The SIFC was established on May 1,1992, under the SIFC Act, succeeding the Small Industry Finance Office (SIFO). The Corporation is allowed to raise funds from the public and has a wider scope of operation than the SIFO. In addition to lending to individuals in the amount not exceeding 10 million Baht for the purposes of setting up, expanding, and improving small scale industries, the SIFC is allowed to undertake more businesses such as underwriting securities and investing in other activities.

Initial capital of the SIFC consisted of 300 million Baht in paid-up capital, of which 75 million Baht was transferred from the net assets of the SIFO by the Ministry of Finance.
