Tables Operations in 1995

The following operational data summarizes statistics for personnel and costs of JICA's operations in 1995, shown in terms of regions and international organizations. Data on individual countries and international organizations are in the JICA Annual Report 1996, Data Volume.

The sphere from which data is collected and collection methods used are as follows:

(1) Acceptance of participants for training: concerns the acceptance of participants for training (including Third Country Training), youth

invitations program, development cooperation and

emigration.

(2) Dispatch of experts:

concerns dispatch of technical cooperation experts, project-type technical cooperation (social development cooperation, health care and medical cooperation, population and family planning, agriculture, forestry and fisheries cooperation and industrial development cooperation), development cooperation, cooperation for disaster relief etc., aid efficiency promotion and emigration.

(3) Dispatch of study teams:

concerns all activities such as the acceptance of technical participants for training.

(4) Dispatch of JOCV teams:

concerns the dispatch of Japan Overseas Cooperation Volunteers.

(5) Emigration:

concerns those who have received assistance such as emigration expenses from emigration program of JICA and those who have been dispatched under the overseas development youth program.

(6) Expenses:

totals of the 1995 budget and carried-over budget. Unit: ¥1,000.

(7) Global:

Since the personnel figures denoted as "8 Global" include "unclassifiable" (world) statistics, this total does not match the total obtained from the figures for regions and international organizations.
