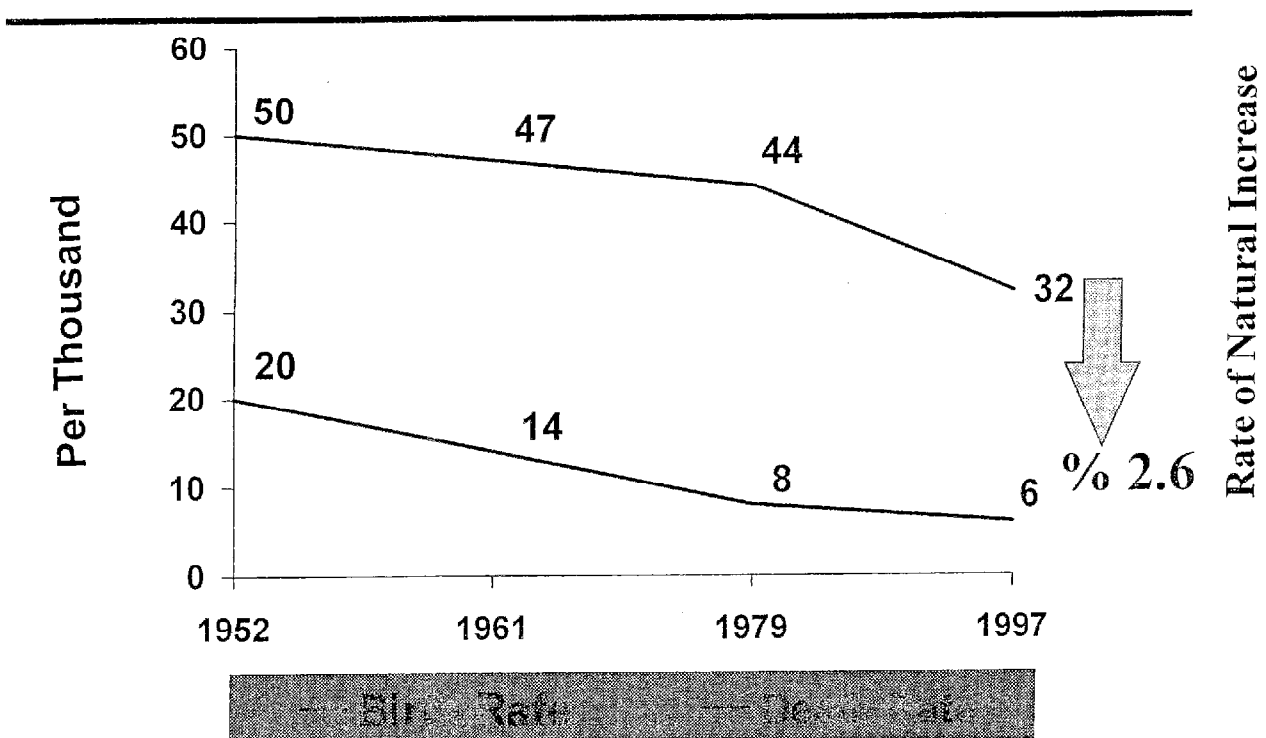

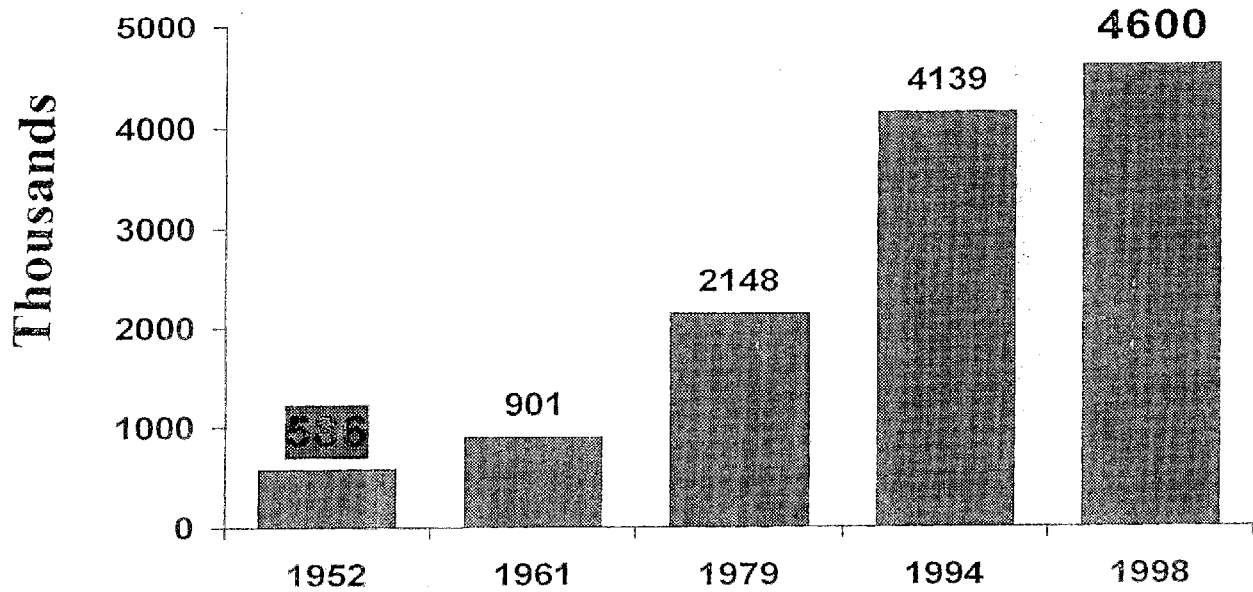

