About “Education Statistics, 1996-97”

What it is about

The “**Education Statistics, 1996/97**” is a collection of statistical information on schools in Cambodia for the school year 1996-1997. It includes information on students, teachers, textbooks, buildings and facilities, and community participation and finance for all Pre-Schools, Primary Schools, and Secondary Schools.

What it is for

The “**Education Statistics, 1996/97**” is primarily intended for professionals, administrators, and managers at various levels of MoEYS and the users among different organizations. This information is essential for the general understanding of and monitoring the system. It also provides a sound basis for policy analysis, planning and management of education activities, and for conducting specific surveys in the future to obtain supporting in-depth information.

How it was collected

The Planning and Aid Coordination Unit (PACU) developed a 4-page “Annual School Census Form” and distributed a form to all schools throughout the country via the Provincial and District Education Service Offices. The School Principals took responsibility for completing the forms and the District and Provincial Offices checked the data and sent the forms back to PACU.

Separate survey forms were used to collect information for Teacher Training, Higher and Technical Education and Nonformal Education. This information will be processed and disseminated separately.

How it was processed

The EMIS Center (Education Management Information Center) at PACU received, checked, collated, edited and coded all forms manually before data were entered into the computer. Specially prepared computer programs checked errors and accepted data that were logically correct. Forms were sent back to the previous step down the line if data were not complete, sometimes to the provinces to check with the schools.

The national staff trained in data processing and computer technology operates the EMIS Center. The Center is equipped with an Ethernet LAN with a number of workstations, and uses Visual dBase 5.5 for the database, SPSS 6 for analysis, and EXCEL 7 software for producing information.

The EMIS Center is jointly supported by UNICEF and the UNESCO/UNDP Project. UNICEF provided a fully furnished building for EMIS Center.

How it is disseminated

The “**Education Statistics, 1996/97**” is disseminated by the PACU to all Education departments at the Central, Provincial and District levels for their planning and management purposes. A limited number of copies are made available to education-related ministries and organizations on request.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

This is the first attempt in publishing basic school information on Pre-School and General Education in Cambodia. The Principals of the Schools provided the basic school data. The District and Provincial level offices also provided help in securing accurate data.

However, there are two points to take into account: 1) In the absence of the National Census figures, population figures provided by the district educational offices were used. They were estimates from the head count survey in the community. 2) In 1996/97, there was a major change in the schooling period for General Education in Cambodia from eleven to twelve years. As such there were some discrepancies in defining 'promotion' and 'repetition' during this year.

Both these factors effected the quality of information produced in this booklet. It is suggested that caution should be used in interpreting tables like, gross and net enrollment ratios, gross and net admission rates, and the student flow rates.

The UNDP/UNESCO Project, in collaboration with UNICEF, provided technical assistance in developing EMIS and in producing information for management use.

Definitions used in “Education Statistics, 19.../97”

Table 1: Schools, Classes, Students and Staff

- Col. 1: Particulars: Name of the area or type of school for which the statistics refers to.
- Col. 2: Number of Schools: Total number of schools in the specified area or with the specified characteristics.
- Col. 3: Disadvantaged Schools: A disadvantaged school is defined as the school with all the following 5 conditions:
- (i) at least 50 per cent of its rooms do not have good roof;
 - (ii) at least 50 per cent of its rooms do not have good floor;
 - (iii) at least 50 per cent of its rooms do not have good wall;
 - (iv) does not have drinking water supply; and
 - (v) does not have latrine facilities.
- Col. 4: Number of Classes: Total number of classes in the schools specified in Col. 2.
- Col. 5: Classes in Pagoda: Total number of classes which are situated in the pagoda compound, irrespective of the location of the schools. The school may be inside or outside the pagoda compound.
- Col. 6: Enrollment (Total): Total enrollment of both gender in schools.
- Col. 7: Enrollment (Girls): Total female enrollment in schools.
- Col. 8: Repeaters (Total): Total repeaters of both gender in schools.
- Col. 9: Repeaters (Girls): Total female repeaters in schools.
- Col. 10: Teaching staff (Total): Total teaching staff (teachers) of both gender in schools. A principal of the school with all grades for the school cycle is classified as teaching staff whether he/she is teaching or not; but the principal of the school without all grades for the school cycle is classified as teaching staff only if he/she is taking at least 1/3 of the normal teaching load prescribed for a teacher.
- Col. 11: Teaching staff (Female): Total female teaching staff in schools.
- Col. 12: Non-teaching staff (Total): Total non-teaching staff of both gender in schools. Non-teaching staff are the school staff who do not directly involve in regular teaching activities in the classrooms. Some school principals, secretary, surveillant, and home economics, workshop and sports teachers together with the clerks and guards are non-teaching staff of a school.

