**CONDITIONS OF MANUFACTURING LICENSE UNDER
THE INDUSTRIAL CO-ORDINATION ACT, 1975**

- (a) Approval for the factory site is subject to the approval from the relevant State Government and the Department of Environment
- (b) The company should commence the project within 12 months from the effective date of the Manufacturing License or within an extended period as allowed by the Licensing Officer. If this project is not implemented within the specified period, this License can be revoked
- (c) The shares of this company that are held by non-Malaysians cannot be sold without the prior written approval from the Ministry of International Trade and Industry.
- (d) The company should as far as possible appoint Malaysians into its Board of Directors and the Ministry of International Trade and Industry should be informed accordingly of the appointment and any changes in its Board of Directors
- (e) The company should employ and train Malaysians to reflect the country's multiracial composition for all position levels.
- (f) If the company intends to use used machinery, written approval from the Ministry of International Trade and Industry should be acquired beforehand along with a report by an independent valuer who is accepted by the Ministry of International Trade and Industry. The approval from the Ministry of International Trade and Industry should also be acquired before any changes, expansions or reductions are proposed to the machinery which will have a substantial impact on the workforce and/or production
- (g) The company should as far as possible use the services from locally owned companies and businesses in line with the New Economic Policy.
- (h) The company should obtain the written approval from the Ministry of International Trade and Industry before signing any technological transfer agreements with foreign parties, such as:-
 - Joint Ventures
 - Technical Assistance and "Know-How" Agreements
 - Licensing Agreements
 - Copyright and Patent Agreements
 - "Turnkey" Contract Agreements
 - Management Agreements

This condition will not apply for purchases of machinery that require the services of technical officers from the machine manufacturers to co-ordinate the assembling and operation on the machinery

Conditions of Manufacturing License

Page 2

- (i) The output of the company should achieve the standards that are acceptable to the Malaysian Government
- (j) The company should as far as possible appoint locally owned companies to distribute its products to the local market and should also appoint Bumiputra distributors to distribute at least 30% of its sales to the local market. The selection and appointment of Bumiputra distributors should be done after discussions with the Ministry of International Trade and Industry. The appointment of foreign companies as distributors should obtain the approval of the Ministry of International Trade and Industry beforehand.
- (k) The company is required to adhere to all regulations and provisions under the Environmental Quality Act, 1974.
- (l) The company must obtain written approval from the Department of Environment before this project is implemented.
- (m) The company should implement the project as approved subject to the conditions stated above and adhere to the laws and other regulations gazetted in Malaysia.

