

- 2) Construction of produce storage,
- 3) Development of rural marketing facilities (Pola),
- 4) Strengthening of Central Artificial Insemination Centre, and
- 5) Strengthening of District Level Veterinary Surgeon Station.

The above supporting plan would be inaugurated as new projects and completed during the period of the Master Plan. The executing agencies for 1) and 2) is Department of Agrarian Services, and for 4) and 5) is Department of Animal Production and Health, and for 3) is the Pradesiya Sabha.

(6) Farm Land Conservation

The farm land conservation project under this Master Plan are of 13,500 ha. The area covered by the project accounts only 21% of the total required area amounting 323,500 ha. Several farm land conservation projects have been executed as pilot schemes in the Study area, but the extent developed are insignificant. The total required area is quite large and would take a longer period beyond the planning period to complete implementation.

As for farm land conservation projects, it is recommended that the National Agricultural Diversity and Settlement Authority (NADSA) would be the executing agency.

6.4 Implementation Period

The Master Plan period is 10 years from 1994 to 2003. The period of 10 years is divided into Phase I from 1994 to 1998 and Phase II from 1999 to 2003.

The implementation programme of the Master Plan, is shown in Fig. 6.4-1 taking account on-going and scheduled project into the plan.

6.5 Implementation Cost

(1) Estimate Conditions

The project cost is estimated subject to the following condition;

- 1) The cost is based on the survey result during the filed survey from February to May, 1993.
- 2) The following exchange rates are used:

$$\text{US 1.00} = \text{Rs. 46.73} = \text{J. Yen 115.0}$$

$$\text{Rs. 1.00} = \text{J. Yen 2.46}$$
- 3) The project cost does not include contingencies, land acquisition costs and crop compensation costs, engineering and administration costs, and operation and maintenance costs.

(2) Implementation Cost

The total amount of the implementation cost is estimated at Rs. 15,317.4 Million with Rs. 7,977.2 Million in Phase I and Rs. 7,340.2 Million in Phase II. The cost for the respective components are shown in Table 6.5-1.

Since the amount of implementation cost of on-going and scheduled projects is Rs. 6,784.4 Million, the remaining implementation cost amounting to Rs. 8,533.0 Million is required through further financial arrangement.

