1. INVITATION

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Employer is the Mechanical and Electrical Department (MED) on behalf of the North Sinai Development Organization (NSDO) of the Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation (MWRI) of the Arab Republic of Egypt (A.R.E.).

- Financing Agencies: The foreign currency component of the project is financed through the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development. The local currency component is financed by the Investment Bank of Egypt (IBE).
- 1.2 Tenders are invited for construction of "The Conveyance System of El Sheikh Gaber El Sabbah Canal Between KM 108.466 and KM 118.560 El Salaam No.7 (Bir El Abd) Pumping Station of the North Sinai Development Project" and are to be based solely on the information contained in these Tender Documents, which supersede any other information previously given or implied by the Employer, the Consulting Engineer or any of their employees or agents.

2. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

- 2.1 Tenders must be prepared in accordance with the stipulations contained in these Instructions to Tenderers and delivered by the date and time and at the place specified therein. Tenders received after this deadline will not be considered.
- 2.2 The Tender shall be prepared in triplicate, one Original and two Copies, as specified below in Item 4 "Documents to be Submitted", and shall be submitted by hand against a dated receipt or by registered mail to arrive by the due date and time.

3. PREPARATION OF TENDER

3.1 Tenderers are advised to visit the site of the Works during the period and obtain for themselves all relevant information that may be necessary for the preparation of the Tender. Such a visit shall be at the Tenderer's expense and shall take place within 4 weeks of the Invitation for Tender being issued. Tenderers shall supply a list of names of the people visiting who shall not exceed 5 in number. Passes will be required to visit the East Bank of the Suez Canal and Tenderers should make their own arrangement to obtain these. Transport to the site shall be at the expense of the Tenderers.

The area of land made available for working areas or the erection of accommodation and workshops is shown on the Tender Drawings. Tenderers should ascertain for themselves that this is adequate for the purpose. If the successful Tenderer (Contractor) requires additional land area on the East Bank,

work site area can be made available by the MWRI. If the Contractor requires additional areas on the West Bank, outside those shown on the drawings then the Contractor will be responsible for all costs, discussion and negotiation with the land owners and for all necessary access roads, for all land outside the boundary shown on the drawings. Tenderer's attention is drawn to the bund to be constructed as temporary works around the total required area.

Tenderers and any of their servants or agents will be granted permission by the Employer, on application, to enter such areas for the purpose of such a visit in connection with the submission of a Tender but only on the condition that such a visit is solely at the risk of the Tenderers, their servants or agents.

The Employer will neither be responsible for, nor pay any expenses or losses which may be incurred by any Tenderer in the preparation of his Tender or when visiting the site.

- 3.2 No unauthorized alterations shall be made to any of the Tender Documents. If such an alteration is made or if the Bills of Quantities are not properly completed and extended or if these Instructions to Tenderers are not fully complied with, the Tender may be rejected.
- 3.3 The Tenderer is advised that the Conditions of Contract are based on the International Conditions of Contract adopted by Arab National and Regional Development Financial Institutions.
- 3.4 The time in which the Tenderer undertakes to complete the Works shall be fortyeight (48) months.
- 3.5 The attention of the Tenderer is drawn to the need to allow in his Tender for cooperating with other authorities and bodies and for carefully programming the Works so that other authorities and bodies can fulfill any requirements of them.
- 3.6 During the period of validity stated hereinafter in these Instructions to Tenderers, the Tender shall be irrevocable and all rates, prices stated therein shall be firm, subject only to the variations allowed for in the Conditions of Contract.
- 3.7 Queries and Addenda

The submission of a Tender shall be indicative that the Tenderer has fully understood the requirements of the Tender. Should the Tenderer have any queries whatsoever as to the meaning of any Tender Documents, or any risk, liability or obligation to be undertaken by the Tenderer, then such queries shall be addressed to the Employer in writing not later than 30 days before the due date for the submission of Tenders. A list of all questions referred to the Employer by the Tenderers and the answers thereto shall be forwarded to each of the Tenderers through formal addendum.

Addenda to the Tender Documents may be issued before but not later than 14 days prior to the closing date for receipt of Tenders for the purpose of clarifying the documents, or to reflect modifications in the design, specifications or Contract terms.

Any Interpretation of Tender Documents or supplementary information will be made only by formal addenda. No responsibility will be taken by the Employer for any other interpretation.

Each addendum issued will be distributed to each Joint Venture to whom the Tender Documents have been sold.

All addenda issued will become part of the Tender Documents and Tenderer shall acknowledge receipt by signing the form and returning the same to the Employer, and shall insert the addenda numbers in the space provided for in the Tender Form.

This procedure will not confer any right to an extension of time for submitting tenders.