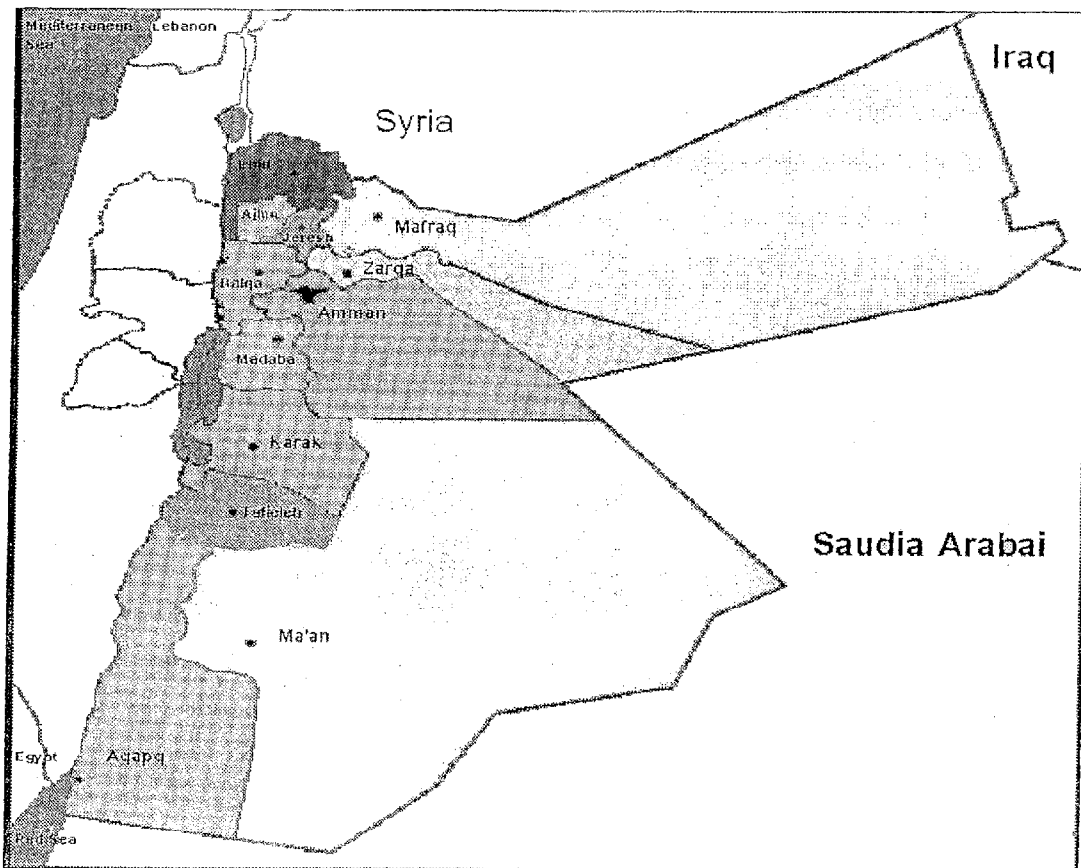
Birth and Death Rate and Rate of Natural Increase 1952-1997