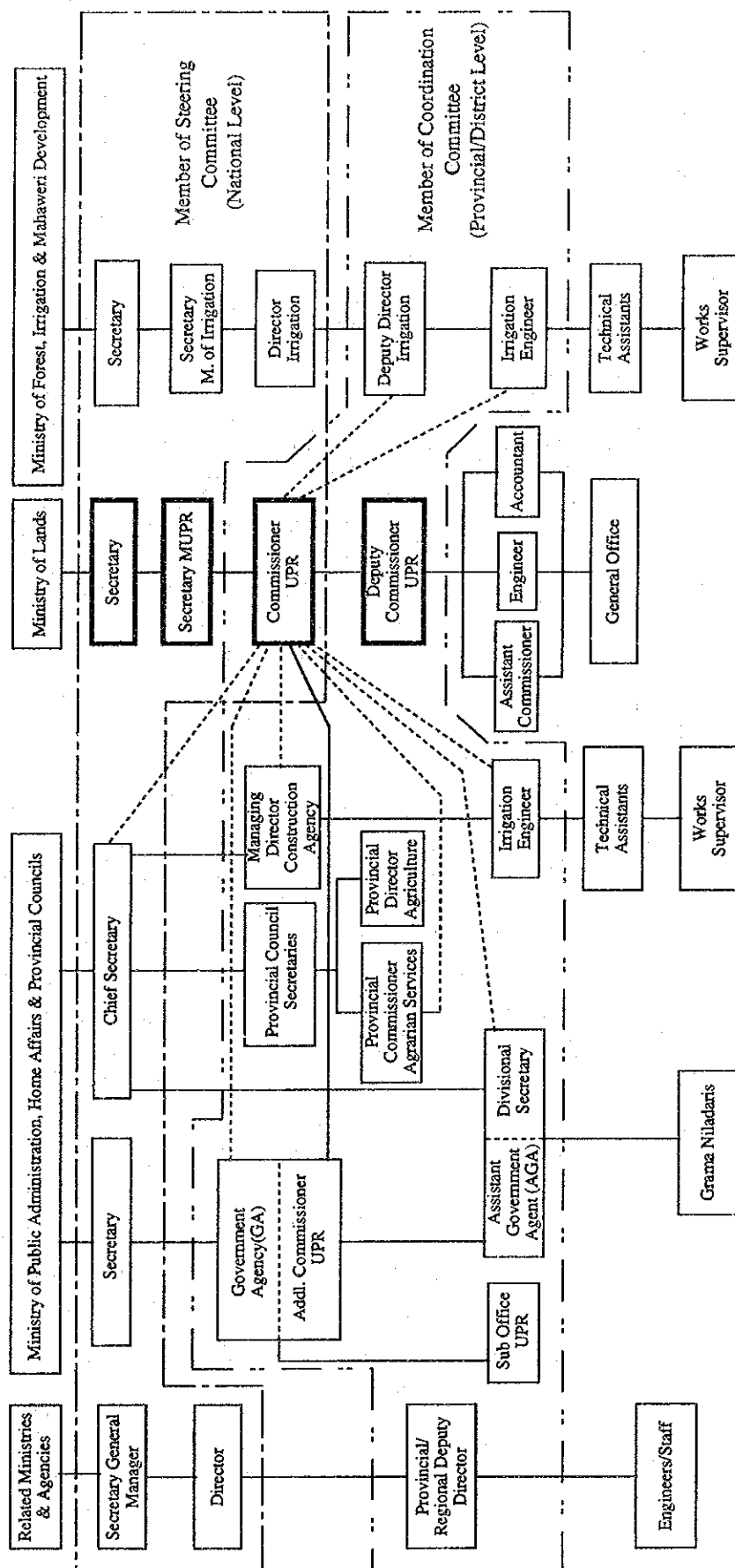


Fig. 6.2-1 PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION SYSTEM(DUPR RELATIVE MINISTRIES & AGENCIES AND COMMITTEES)

Fig. 6.4-1 IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE FOR MASTER PLAN





I. INTRODUCTION

In response to the request of the Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka (hereinafter referred to as "the Government"), the Government of Japan has decided to conduct the master plan study on the Agricultural and Rural Development for Up-country Peasantry Rehabilitation programme (hereinafter referred to as "the Study") in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations in force in Japan.

Accordingly, the Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter referred to as "JICA"), the official agency responsible for the implementation of the technical cooperation programmes of the Government of Japan, will undertake the Study in close cooperation with the authorities concerned of Sri Lanka.

The present document sets forth the Scope of Work with regard to the Study.

II. OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY

The objectives of the Study are:

1. to formulate a master plan on the agricultural and rural development for Up-country Peasantry Rehabilitation Programme, and
2. to carry out technology transfer to the Sri Lanka counterpart personnel in the course of the Study.

III. STUDY AREA

The study area is to cover Central Province, Uva Province and Sabaragamuwa Province (approximately 19,000km²).

IV. SCOPE OF THE STUDY

In order to achieve the above objectives, the Study will cover the following items:

1. to collect and review existing data and information and to carry out field survey and investigation in the study area,
 - natural condition (meteorology and hydrology, geology, soil, topography etc.)
 - social and economic conditions (population, number of farmers' household, social structure, etc.)
 - agriculture (land use and tenure, cropping pattern, crop yielding, agricultural support services, and organizations for farming, etc.)
 - agricultural and rural infrastructure (irrigation and drainage facility, agricultural rural road, rural water supply facility etc.)
 - others

2. to carry out inventory survey on existing projects under being planned and implemented
 - structuring data base (irrigation, agricultural rural road, water supply, agricultural training center, marketing center and processing facilities for agricultural products, environmental protection projects, etc.)
 - review of necessity and component of each project
 - modification of each project and proposing new necessary project
 - others
3. to carry out farmer's household survey
4. to formulate a master plan on the agricultural and rural development for the Up-country Peasantry Rehabilitation Programme as follows;
 - land and water resources development plan,
 - agriculture and rural infrastructure development plan,
 - agriculture support plan,
 - environmental preservation and management plan, and
 - implementing plan

The plan components consist of;

- irrigation,
 - agricultural rural road,
 - rural water supply,
 - electrification, -
 - agricultural and animal husbandry production,
 - agricultural supporting services (marketing, extension, training, etc), and
 - agricultural land degradation (soil conservation, land slide).
5. to formulate a guideline for promoting;
 - agriculture and rural infrastructure development plan,
 - agriculture support plan, and
 - environmental preservation and management plan, andto carry out case studies (maximum three numbers), following the guideline.


V. STUDY SCHEDULE

The study will be carried out in accordance with the tentative schedule attached in Annex.

JICA shall prepare and submit following reports in English to the Government of Sri Lanka.



Twenty (20) copies at the end of the first home office work in Japan.
4. Progress report (2)
Twenty (20) copies at the end of the second field survey in Sri Lanka.
5. Draft Final Report
Twenty (20) copies at the end of the second home office work in Japan. The Government of Sri Lanka shall provide JICA with its comments on the Draft Final Report within one (1) month after receiving the Draft Final Report.
6. Final Report
One hundred (100) copies within two (2) months after receiving the comments on the Draft Final Report.