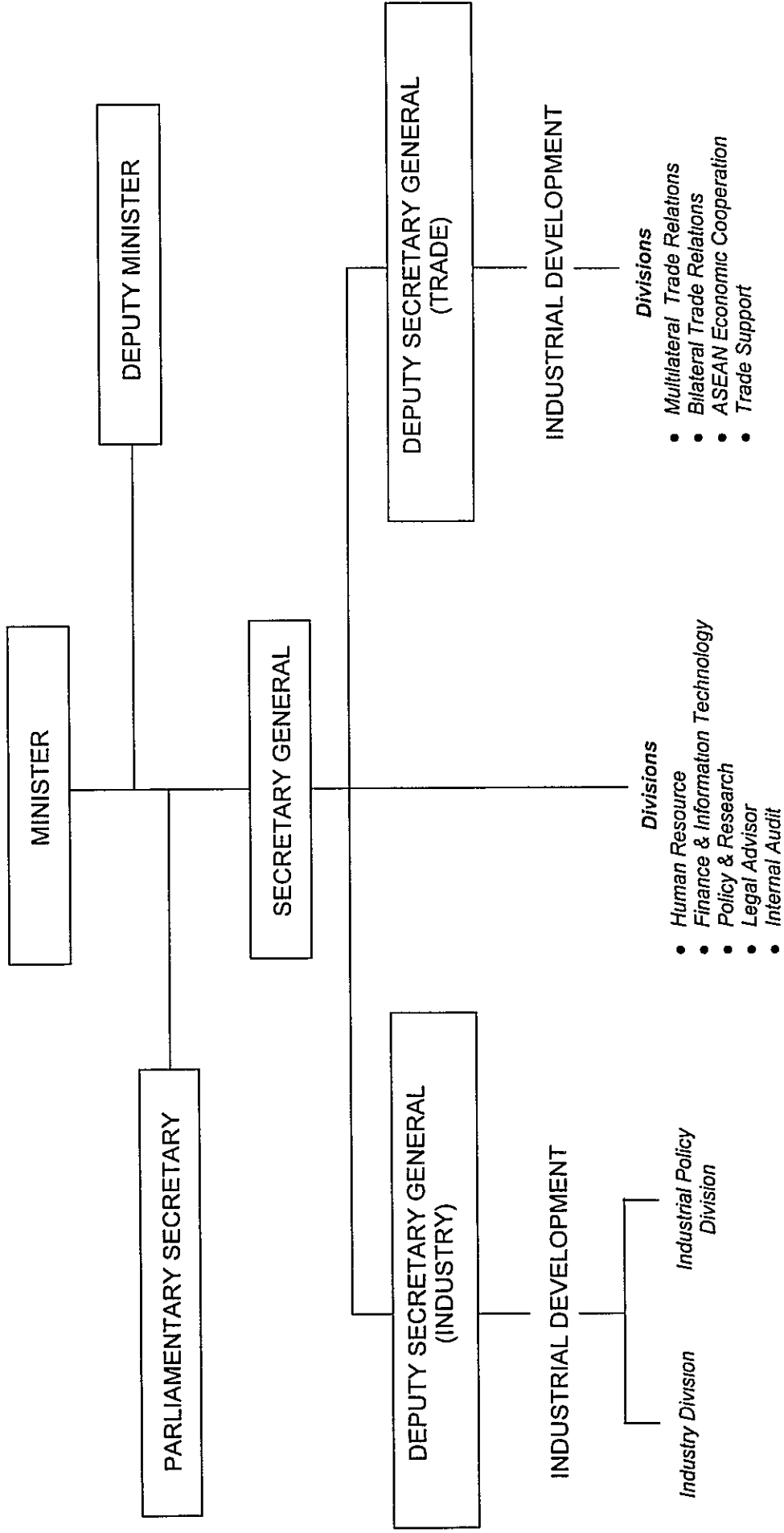

MALYSIAN INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MIDA) – ORGANISATION CHART