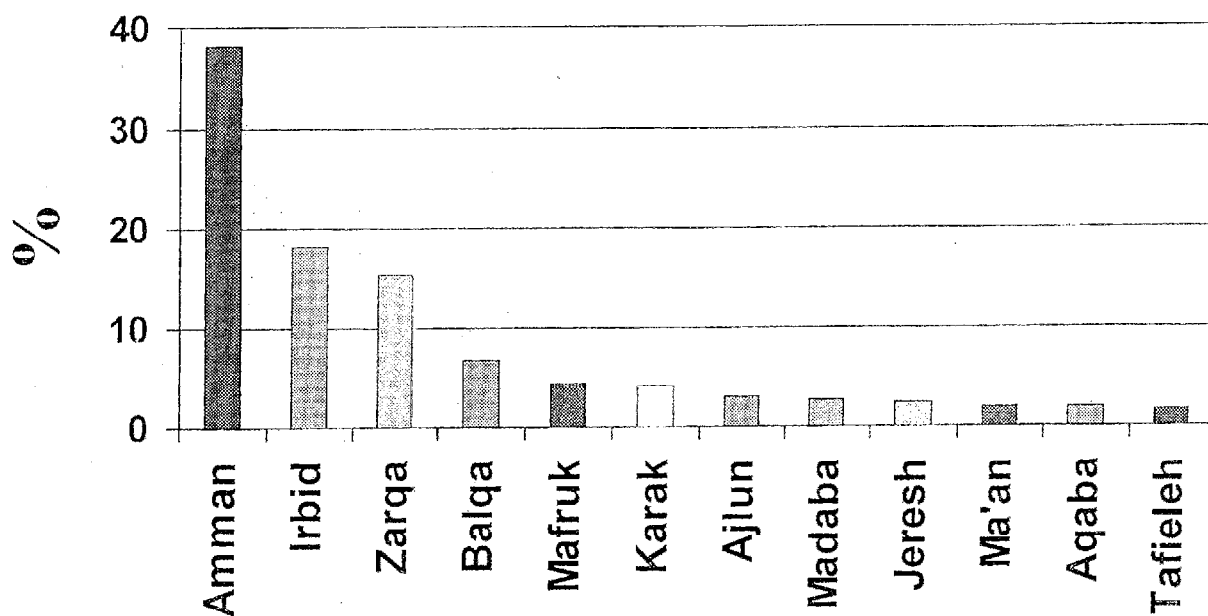
Population Size 1952 -1998

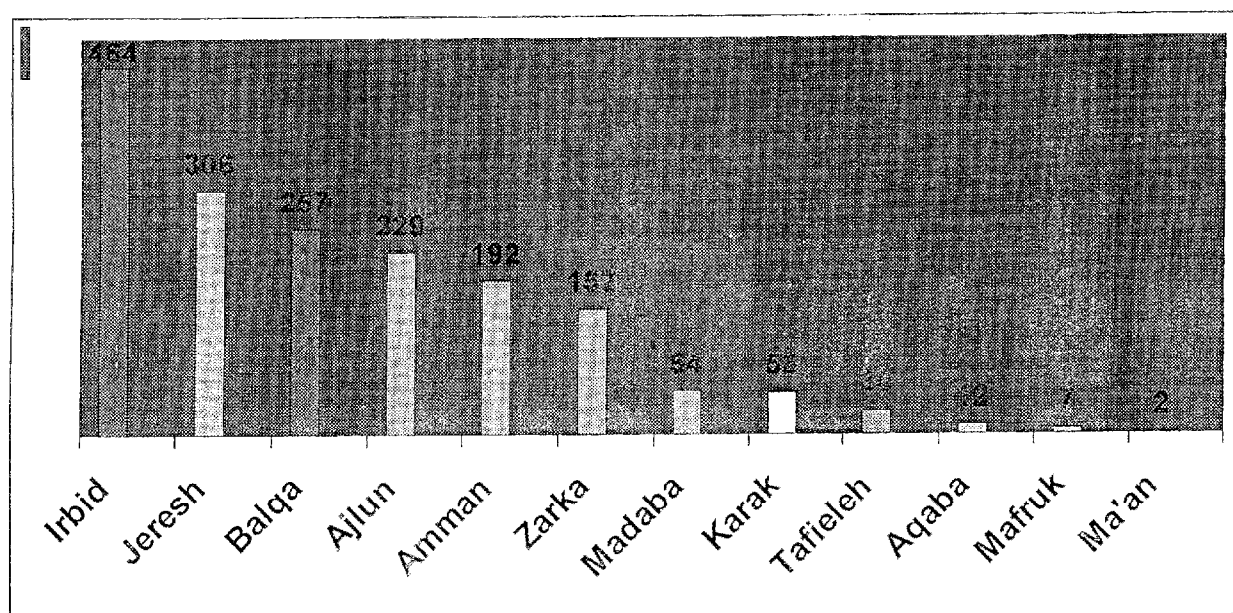


Population By Governorates 1994



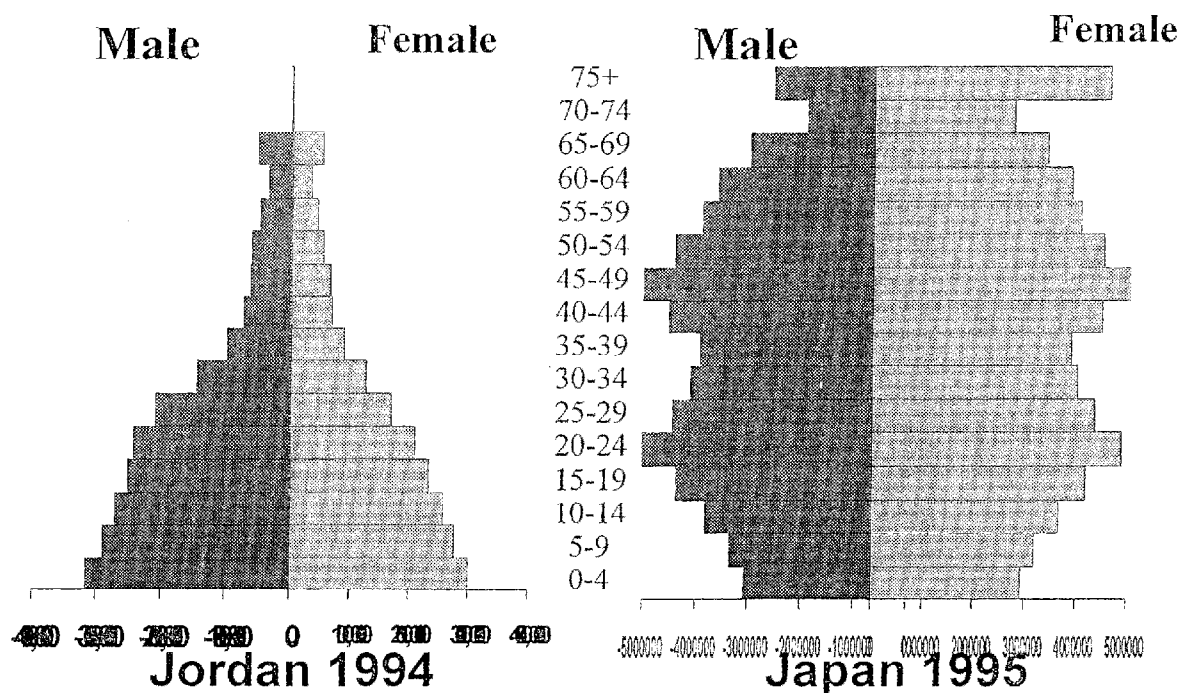