VII. UNDERTAKING OF THE GOVERNMENT OF SRI LANKA

1. To facilitate smooth conduct of the Study, the Government of Sri Lanka shall take necessary measures;
 - (1) to secure the safety of the Japanese study team,
 - (2) to permit the members of the Japanese study team to enter, leave and sojourn in Sri Lanka for the duration of their assignment therein, and exempt them from foreign registration requirements and consular fees,
 - (3) to exempt the members of the Japanese study team from taxes, duties, fees and any other charges on equipment, machinery and other materials brought into Sri Lanka for the conduct of the study,
 - (4) to exempt the members of the Japanese study team from income tax and charges of any kind imposed on or in connection with any emoluments or allowances paid to the members of the Japanese study team for their services in connection with the implementation of the Study,
 - (5) to provide necessary facilities to the Japanese study team for remittance as well as utilization of the funds introduced into Sri Lanka from Japan in connection with the implementation of the Study,
 - (6) to secure permission for entry into private properties or restricted areas for the implementation of the Study,
 - (7) to secure permission for the Japanese study team to take all data and documents related to the Study including photographs and maps out of Sri Lanka to Japan,
 - (8) to provide medical services as needed. Its expense will be chargeable on the members of the Japanese study team.



2. The Government of Sri Lanka shall bear claims, if any arises, against the members of the Japanese study team resulting from, occurring in the course of, or otherwise connected with, the discharge of their duties in the implementation of the Study, except when such claims arise from gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the members of the Japanese study team.
3. The Ministry of Lands, Irrigation and Mahaweli Development (hereinafter referred to as "MLIMD") shall act as counterpart agency to the Japanese study team and also as coordinating body in relation with other governmental and non-governmental organizations concerned for the smooth implementation of the Study.
4. MLIMD shall, at its own expense, provide the Japanese study team with the following, in cooperation with other organizations concerned:
 - (1) available data and information related to the Study,
 - (2) counterpart personnel,
 - (3) suitable office space with necessary equipments in Colombo and project sites,
 - (4) credentials or identification cards,

VIII. UNDERTAKING OF JICA


For the implementation of the Study, JICA shall take the following measures:

1. To dispatch, at its own expense, study teams to Sri Lanka,
2. To pursue technology transfer to the Sri Lanka counterpart personnel in the course of the Study.

IX. CONSULTATION

JICA and MLIMD will consult with each other in respect of any matter that is not agreed upon in this document and may arise from or in connection with the Study.

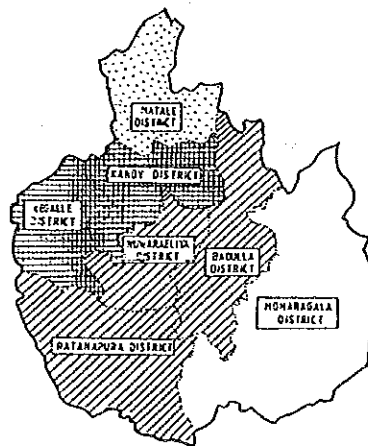

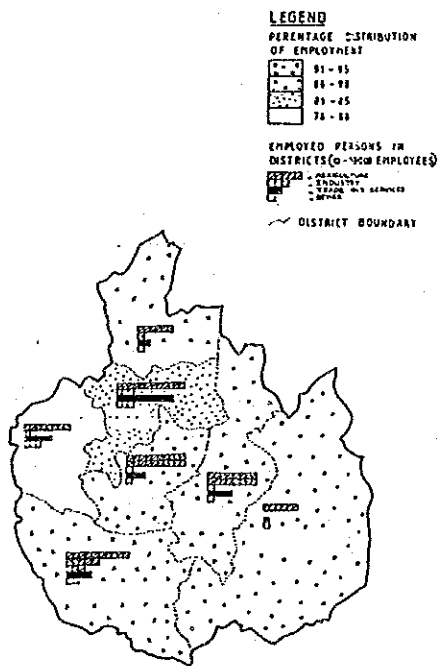
Fig. Condition of the Project Area (1981 census) 1/2



