


## No.16 Rao Sau ( Quang Binh Prov.)

## Other Information

- The approach road of the right bank is larger than the left bank. No passing of a car. About 200m from Provincial road.
- 2) It crosses on the bamboo bridge. A ferryboat is about 5.0m. 100 users/day
- It is greatly flooded from the right bank being located in a sandbank in flood.
   The left bank is flooded on an attachment road
- 4) Because of navigation clearance, a bridge position becomes high and construction of an attachment road is difficult.




## No.17 Ben Cung ( Quang Binh Prov.)

## Other Information

- An access road is a bad road very much.
   The center of a town is in a left-bank side.
- It walks across in dry season, but it has no used trace.The attachment road of the right bank is waterway.
- 3) Vehicles are returned and crossed to a downstream to the national highway No. 15. (submerged bridge 10km downstream)
- 4) It branches from the national highway No. 15, and a railroad is crossed immediately. The attachment of a crossing part is bad. Reinforcement is required for passing.
