During its stay in the Republic of Indonesia, a series of meetings on the Study were held between the Contact Mission and the officials from the Government of the Republic of Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as "GOI") and other organizations concerned. The attendants of the meeting are listed in Appendix 1. Through these meetings, both sides agreed the following points on the Study.

I. Objectives of the Study

The objectives of the Study are:

- 1. to formulate Sabang Integrated Economic Development Zone (SIEDZ) regional development master plan for 2020,
- 2. to conduct pre-feasibility study on prioritized projects identified under the Study, and
- 3. to help strengthen the planning capacity of Indonesian counterpart personnel through the implementation of the Study.

II. Study Area

The Study Area covers SIEDZ of 264 km² and its influential area of Banda Aceh.

III. Schedule of the Study

The Study will be carried out in accordance with the attached tentative schedule (Appendix 2).



 - (3) suitable office space with necessary equipment in Sabang and Jakarta; and
 - (4) credentials or identification cards.

VIII. UNDERTAKING OF JICA

- 2. to pursue technology transfer to the Indonesian counterpart personnel in the course of the Study.
