In accordance with the Scope of the Work for the Study on the Integrated Development Master Plan in the Northern Region for Agriculture and Livestock of the State of Tocantins (hereinafter referred to as "the Study"), the Government of Japan through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) dispatched the Study Team headed by Mr. Satoru KIDO and the Advisory Team headed by Mr. Toshio OGAWA for the implementation of the Study in the State of Tocantins in the Federative Republic of Brazil. At the commencement of the Study, the Study Team submitted officially twenty five (25) copies (15 in English and 10 in Portuguese) of the Inception Report to the Government of the State of Tocantins and explained the contents of the Report at the presence of the concerned officials of the State of Tocantins government, the Secretariat of Production (hereinafter referred to as "SEPRO-TO") and Secretariat of Planning and Environment (hereinafter referred to as "SEPLAN-TO"), on April 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>, 2000. As a result of an explanation and exchange of opinions on the Report, the following has been agreed upon by both State of Tocantins and Japanese sides.

- 1. At the beginning of the meeting, the State of Tocantins side explained the change of the State Organization chart. Since February the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2000, the Secretariat of Agriculture has merged with the Secretariat of Industry and Commerce forming the Secretariat of Production. In this connection, the agencies concerned to this Study are thus the Secretariat of Production (SEPRO) and the Secretariat of Planning and Environment (SEPLAN).
- 2. The Tocantins State side agreed with the contents of the Inception Report which had been prepared in due compliance with the conditions set forth in the Scope of the Work for the Study.
- 3. Both parties shall cooperate for the effective and timely implementation of the present Study in such manner as to accomplish the objectives of the Study and to keep work schedule as contemplated in the Inception Report.
- 4. The Japanese side requested to the State of Tocantins side to assign at least one full time counterpart personnel for each Japanese expert so that the Japanese Study Team may undertake on-the-job training to these counterpart personnel as required in the Scope of the Work for the Study.