Col. 13: Non-teaching staff (Female): Total female non-teaching staff in schools.

Row 1: For the whole Kingdom.

Row 2: For the schools located in the urban areas.

Row 3: For the schools located in the rural areas.

Row 4: For the schools located in the remote areas.

Note: Schools are classified as urban, rural or remote, based on the definitions recognized by the respective district education office (DEO) and provincial education services (PES). Normally, the schools located in the large towns or cities are classified as urban schools; and those located in isolation, with very difficult communication and transport systems are classified as remote. The rest are rural schools.

Row 5: Pre-school: Schools under Pre-School and General Education Department, for children aged 3-5 years old.

Row 6: Primary school: Schools which are providing at least one grade of primary education. It can be an annex school. In Cambodia, primary education comprises of grades 1 through 6.

Row 7: College: Lower Secondary Schools with grades 7 through 9, but some may not have all grades (Total College=351).

Row 8: Lycee: Upper Secondary Schools with grade 10 through 12, but some may not have all grades (Lycee without Lower Secondary=7). Some Lycee also have Lower Secondary grades (Lycee with Lower Secondary=99). (7+99=106). (99 can be derived by subtracting 351 from 450).

Row 9: Lower Secondary Level: Counting only for Lower Secondary level education. Include Lower Secondary grades from all Colleges (Total College=351), and all Lower Secondary grades from Lycee (Lycee with Lower Secondary=99). (351+99=450).

Row 10: Upper Secondary Level: Counting only for Upper Secondary level education. Include Upper Secondary grades from all Lycee (Total Lycee=106).

Row 11: Cluster - core school: The core school of a primary school cluster.

- Row 12: Cluster - satellite school: The member school, a primary school cluster but not the core school.
- Row 13: School not in cluster: The primary school which is neither core nor satellite school of a primary school cluster.
- Row 14: Annex school: An annex school is a branch of a school located away from but administered by a parent school. Usually the Vice-Principal or a senior teacher is assigned as "in-charge". Annex schools normally do not have all 6 primary grades and located in different village from their parent school.
- Row 15: School in Pagoda: The schools which are totally located in pagoda compound.
- Row 16: Disadvantaged schools (all level): Same as Col.3.

Table 2: Schools, Classes, Students and Staff by Province (or District)

- Col. 1: Provinces: Province or area of location of school for which the statistics refers to.
- Col. 2-13: As defined for Table 1 .

Table 3: Enrollment by Level of Education

- Col. 3-4: Pre-school Enrollment: Enrollment in various pre-school steps: low, medium, high or mixed steps. Col. 3 for both sexes and Col.4 for girls only.
- Col. 5-6: Primary Enrollment: Enrollment in Grades 1 through 6.
- Col. 7-8: Lower Secondary Enrollment: Enrollment in Grades 7 through 9.
- Col. 9-10: Upper Secondary Enrollment: Enrollment in Grades 10 through 12.

Table 4: Characteristics of School and School Principal

- Col. 6: 2-Shift School: Number of schools where pupils attend only one part of the day (morning or evening). Few schools even practice 3 shifts and are included in the list.

