
Letter of Transmittal

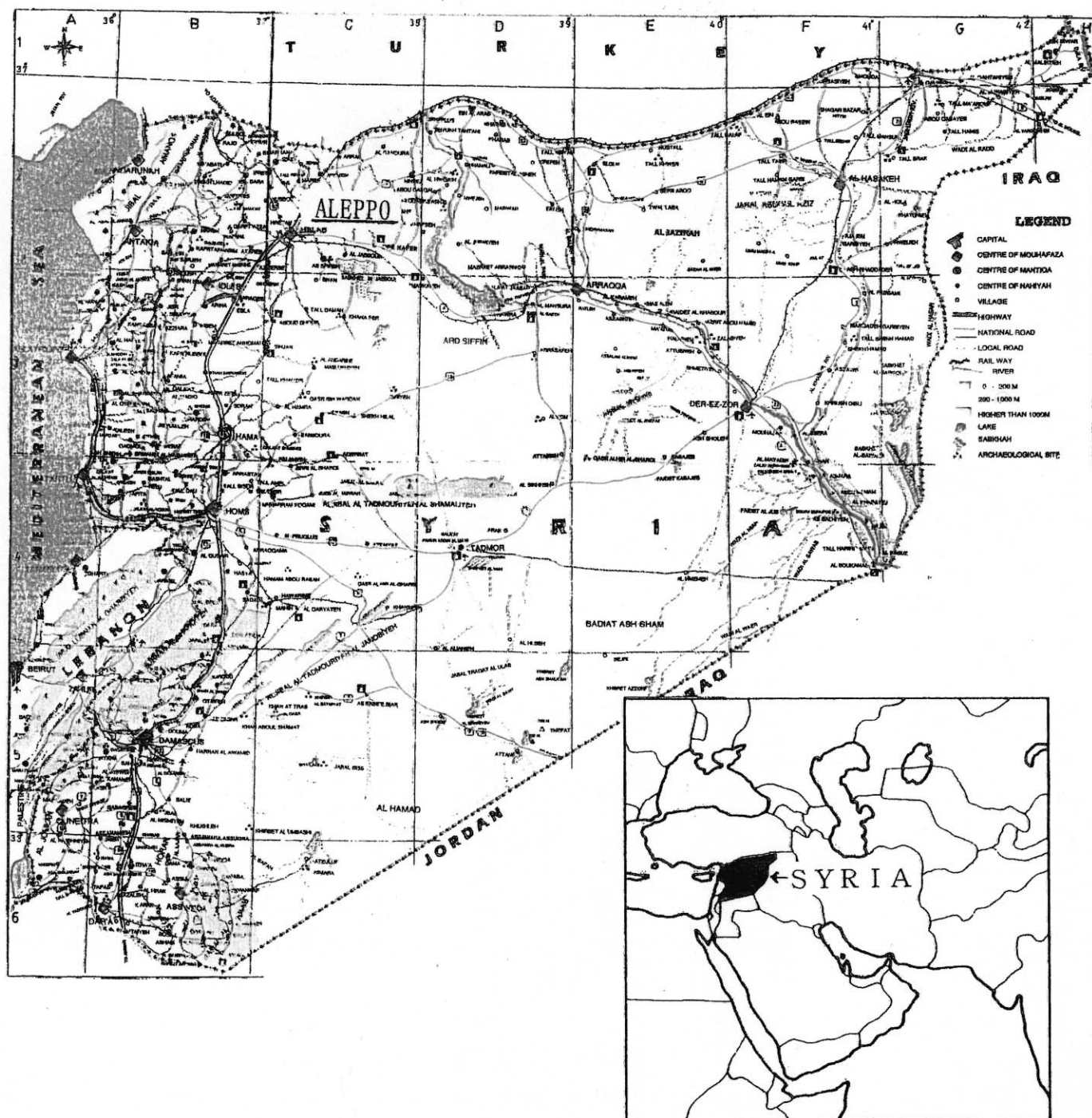