Population Density per sq. km by Governorate

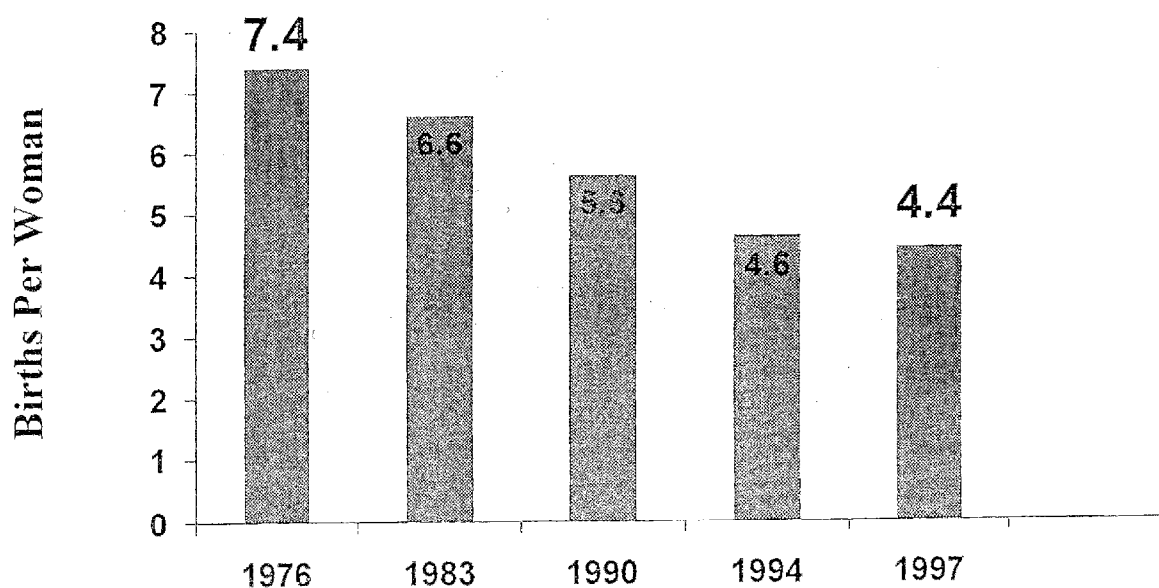

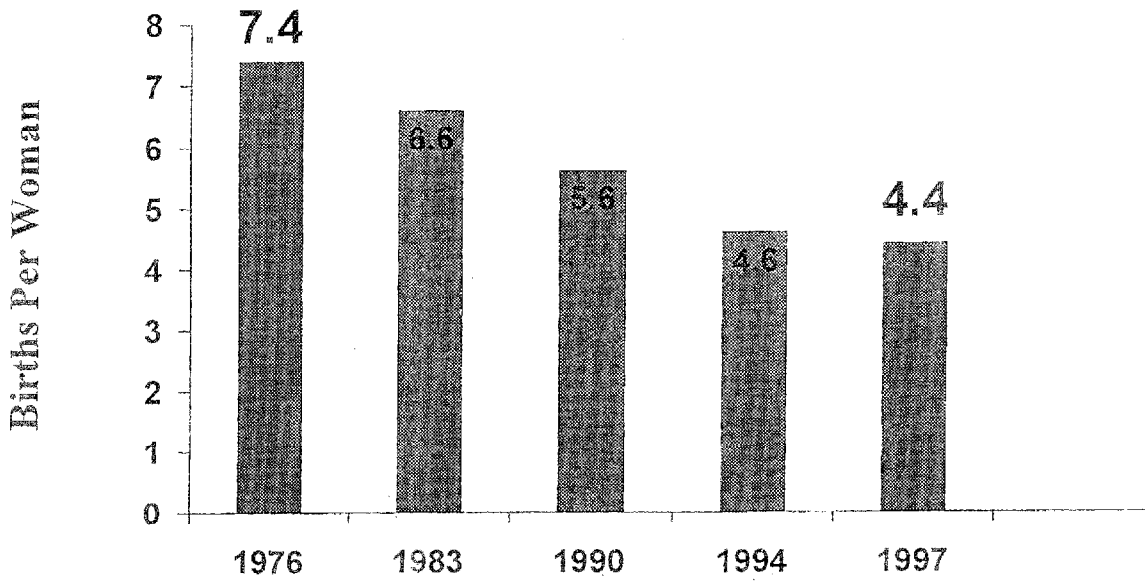


Total Fertility Rate 1976-1997