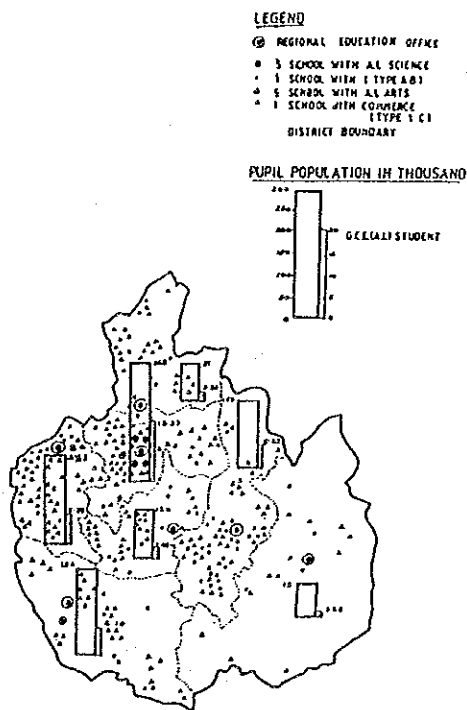
Population Distribution

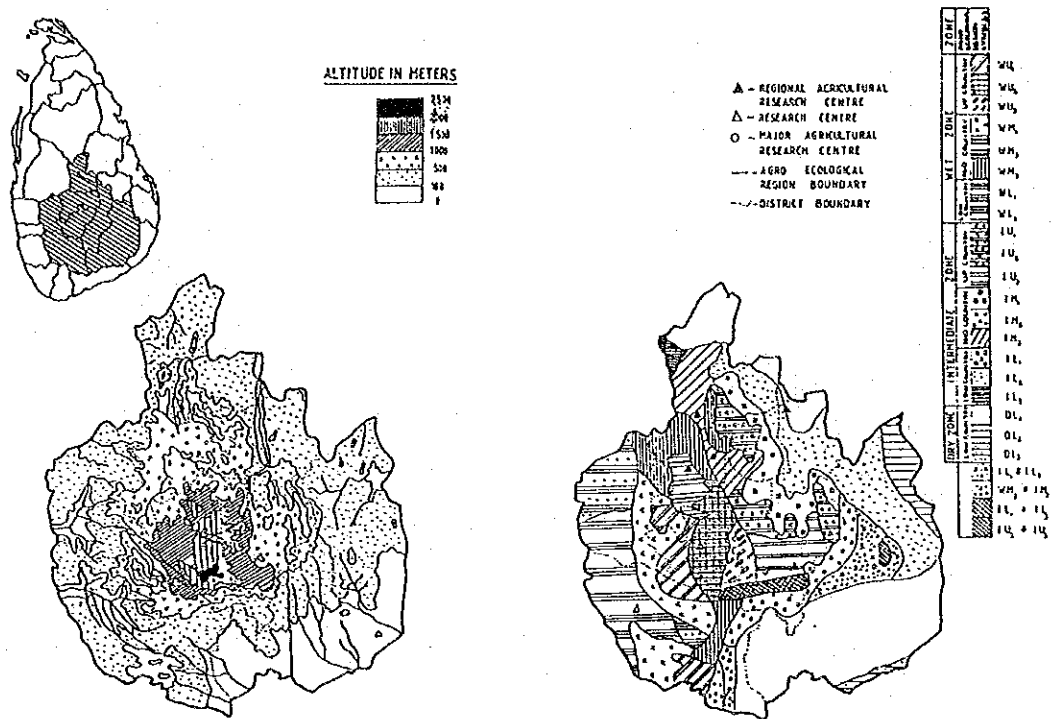

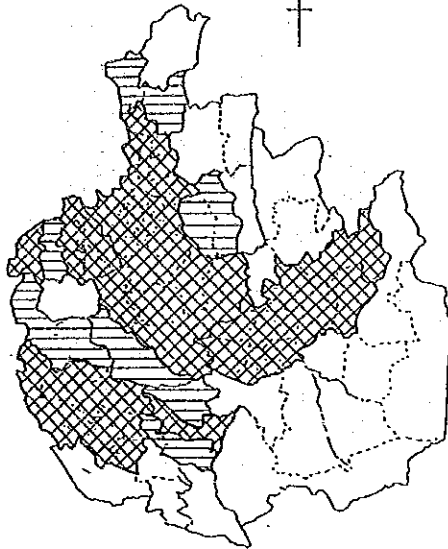

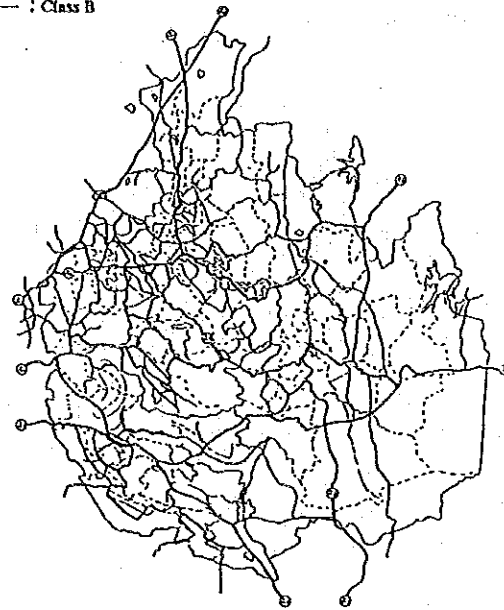
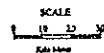
Fig. Present Condition of the Project Area (Result of the Survey in 1993) 2/7

