Over grazed scrubland comprises the second large place in the proposed site with 143.5 ha (20% of the total area). This land cover is generally developed on public properties and rocky areas on the steep slopes which are the marginal lands for agriculture. Sheep and goat grazing is still done actively in the area.

Maquis terrain with 107.9 ha (15% of the total area) takes an important part in the probable zone. The maquis in the terrain did develop in the non-agricultural fields, stream beds and slopes as a maquis under storey or at the fields in the forests. More detailed information about the maquis in the region can be found in the flora and fauna Figure 14-7.