- 3.8 The Tender shall be prepared by the Tenderer at their own cost.
- 3.9 The Tenderer shall complete all the forms and other information required in these Instructions to Tenderers.
- 3.10 Obtaining the rates for taxes, customs duties, social insurance etc., is the sole responsibility of the Tenderer.

4. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

4.1 The Tender shall be completed in ink and submitted on the forms supplied with the Tender Documents. The tender forms and accompanying documents shall not be detached and no alteration shall be made to any part of the original Tender Documents. The Tender Form shall be signed by a director of the Tenderer or such person authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer. All the pages of the Tender shall be either signed or initialed by the said authorized person.

The Tender shall be submitted in three sets, one Original and two Copies. Each set shall consist of Technical Envelope and Financial Envelope as described below. The Original set shall be completed using the Tender Documents provided.

In the event of any discrepancy between the Original and the Copies (except for the non-existence of the Group C documents in the Copies of the Technical Envelope

as described in Sub-Item 4.3 below), the Tender may be disqualified.

4.2 As the present Tender shall be evaluated by a 2-envelope system, the documents to be submitted shall be edited in the following manner:

The documents shall be divided and placed in two envelopes, i.e., the Technical Envelope and the Financial Envelope as described in Sub-Items 4.3 and 4.4. These two envelopes shall be again put in an Overall Envelope. All these 3 kinds of envelopes shall be of double cover type, sealed and carry the following descriptions on the covers.

4.3 Technical Envelope

Technical Envelope shall comprise the following 3 groups of documents:

Group A

The documents of this group shall become part of the Contract Documents.

- A1) Cover letter (free style, but do not mention the Tender Price)
- A2) Eligibility and Certificate of Pre-Qualification of all JV partners (Photocopies)
- A3) Tender Bond (on Bank's Letterhead)
- A4) Power of Attorney

- A5) Joint Venture Agreement
- A6) Schedule of Technical Data (Use the original Tender Documents Volume II-2) The Tenderer shall fill in the technical data required in this schedule.
- A7) Alternative Proposals, if any, together with detailed design documents, drawings and technical specifications.

Group B

The following documents shall be prepared using the Tenderer's own formats. These are required for the purposes of assessing the Contractor's Tender and comparing the various Tenders received. It is not intended that these documents will form part of the Contract between the Employer and the successful Tenderer.

- B1) An organization chart showing clear demarcation among the JV partners and Named Specialist Sub-Contractors and clear definition of powers and duties of each staff in the organization. It shall also indicate the composition and role of the home office co-ordination and steering committee consisting of all JV partners.
- B2) A preliminary but comprehensive network showing the Tenderer's proposed procedure and the programme for constructing the Works in accordance with the Contract, together with such additional information the Tenderer wishes to submit in support thereof.
- B3) A histogram showing staff (managers, engineers and specialized technicians) and labour whom the Tenderer anticipates employing to construct the Works. The histogram shall differentiate direct employees and those employed by the Tenderer's sub-contractors.
- B4) Curriculum Vitae of all staff anticipated to be employed on the Contract.
- B5) A list of the major Constructional Plant to be used.
- B6) A statement detailing the method and procedure of dewatering during the construction of the pumping station.
- B7) A list of the works which are anticipated to be sub-contracted other than those works to be carried out by Nominated Specialist Sub-Contractors.
- B8) A list of all permanent materials showing the proposed sources and suppliers.

Group C

The following original Tender Documents shall be included in the documents to be submitted as a token of acceptance of the same by the Tenderer. The Group C documents are required only in the "Original" envelope of the Tender and not required to be included in the "Copy" envelopes.

- C1) Volume I-2: Conditions of Contract, Parts I and II
- C2) Volume II-1: Technical Specifications
- C3) Addenda issued during the Tender Period
- 4.4 Financial Envelope

Financial Envelope shall comprise the following documents which shall become part of the Contract Documents.

- 1) Tender Form together with the Appendices, which should not be detached from Volume I-1 "Invitation for Tender and Instructions to Tenderers"
- 2) Volume III: Bill of Quantities together with Appendix A "Daywork Schedules"
- 3) Detailed Supplementary Schedules (Breakdown of all Tender Rates and Lump Sums) as per Sub-Item 4.7
- 4) Alternative Proposal, if any: The Cost comparative tables compared to the original specifications
- 4.5 Joint Venture Agreement, Power(s) of Attorney and Form No.14

Duly authenticated copies of the Joint Venture Agreement defining the constitution of the Tenderer together with its powers of attorney and other relevant documents shall be included in the Technical Envelope so as to show by what persons and in what manner, Contract may be entered into by or on behalf of the Tenderer and which persons are directly responsible for the due execution of such contract and can give valid receipts on behalf of the Tenderer.

