MINUTES OF DISCUSSIONS
ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
KING MONGKUT'S INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY LADKRABANG
AND
JOMO KENYATTA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY

Based on the Memorandum of Understanding on Academic Cooperation between King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang and Jomo Kenyatta University College of Agriculture and Technology signed on March 26, 1991, the two institutions have arrived at the following agreements for the first phase of their exchange programme for the period 1992-1996:

1. Exchange of information and publications;
2. Exchange of delegations for reviewing of the exchange programme and presenting a special lecture;
3. Exchange of staff for the promotion of education and research in both institutions involving at least one person a year bilaterally, with a maximum duration of three months per person. The members of KMITL and JKUCAT will be responsible for carrying out any combination of teaching, individual training and identifying feasible areas of research for the benefit of both institutions;
4. Training of JKUCAT staff at KMITL according to the following arrangements:
 - 4.1 Not more than three persons to be admitted into the master's degree programmes annually;
 - 4.2 Not more than two persons to be admitted into the doctorate programmes annually;
5. Joint research in the fields of common interest to both institutions in order to foster educational and academic activities;
6. Both institutions will make all possible efforts to implement this exchange programme.

The fields of common interest are given in Attachment 1 and the tentative schedule of the exchange programme for the period 1992-1996 in Attachment 2. Attachment 3 lists the names of the authorities from both institutions who participated in the discussions on November 13, 1991.

This Minutes of Discussions on Academic Cooperation is drawn on November 14, 1991.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
KING MONGKUT'S INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY LADKRABANG
AND
JOMO KENYATTA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL) of Thailand and Jomo Kenyatta University College of Agriculture and Technology (JKUCAT) of Kenya recognise the following common characteristics:

1. both KMITL and JKUCAT are universities which have educational and research programmes in the fields of
 Engineering
 Science
 Agriculture
and Architecture;
2. both KMITL and JKUCAT were established with cooperation from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) of Japan, KMITL in 1960 and JKUCAT in 1977;
3. both KMITL and JKUCAT are in the stage of development with experiences that can be exchanged for mutual benefit in accelerating their development.

With the above recognition, KMITL and JKUCAT hereby agree to have cooperation in the following areas:

1. exchange of staff for sharing of experiences in academic development as well as in administration;