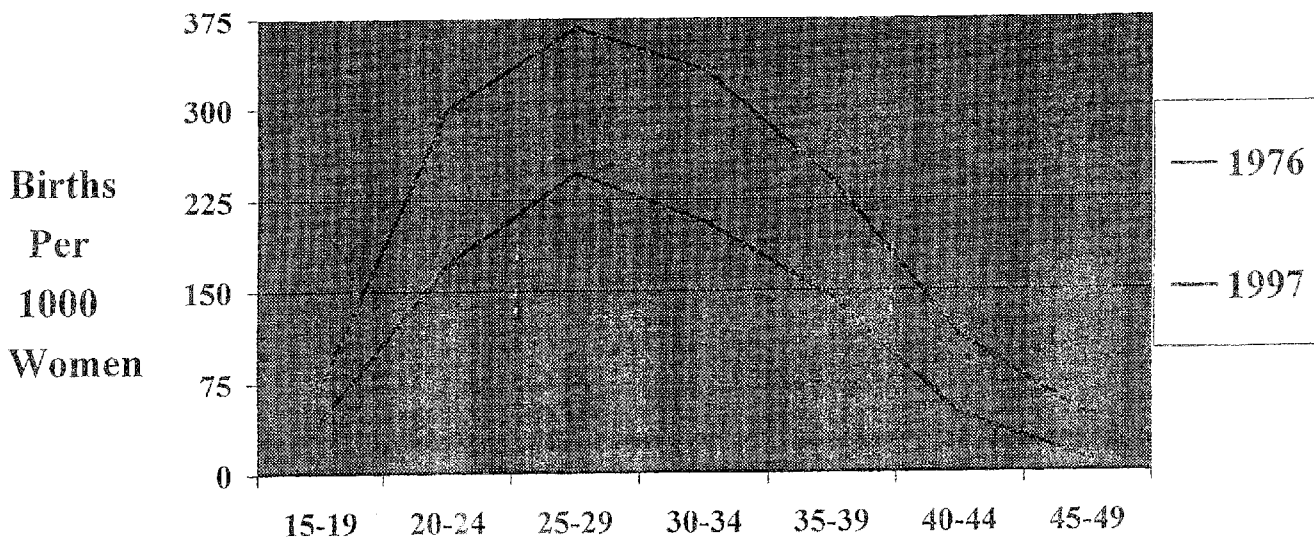

Total Fertility Rate 1976-1997



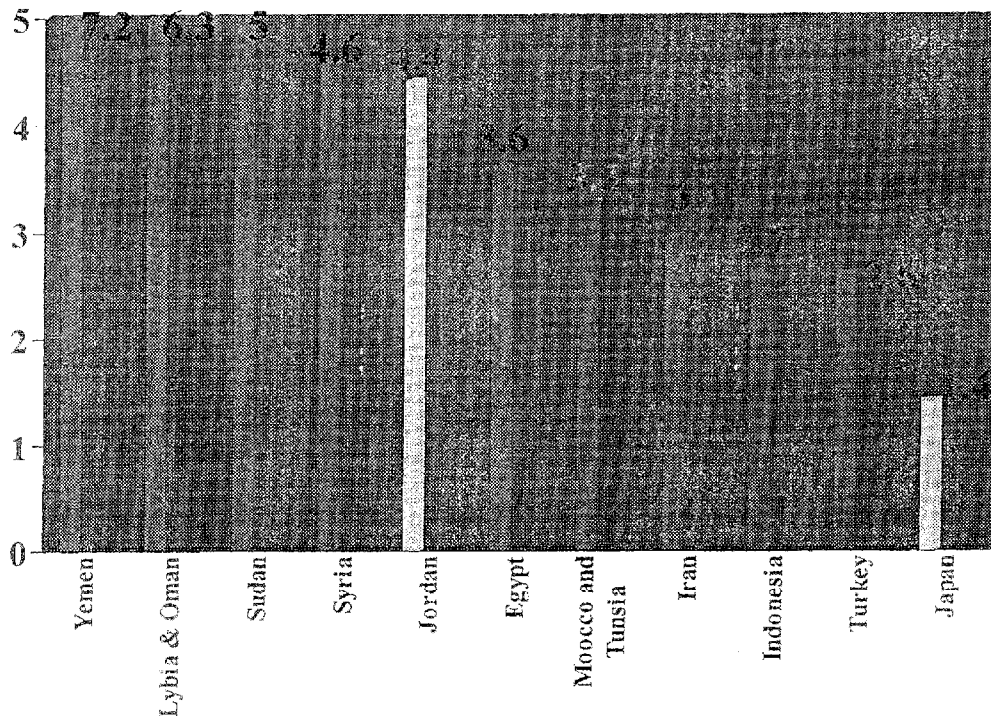

Reasons For Fertility Decline

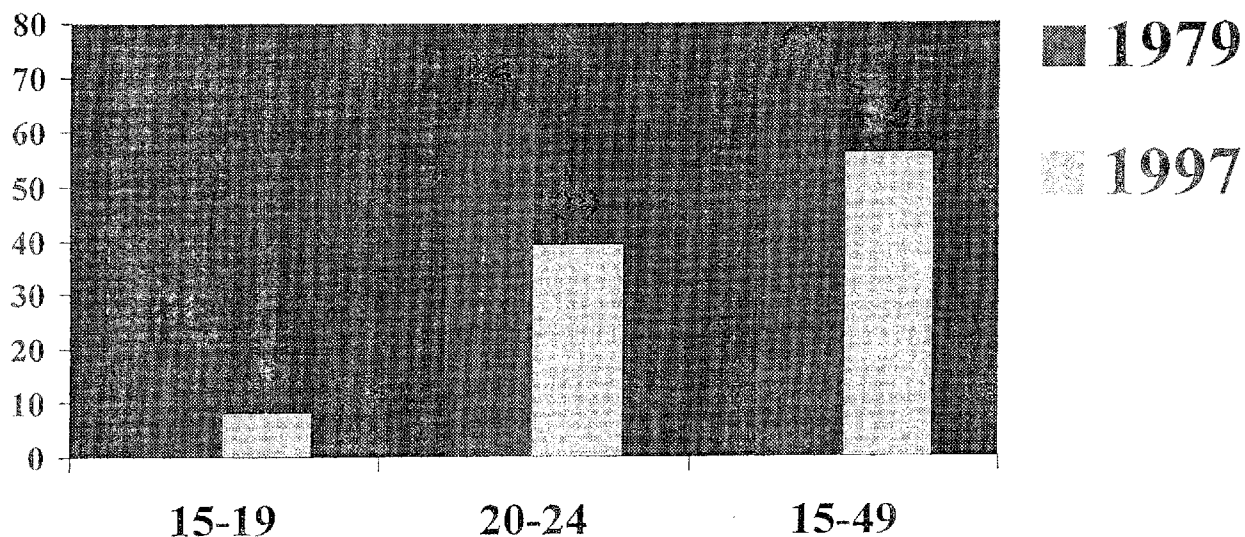