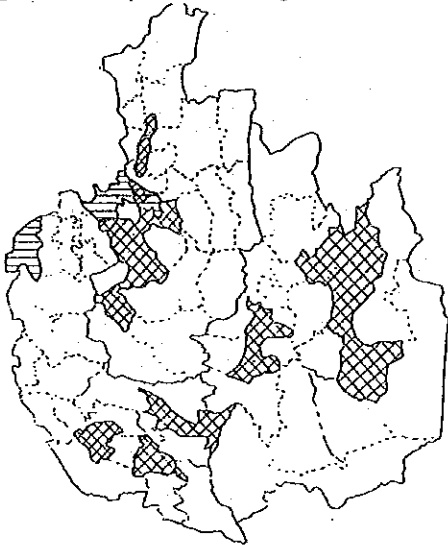
Road Density



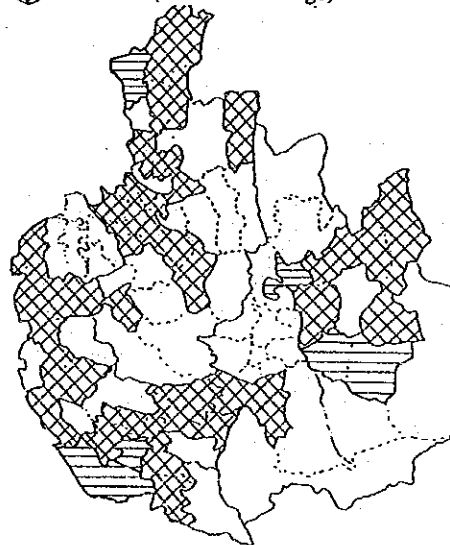
Main Road Network

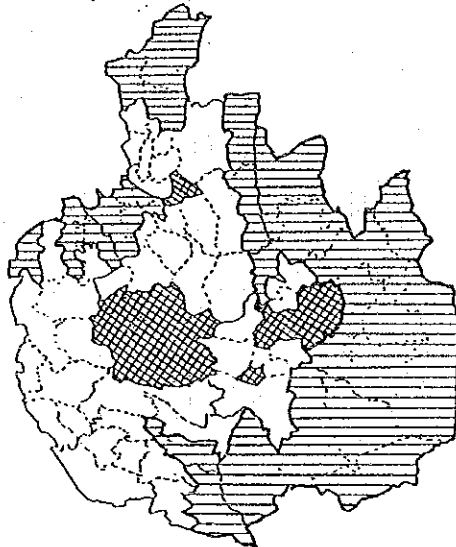

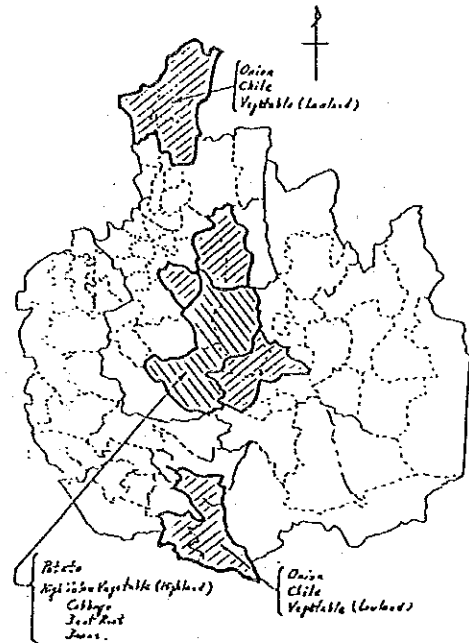

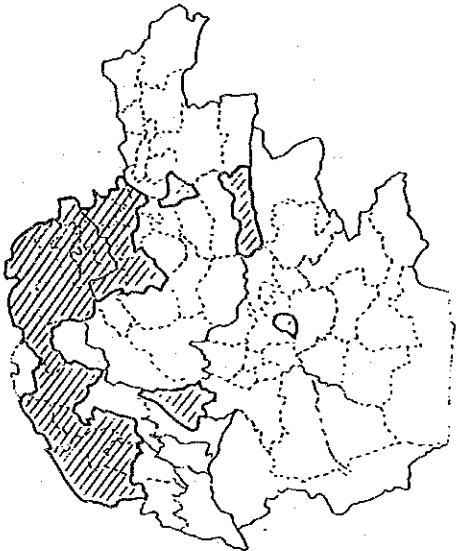


The Proportion of Small Holding and Estate