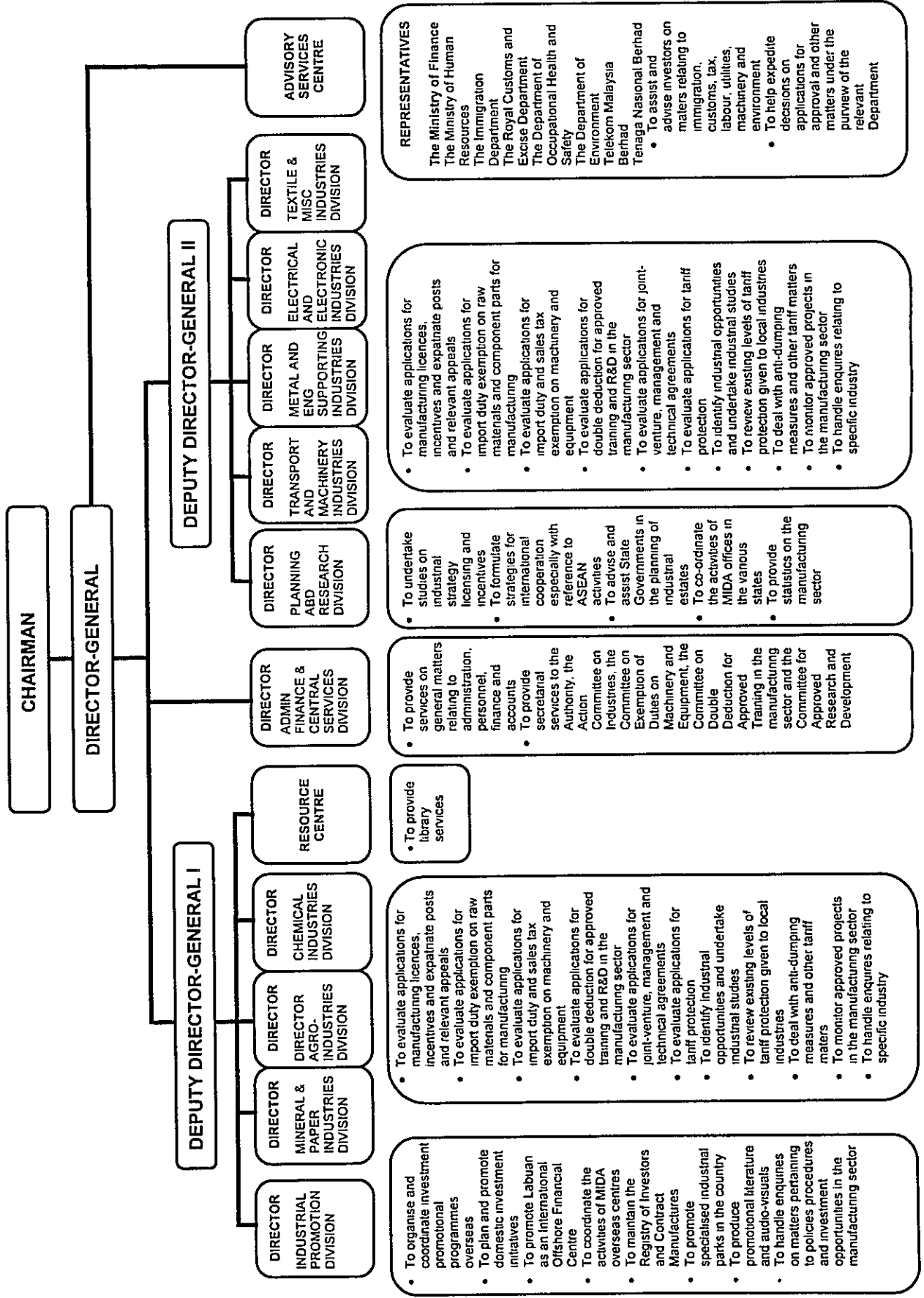