● Marriage Pattern

● Family Planning

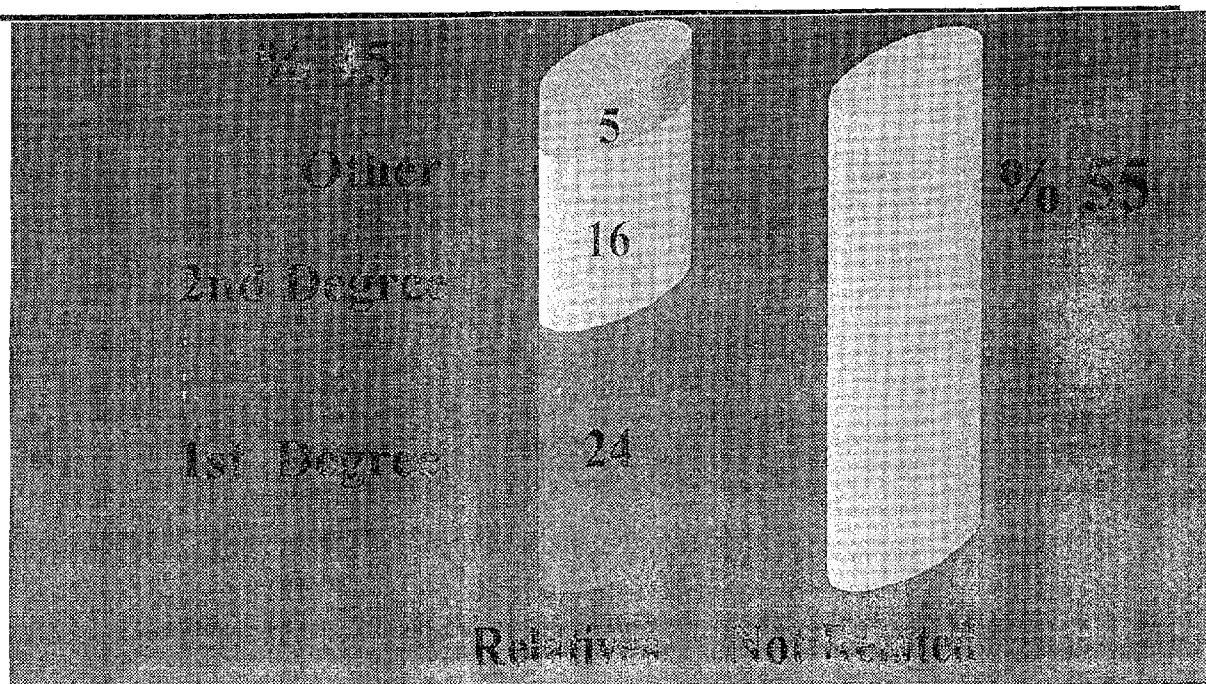
- Increase in Contraceptive Prevalence Due to Increased Motivation to use Among Couples