Cash Crop Growing Districts

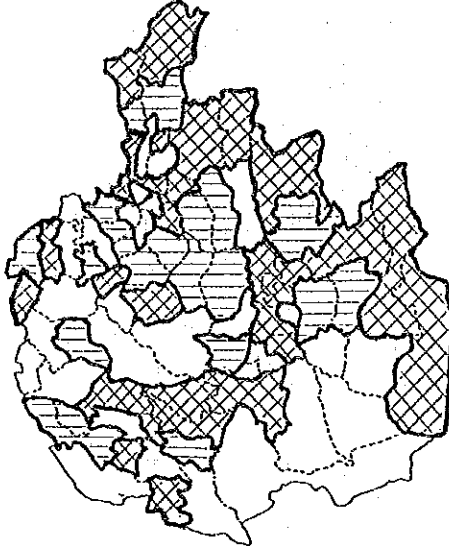

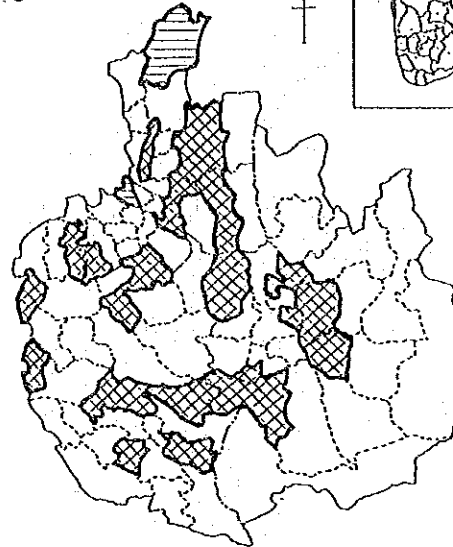

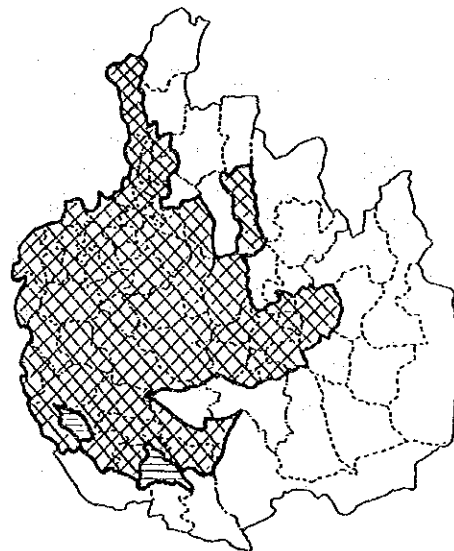

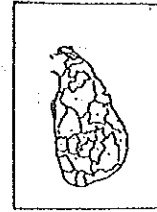

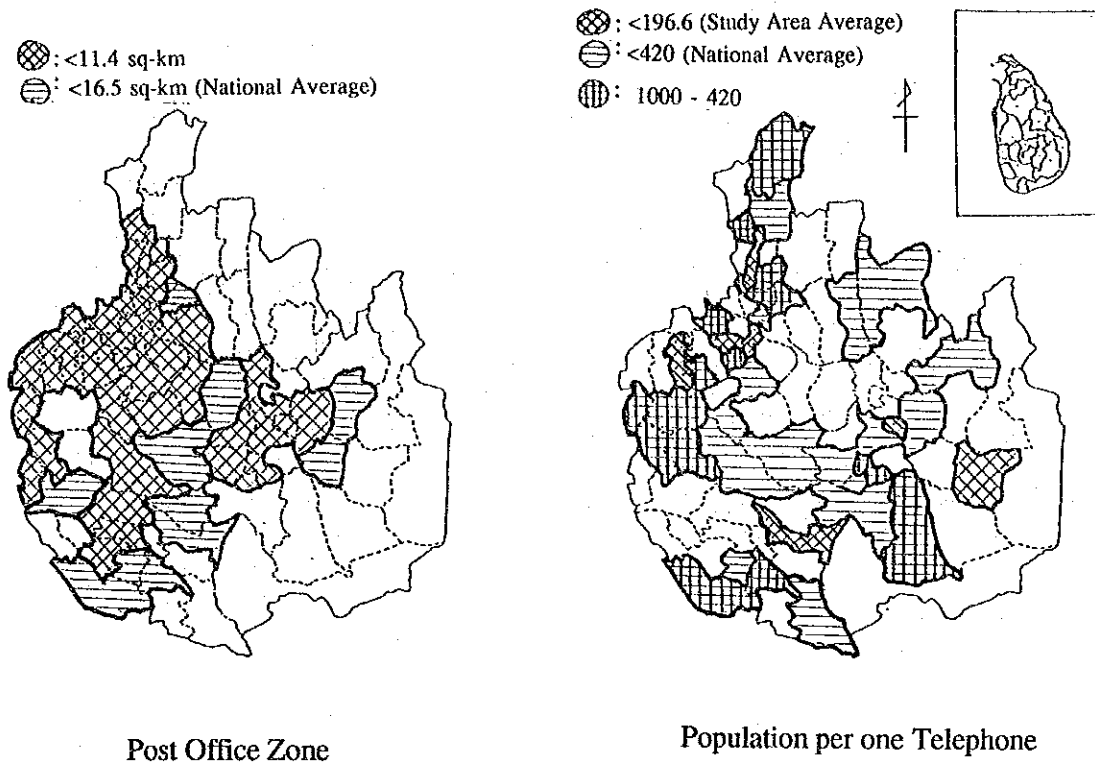