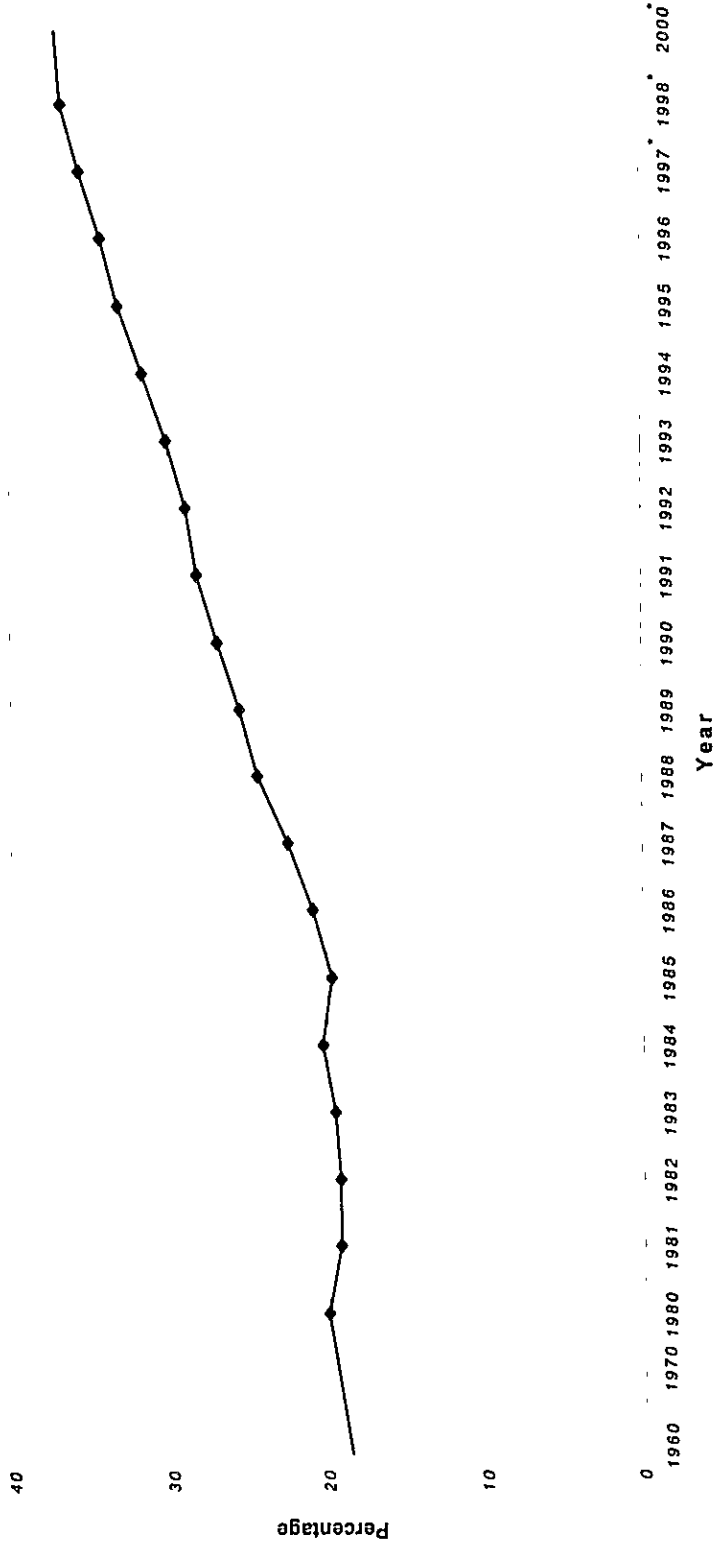

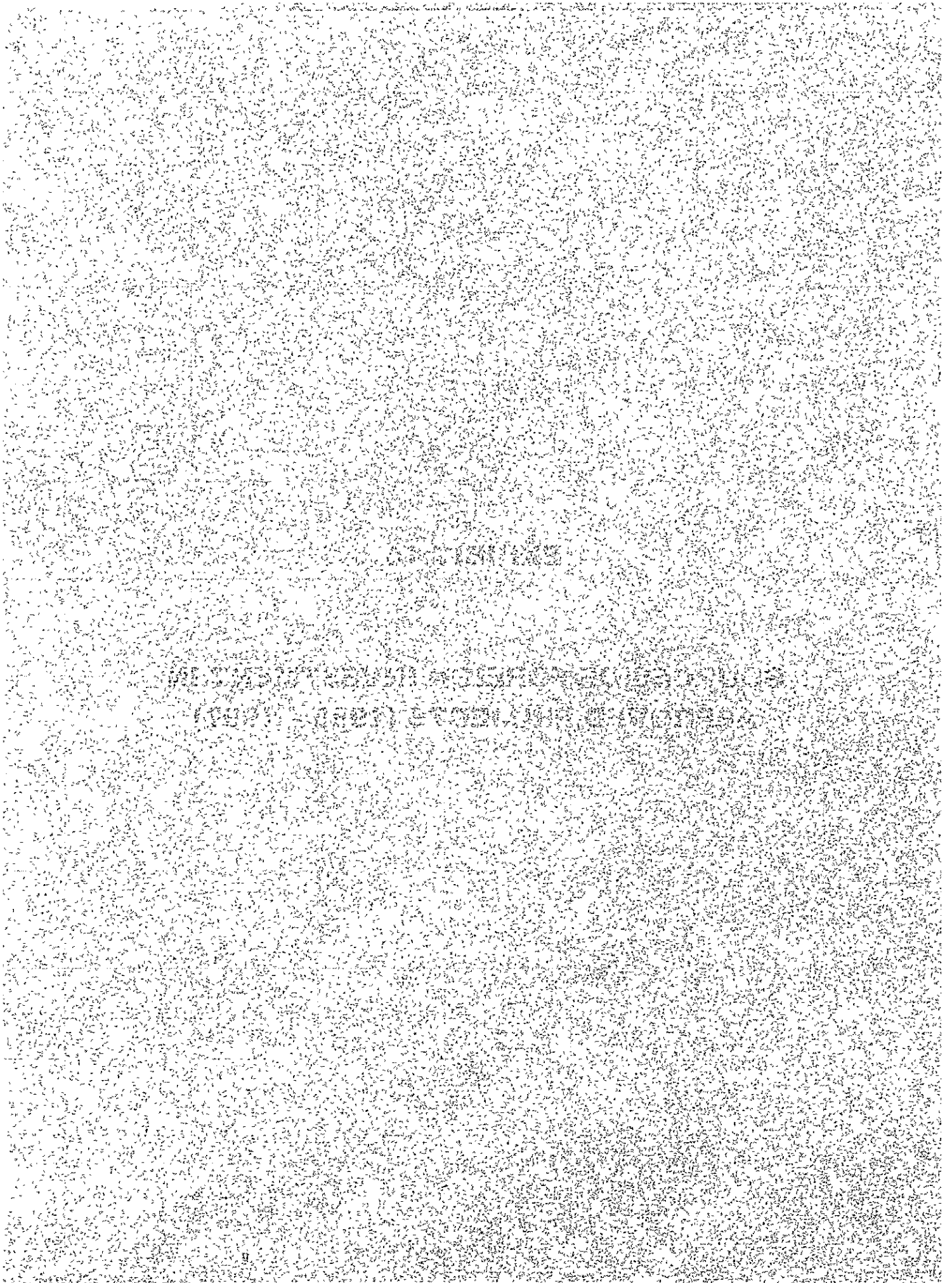