The signature of the person allowed to sign on behalf of the Tenderer in connection with the Tender or a possible Contract Agreement must be given on the same authenticated copies of the Joint Venture Agreement or powers of attorney.

If the original documents are not written in English language, a certified translation of each document must be submitted with the Tender.

The said documents must be legalized at the place of issue by such authorities as are automatically accepted for the performance of such duties.

The Tenderer shall include in the Technical Envelope his local commercial agent's Form No. 14.

Any Tender not containing the said documents or if such documents are incomplete or do not conform to the aforesaid may at the discretion of the Employer be excluded from the adjudication.

4.6 Alternative Proposal

The Tenderer shall submit a Tender covering the whole scope of the present Tender Documents. Tenders covering only a part of the whole scope shall be disqualified. The Tenderers shall either submit fully compliant Tenders or are allowed to propose alternative materials and/or construction methods with the following exceptions, for which no alternatives will be permitted.

- a) Number of pumping units/type of pump unit being vertical, pump speed being open
- b) Number of discharge pipe lines
- c) Dimensions of discharge pipe lines and material being steel
- d) Design drawings of civil works including pipelines

The Tenderer who wishes to offer alternative proposal(s) shall submit detailed design documents, drawings and technical specifications as well as cost comparative tables compared to the original specifications. The detailed design documents, drawings and technical specifications shall be included in the Technical Envelope and the cost comparative tables compared to the original specifications shall be included in the Financial Envelope.

4.7 Bill of Quantities, Daywork Schedules & Detailed Supplementary Schedules

Tenderers must insert rates against all items in the Bills of Quantities and these shall be extended, with the exception of lump sum items. Items against which no price is entered by the Tenderer will be deemed to be covered by the rates against other items in the Bills of Quantities.

Tenderers must complete the Daywork Schedules of Rates for Labour and Plant as well as the percentage rate for the Materials to be used in calculating the cost of work to be done on Dayworks.

All insertions in the Tender Documents shall be in ink. Any alterations shall be initialed by the person signing the Form of Tender.

The rates inserted by the Tenderer against the items in the Bills of Quantities shall be for the full inclusive value of the finished work described and shall include for profit and all obligations and liabilities of every kind arising out of the Contract.

Tenderers shall provide with their Tenders, Detailed Supplementary Schedules breaking down all Tender rates for units of work and lump sums in the Bills of Quantities into their component parts of labour, constructional plant, materials, temporary works and overheads and profit with full analysis of each part.

4.8 Tender Price and Currencies

The rates and prices quoted in the Bills of Quantities shall be in Egyptian pounds in the column marked "Local Currency", and in a currency of the Tenderer's choosing in the column marked "Foreign Currency", such currency to be a recognized convertible currency and clearly defined.

- a) For goods and services which the Tenderer will supply from within A.R.E., the rate shall be quoted in Egyptian Pounds,
- b) For goods and services which the Tenderer will supply from outside A.R.E., the rate shall be quoted in the foreign currency,
- c) For goods and services which the Tenderer will supply partly from within A.R.E., and partly from outside A.R.E., the rate shall be quoted both in Egyptian Pounds and in the foreign currency,

The goods and services available in A.R.E. should be given preference as far as their quality and quantity available in A.R.E. meet the Specifications. As for the steel sheets to be used for the fabrication of the pressured delivery pipes, the Tenderers are to evaluate carefully the quality and quantity available in the local market and to decide on the percentage distribution between the local and foreign currencies.

The total amounts given in the Tender Form which are expressed in Egyptian and in the foreign currencies together constitute the total Tender Price and each amount shall be stated in figures and words. No conditions related to exchange rates shall be stated in the Tender.

The Tenderers shall also note that the local currency component shall not be less than 35% of the total Tender Sum.

Tenderers must include in their offered price any work or item not stated or overlooked in the specification or the scope of works and have it included in the rates and Tender Price.

4.9 Lump Sum Adjustment

Should the Tenderer require to make any lump sum adjustment to his Tender prior to submission then such adjustment shall be inserted in the appropriate space on the summary page of the Bills of Quantities.

4.10 Validity Period of Tender

The period of validity of the Tender shall be 150 days from the deadline date of the Tender submission.

4.11 Tender Bond (Bid Bond) & Performance Bond

Each Tenderer shall enclose with his Tender, a Bank certified cheque or a Banker's guarantee as a Tender Bond (Bid Bond) issued by a first class Bank, and endorsed by an Egyptian Bank acceptable to the Employer for an amount of 2% of the tender value in the same currencies.

The above Tender Bond shall be in the form attached to these Instructions to Tenderers. It will be converted into a Performance Bond of 10% of the Initial Contract Price by the successful Tenderer.

