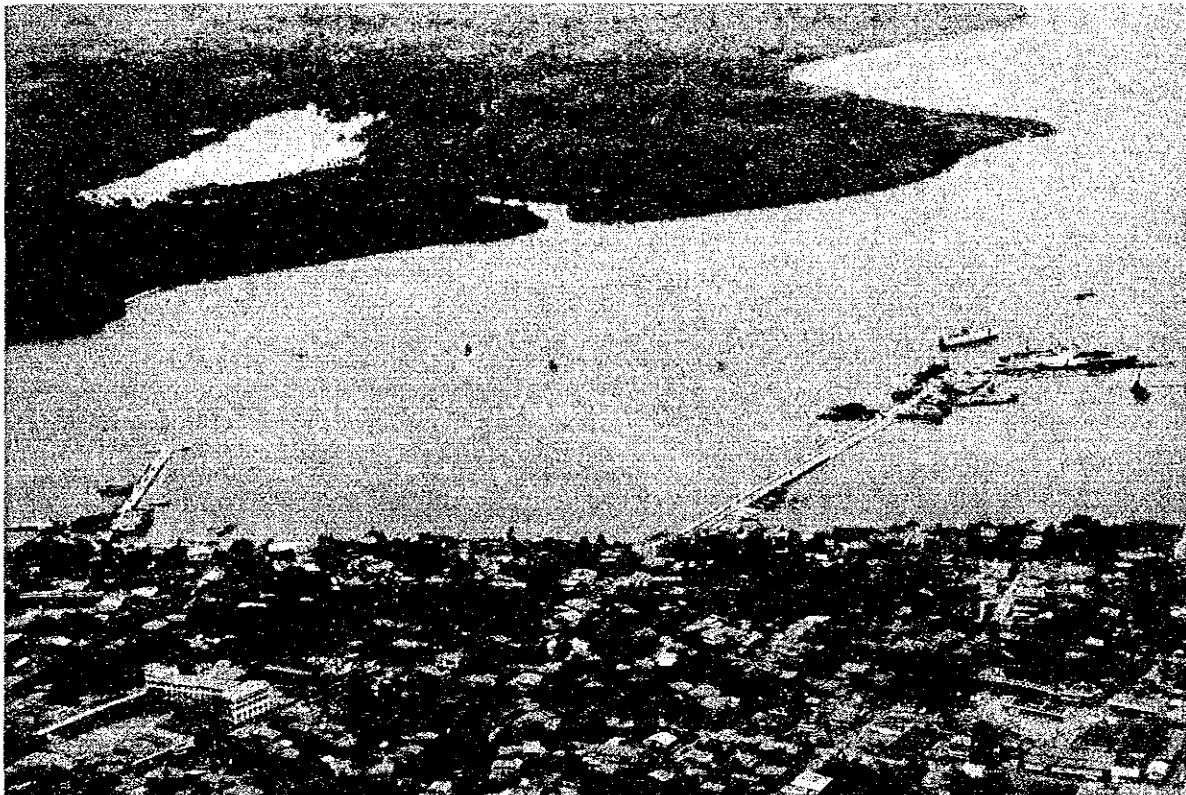
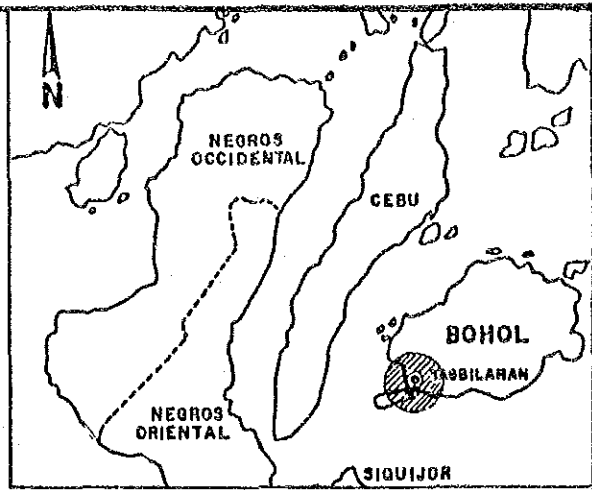
GENERAL PLAN PORT OF CATAGBACAN LOON, BOHOL