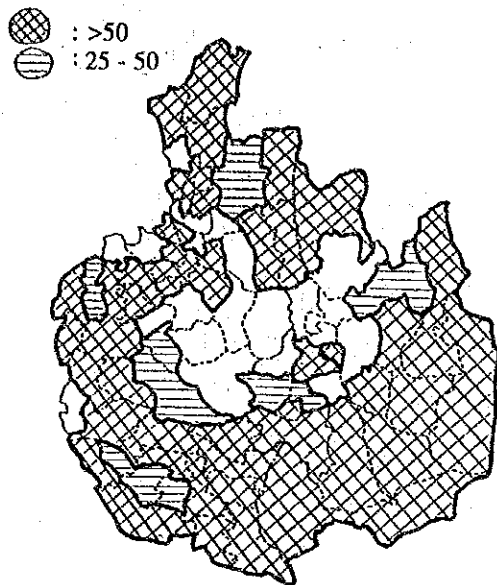
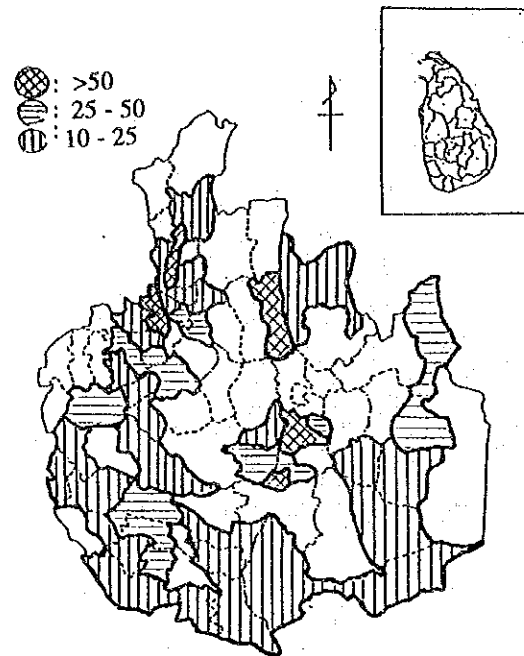


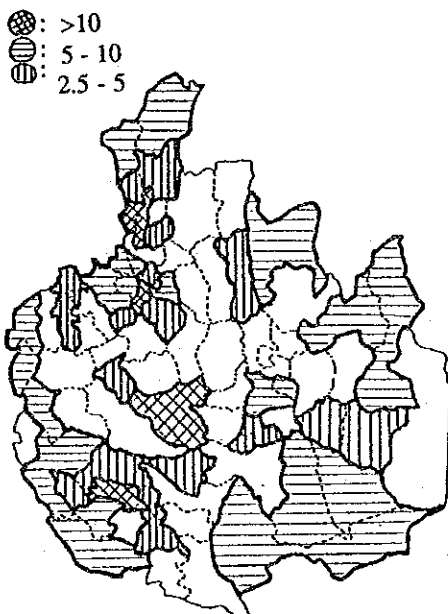
Fig. Present Condition of the Project Area (Result of the Survey in 1993) 6/7



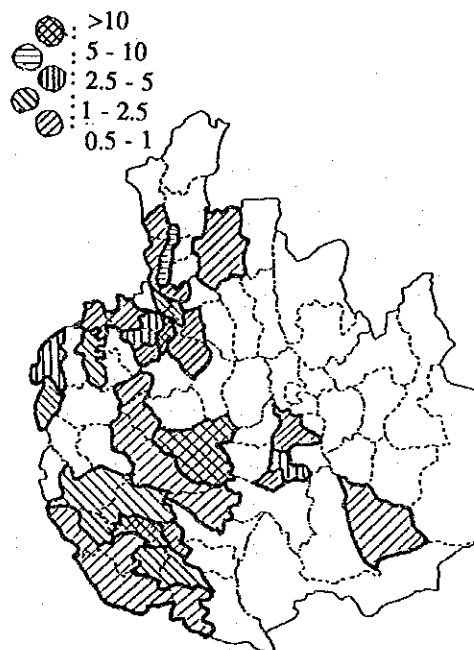
The Diffusion of Radio (per 100 families)

