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#### CHAPTER 1 RELATED PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

#### 1.1 Government/Public Organizations related to the Project Implementation

The Government/public organizations related to the Propjet implementations are the Department of Agriculture responsible for the overall project monitoring and technical guidance at the central level, and West Java Provincial Agricultural Service Office (Dinas Pertanian Tanaman Pangan TK I) and District Agricultural Service Offices (Dinas Pertanian Tanaman Pangan TK II) of the priority model areas which are actually responsible for project execution. The following government offices or organizations will provide the collaboration to the Project implementation, i.e., the Economic Planning and Development (BAPPEDA), Public Work Service Office (Dinas PU), Regional Cooperative and Small-scale Enterprises Service Office and Regional Team for Improvement of Household Living (PKK) at the province and district levels. The collaboration offices also include the sub-districts and village offices concerned to the model areas.

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#### CHAPTER 2 PUBLIC HEARING MEETING

#### 2.1 General

#### 2.1.1 Objectives

In accordance with participatory approach upon which the project planning process is based, public hearings were conducted at each model area site. Efforts were spent to ensure the attendance of local potential beneficiaries, representatives of local government administrations, collaborating offices from district and sub district levels, and district, provincial and Department counterparts. The objectives of this public hearing are three folds, namely:

- 1) To have the full understanding of the potential beneficiaries farmers, and collaborating offices and local governments regarding the proposed plan and its implementation,
- 2) To give them chance to correct (if required) the plan and its implementation, and
- 3) To obtain their full support for the plan and its implementation.

#### 2.1.2 Time Schedules and Participants

The public hearing meetings for the four model areas were held from January 19, 2000 to January 22, 2000. A half-day public consultation meeting was conducted at each model area, and it was held at the village office. Details about schedule, time and participants of the public hearings are presented in the following table:

#### 2.1.3 Presentations

The presentations were addressed in a manner which was suitable for local farmers to make them easy to follow the presentation and address their matters of concerns at the discussion. In this regard, the presentations were conducted mainly in local language (i.e. Sundanese language) and the help of provincial counterparts, either acting as presenters themselves or translators, had made this possible.

The presentation was conducted for the following topics:

- 1) General explanation of the project,
- 2) Present Condition (Socioeconomy and agriculture etc.),
- 3) Proposed plan,
- 4) Project implementation.

#### 2.2 Result of the Public Hearing

#### 2.2.1 Conclusion of the Discussion

From the discussion at all model areas, it was concluded that topics of presentation were fully understood by all participants including the intended beneficiary farmers. Their full support for the plan and its implementation had been also granted. It was important to note that the farmers and local government had also confirmed that they were willing to provide land required for development of water facility, marketing roads, collection center etc. without asking for payments for the land. Woman organization, i.e., PKK had also addressed their concern and support for the project. Details of the discussions are presented in paragraph 2.2.

#### **CHAPTER 3** PUBLIC SUPPORTS

#### 3.1 List of NGO working in West Java

The participation of NGO is required to hear the opinions and demands of the beneficiary farmers effectively in the Study and project implementation and to ensure the beneficiary's participation. The project implementation plan is prepared with involvement of NGO for coordination with the project side and beneficiaries.

In the Second Stage Study, the potential and possibility of participation of NGO working in West Java area were examined from the data and information collected. Then some NGO was selected and requested to join the Study work, which was characterized in forest preservation and natural resources, and enhancement of inhabitants' living condition and welfare.

NGO conducted (a) the preparatory works of public hearings, participation in public hearings, and hearing of beneficiaries' intentions on the proposed project plans, (b) additional socioeconomic survey inclusive of rural society activities.

NGOs working in West Java are shown in Table X-5.

#### 3.2 Special Program to Overcome the Impacts of Economic Crisis

The District Endeavor Program to Overcome the Impacts of Economic Crisis (Program Pemberdayaan Daerah Dalam Mengatasi Dampak Krisis Ekonomi: PDM-DKE<sup>1</sup>) is on-going in West Java area with the following objectives:

- (1) To increase the purchasing capacity of the poor in rural and city by creating the opportunities for employment;
- (2) To reactivate the public economy by rebuilding the economic and social infrastructure which supports the production and distribution system of goods and service;
- (3) To increase the public socioeconomic facilities and infrastructure functions.

This program is implemented by giving the working capital for developing the productive activities, and improving the facilities and infrastructures that are supporting the rural socioeconomy. The main targets are as follows:

-

Refer to : Petunjuk Pelaksanaan "Program Pemberdayaan Daerah Dalam Mengatasi Dampak Krisis Ekonomi (PDM-DKE)" 1998/1999

- (1) Accommodating of work searcher in all development sectors;
- (2) Improving of small and middle public economic activities;
- (3) Increasing of the purchasing capacity;
- (4) Maintenance of the socioeconomic infrastructures.

The priority of PDM-DKE support are given to:

- (1) Activities which directly result in increasing of the employment opportunities and public income;
- (2) Development activities of infrastructures which support the socioeconomic activities by involving of the villagers.

This program is provided to the rural and city areas that fall in (a). jobless, (b) insufficient income to fill daily needs, education, health and other economic needs. The management of the program is based on the following:

- Quick disbursement
- Transparency
- Accountability
- Sustainability

The PDM-DKE program consists of the following three groups:

- (1) BLM: Bantuan Langsung Masyarakat
- (2) BOP: Bantuan Operasional dan Pengendalian
- (3) BM: Bantuan Manajemen

The information of the program provided in the Districts related to the model area is given in Table  $X-6^2$ . The following shows the management criteria of PDM-DKE program.

- (1) The fund can directly be used to rehabilitate and develop the small industry;
- (2) The fund delivery should always be based on results of public meeting;
- (3) The villagers should be involved in planing, operating and maintaining of this program;
- (4) Activities for this program have to be discussed in LKMD;
- (5) Villagers should be responsible for maintenance and further development;
- (6) The fund should not be used for land compensation;
- (7) The first fund will be given after all the preparation is finished, and then the next fund will be given based on the first results;
- (8) The public, which actively participates in this program, can receive an

incentive based on man-day and not more than regional minimum salary in every district.




Figure X-1 Organization Structure of Government Office




Figure X-2 Organization Structure of Bupati Office




Figure X-3 Organization Structure of Camat Office




Figure X-4 Organization Structure of Food Crops Service in District Level-II Cianjur





Figure X-5 Organization Structure of Desa

## CHART OF FAMILY WELFARE EDUCATION (PKK) MOVING MECHANISM IN VILLAGE/POLITIC DISTRICT




Figure X-7 Organization Structure of PKK




Figure X-8 Organization Structure of Department of Cooperation Small and Midium Entreprise of Garut District




Figure X-9 Organization Structure of Department of BIPP of Garut District