The period of validity of the Tender Bond shall be at least 180 days.

In the event of the Tenderer withdrawing his Tender before the expiration of the period of validity previously stated, or failing to execute a formal Contract, the amount of the Tender Bond in respect of the Tender shall be confiscated in favour of the Employer.

The successful Tenderer shall present a letter of guarantee as a Performance Bond in the form attached to these Instructions to Tenderers issued by a first class Bank, and endorsed by an Egyptian Bank acceptable to the Employer for an amount of 10% (ten percent) of the Initial Contract Price and in the same currencies. Said Performance Bond has to be presented within 28 days of receipt by the Contractor of the Letter of Acceptance of his Tender, but not later than the date of expiration of the period of validity of the Tender Bond, or any agreed extension hereto.

The Employer will return the Tender Bond to the Successful Tenderer on receipt of the Performance Bond.

The Tender Bonds of unsuccessful Tenderers will be returned as soon as the successful Tenderer has provided the Performance Bond, however not later than the date of expiration of the period of validity of the Tender Bond or of any agreed extensions hereto.

5. EVALUATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER

- 5.1 The Employer will not be obliged to accept the lowest or any Tender, or to give explanation for any such decision.
- 5.2 Two Envelope System of Tender Evaluation

The evaluation of the Tenders and selection of the successful Tenderer shall be conducted in two steps using the Two Envelope System. Each Tender is submitted in two envelopes, i.e., Technical Envelope and Financial Envelope, as described in Item 4 "Documents to be Submitted". First, only the Technical Envelopes will be opened and evaluated by the Technical Committee of the Employer. The result of the evaluation for each Tender shall be either "passed" or "failed". Then, the Financial Envelope of only the "passed" Tenderers will be opened and the lowest price Tenderer shall be the successful Tenderer.

- 5.3 The Bills of Quantities will be checked arithmetically and in the event of there being any mistakes in the extension of unit rates, the summation of any pages or Bill totals or the carrying forward of any sum, then the Tender shall be amended and the Tender Sum revised accordingly.
- 5.4 All tender prices will be valued in terms of Egyptian Pounds (L.E.) using the selling rates of exchange published by the Central Bank of Egypt, applicable to similar transactions, on the day the tenders are opened (for the purpose of evaluation).
- 5.5 All reservations shall be evaluated in terms of cost and added to the total Tender price, for the purpose of comparison only. If the successful Tenderer has submitted reservations in his Tender, the details shall be negotiated with him during the Contract negotiations.
- 5.6 Qualification of JV Lead Partner

The Lead Partner of the Tenderer shall fill in Forms A and B. If the Employer finds him lacking qualification as JV Lead Partner, the JV members shall negotiate among themselves and select another Lead Partner and resubmit the Forms A and B. If at the end of this procedure none of the JV members are found to be unqualified as JV Leader, the Tenderer shall be disqualified.

6. **GENERAL**

6.1 The Tenderer's attention is drawn to the fact that the Tender and the Contract will be administrated in the English language, but the law of the Contract will be that of the Arab Republic of Egypt.

- 6.2 The Tenderer shall state in his Cover Letter the address to which all correspondence concerning his Tender shall be addressed.
- 6.3 The details of the Tender Documents are confidential and details should not be communicated to any party other than for the specific purpose of compiling a Tender. All Tenders will be treated in the strictest confidence.
- 6.4 These Tender Documents are subject to the revision of the Egyptian Sate Council and the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development. Any modifications issued by either of them will be sent to the Tenderers according to item 3.7 of these instructions.
- 6.5 The Tenderer shall investigate the work site conditions on his own before submitting his Tender. He shall be deemed to have satisfied himself on all aspects of site conditions when he submits his Tender. A geological survey report of the work site is available for reviewing to any Tenderers at the same address shown in the Invitation for Tender. However, any conclusion drawn from the said report is at the Tenderers' responsibility, and the Employer, the Engineer or any other entity concerned with the said report cannot be held responsible in any way for the contents of the report.

7. DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKS

The construction sites extend in the Bir El Abd area located approximately 40 km southwest of El Arish city.

The Contract comprises construction of 10.1 km long water conveyance canal consisting of the following:

- Reinforced concrete type sand settling basin with roller gates system and connecting canal
- No. 7 pumping station and building equipped with 4 units vertical shaft volute pump (diameter 1,900 mm x 1,500 mm), 4 units main motor (13,000 kW) and auxiliary sub-station and related equipment
- Diameter 2,400 mm pressured delivery steel pipes, 3 rows x 9.35 km with 6 units one-way surge tanks
- Reinforced concrete type discharge tank
- No. 3 access road between national highway and No. 7 Pumping Station