- Col. 7: Floating school: Number of schools which are built to stay on water. Normally, pupils in those schools have to use boat to reach to school except for few months in the dry season.
- Col. 9: Attached Pre-school: Number of pre-schools which are attached to a primary school.
- Col. 10: Schools without Water Supply: Number of schools without any drinking water supply for the pupils.
- Col. 11: Schools without Latrine: Number of schools without toilet facilities for the pupils.
- Col. 12: Average Age: Average age of school principals (or person in-charge for annex school) in the given area.
- Col. 13: Average Service: Average total years of service of school principals (or person in-charge for annex school).
- Col. 14: With Upper Secondary+ Education: Total number of school principals (or person in-charge for annex school) with upper secondary or higher education. Principals with upper secondary certificate (completed upper secondary) or with some years of university education or with a university degree or diploma are included.
- Col. 15: Female: Total number of female school principals (or person in-charge for annex school).

Table 5: Number of Schools by Highest Grade Taught

- Col. 2: Pre-schools (Total): Total number of pre-schools.
- Col. 3: Pre-schools (Mixed Step): Number of pre-schools with only one "Mixed" step for every child. Do not include other steps: low, medium and high.

Table 7: Enrollment and Repeaters by Grade

Note: Repeaters refer to those pupils who are attending the same grade as they were in the previous school year or those who were not successful in the previous school year and are now studying in one grade lower than their successful counterparts. For this school year, those who attended grade 7 last year and are attending grade 8 now are repeaters, because of the change in schooling period.

- Col. 2: Grade 1 Intake (Total): Total number of new admissions (intakes) in Grade 1. Those pupils never enrolled in school system previously.
- Col. 3: Grade 1 Intake (Aged 6): Total number of new admissions (intakes) in Grade 1 at age 6 (or younger).
- Col. 4: Primary Enrollment (Total): Total number of pupils enrolled in primary level (Grades 1-6), irrespective of their age.
- Col. 5: Primary Enrollment (Aged 11+): Total number of pupils enrolled in primary level, but are older than 11 years (12, 13, 14, . . .).
- Col. 6: Grade 7 Intake (Total): Total number of new pupils enrolled in Grade 7 (who were successful in previous school year and now are in Grade 7).
- Col. 7: Grade 7 Intake (Aged 12): Total number of new pupils enrolled in Grade 7 at age 12 (or younger).
- Col. 8: Lower Secondary Enrollment (Total): Total number of pupils enrolled in lower secondary level (Grades 7-9), irrespective of their age.
- Col. 9: Lower Secondary Enrollment (Aged 14+): Total number of pupils enrolled in lower secondary level, but are older than 14 years (15, 16, 17, . . .).
- Col. 10: Grade 10 Intake (Total): Total number of new pupils enrolled in Grade 10.
- Col. 11: Grade 10 Intake (Aged 15): Total number of new pupils enrolled in Grade 10 at age 15 (or younger).
- Col. 12: Upper Secondary Enrollment (Total): Total number of pupils enrolled in upper secondary level (Grades 10-12), irrespective of their age.
- Col. 13: Upper Secondary Enrollment (Aged 17+): Total number of pupils enrolled in upper secondary level, but are older than 17 years (18, 19, . . .).
- Col. 14: Percentage Over-age Enrollment in Primary: Percentage of pupils aged 12 years or older (aged 11+) in total primary enrollment.
- Col. 15: Percentage Over-age Enrollment in Lower Secondary: Percentage of pupils aged 15 years or older (aged 14+) in total lower secondary enrollment.

- Col. 16: Percentage Over-age Enrollment in Upper Secondary: Percentage of pupils aged 18 years or older (aged 17+) in total upper secondary enrollment.

Table 10: Number of Primary Schools Receiving Teachers' Guides

- Col. 2-13: Number of primary schools with Grade 1 classes and total number of schools receiving Grade 1 teachers' guide for four major subjects (and those for Grade 6) from MoEYS.
- Col. 14: Number of primary schools receiving any type of teachers' guide for any grade from other sources.

Table 11: Number of Secondary Schools Receiving Teachers' Guides

- Col. 2-13: Number of secondary schools with Grade 7 classes and total number of schools receiving Grade 8 teachers' guide for four major subjects (and those for Grade 10) from MoEYS.

- Col. 6-9: Similar to Col. 3-5, but for non-teaching staff.
- Col. 10-13: Similar to Col. 3-5, but confined to teaching staff without pedagogy training.

- Col. 2-10: Total number of schools with special functions assigned to staff (not number of staff).