Ever-Married Females (%)



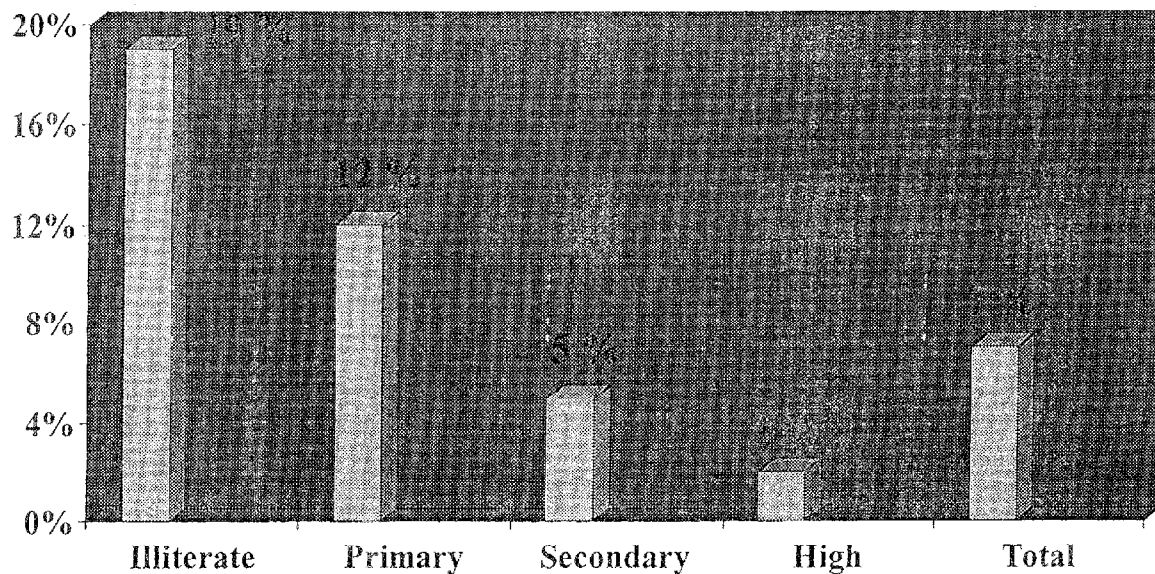

Kinship Marriage



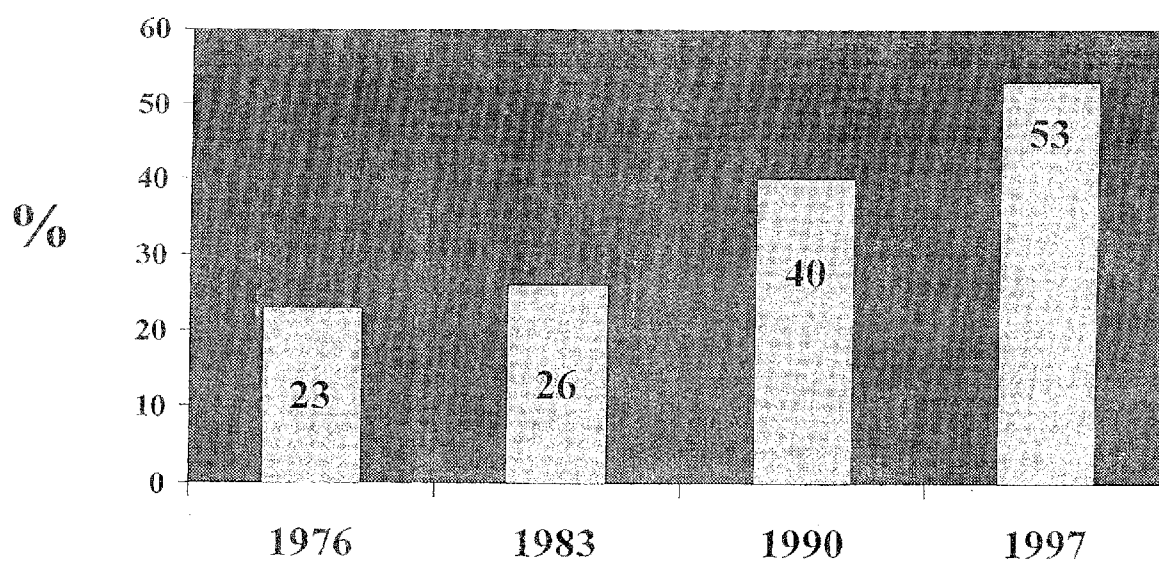

% of Women 15-49 in Polygamous Marriage by Education