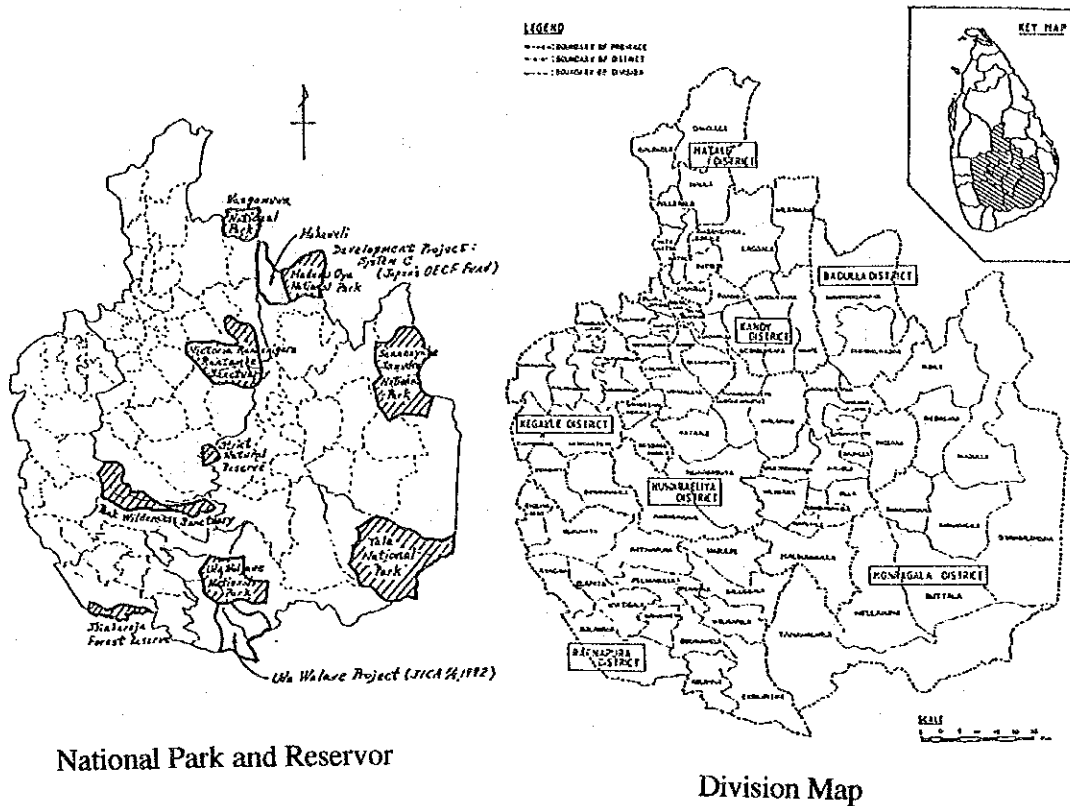


The Diffusion of Motorbike (per 100 families)

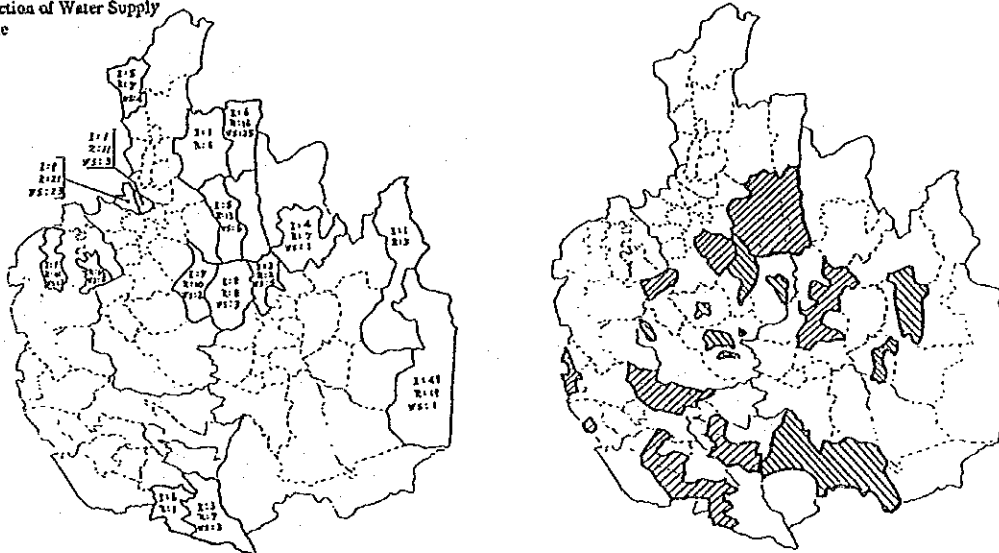