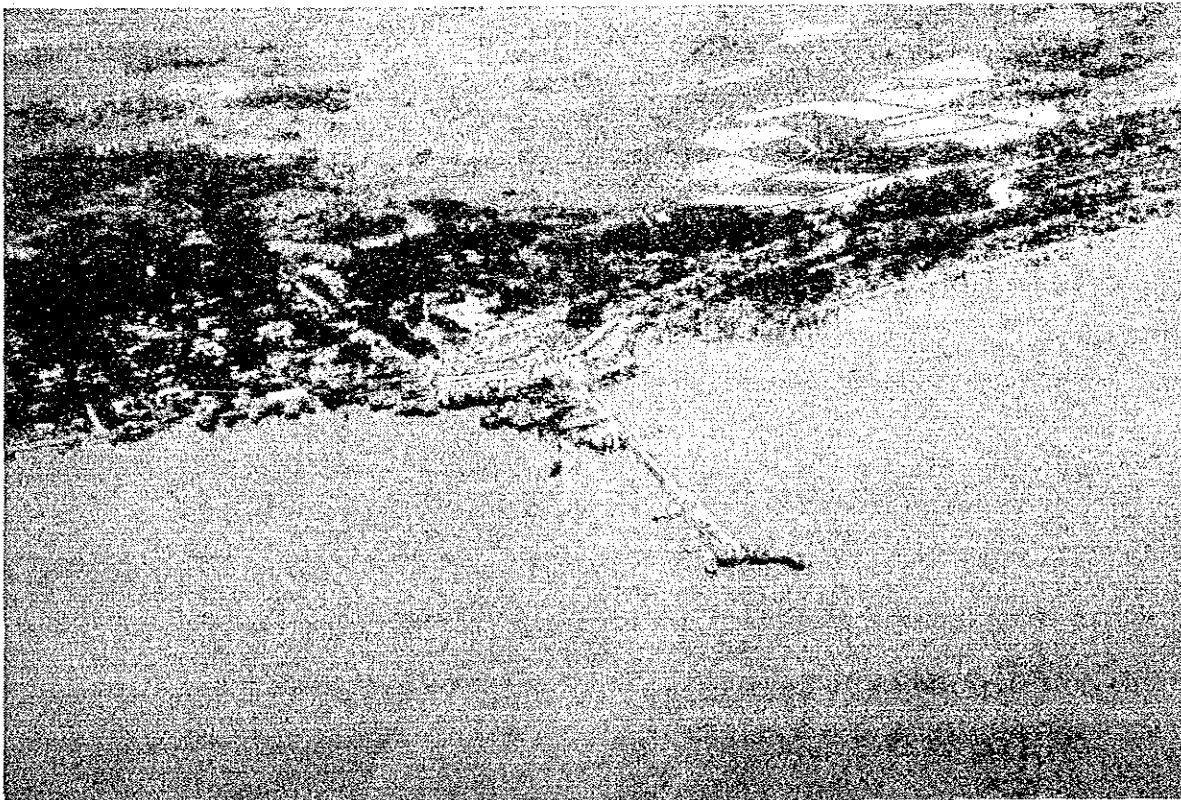
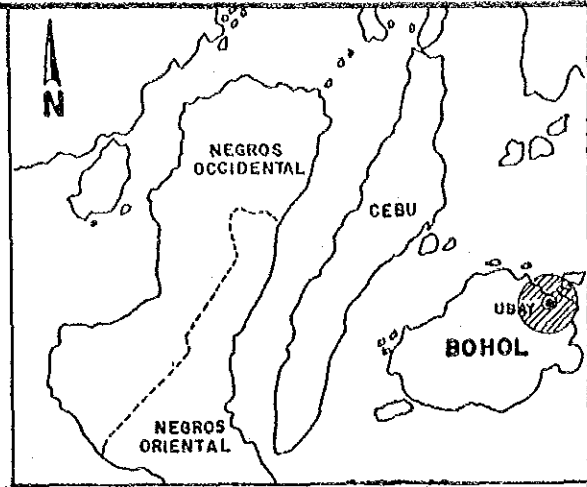


GENERAL PLAN PORT OF JAGNA JAGNA, BOHOL