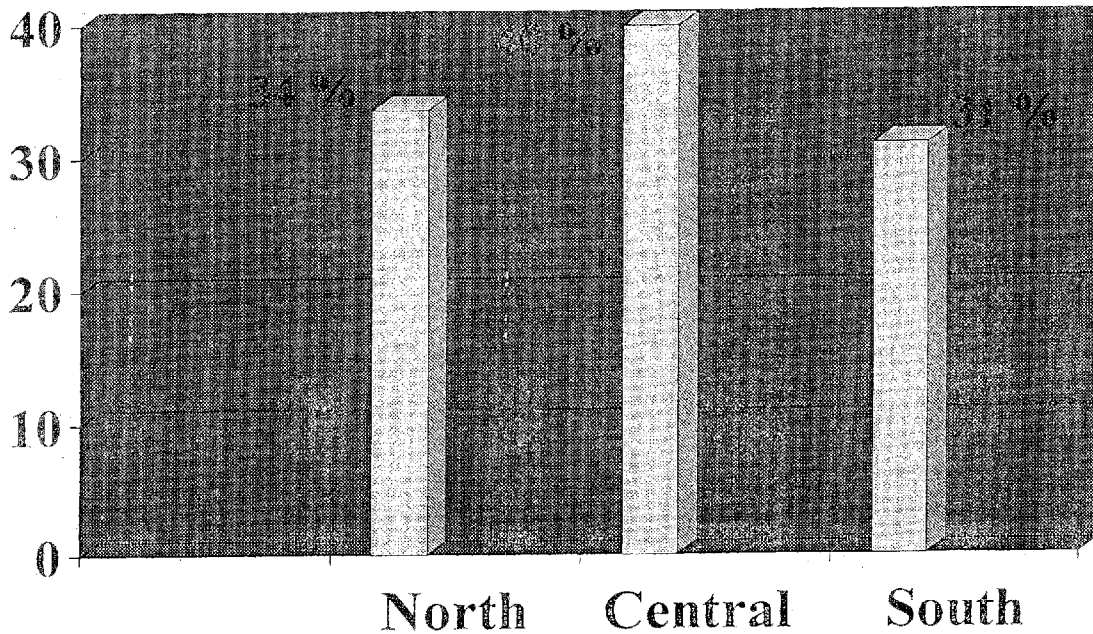

Contraceptive Prevalence Among Currently Married Women



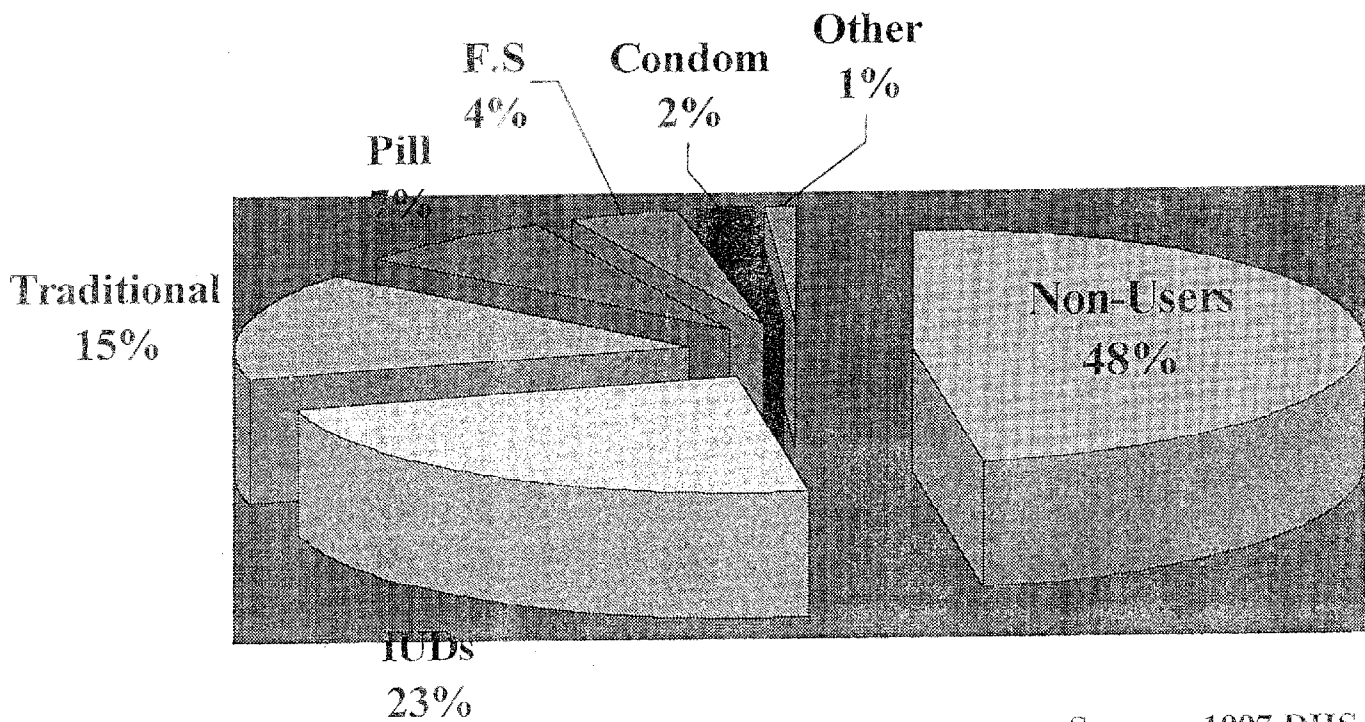
