IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA


Based on the results of the Preparatory Study, the Government of Japan decided to conduct a Basic Design Study on the Project for Improvement of Community Based Rehabilitation Center (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") and entrusted the study to the Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter referred to as "JICA").

JICA sent to Bosnia and Herzegovina the Basic Design Study Team (hereinafter referred to as "the Team"), which is headed by Mr. Katsutoshi Ishikawa, Grant Aid Division, Economic Cooperation Bureau, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and is scheduled to stay in the country from 23rd, August 2001 to 28th, September 2001.

The Team held discussions with the officials concerned of the Government and conducted a field survey at the study area.

In the course of discussions and field survey, both parties confirmed the main items described on the attached sheets. The Team will proceed to further works and prepare the Basic Design Study Report.



ATTACHMENT

1. Objective of the Project

The objective of the Project is to improve rehabilitative services in the Republic of Srpska through procurement of equipment and renovation of facilities of the Community Based Rehabilitation Centers (hereinafter referred to as "the CBR Centers").

2. Project sites

The sites of the Project are 17 CBR Centers as shown in Annex-1.

3. Responsible and Implementing Agency

3-1. The Responsible Agency is Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, Republic of Srpska.

3-2. The Implementing Agency is Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, Republic of Srpska.

4. Items requested by the Government

After discussions with the Team, equipment described in Annex-2 and renovation works for the CBR Centers listed in Annex-1 were finally requested. JICA will assess the appropriateness of the request and will recommend to the Government of Japan for approval.

5. Japan's Grant Aid Scheme

5-1. The Government understands the Japan's Grant Aid Scheme explained by the Team, as described in Annex-3.

5-2. The Government will take the necessary measures, as described in Annex-4, for smooth implementation of the Project, as a condition for the Japanese Grant Aid to be implemented.

6. Schedule of the Study

6-1. The consultants will proceed to further studies in Bosnia and Herzegovina until September 28th, 2001.

6-2. JICA will prepare the draft report in English and dispatch a mission in order to explain its contents around January 2002.

6-3. In case that the contents of the report is accepted in principle by the Government, JICA will complete the final report and send it to the Government by April 2002.

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7. Other relevant issues

7-1. The items and number of the equipment will be decided through further analysis.

7-2. Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, Republic of Srpska, will secure necessary budget for the operation and maintenance of the 17 CBR Centers, and sufficient number of personnel for the Project.

7-3. The Government requested vehicles necessary for the Project.

7-4. The Government requested the consultant services for management of the CBR Centers as one of the components of the Grant Aid.

7-5. For the sake of the technology transfer on sustainable operation and maintenance of the Project, the Government pointed out the need for dispatch of Japanese experts as well as technical training of counterpart personnel in Japan. They also understood that another official request on technical cooperation should be submitted through diplomatic channels.

Annex-3 : JAPAN'S GRANT AID SCHEME

1. Grant Aid Procedure

1) Japan's Grant Aid Program is executed through the following procedures.

Application	(Request made by a recipient country)
Study	(Basic Design Study conducted by JICA)
Appraisal & Approval	(Appraisal by the Government of Japan and Approval by Cabinet)
Determination of Implementation	(The Notes exchanged between the Governments of Japan and the recipient country)

2) Firstly, the application or request for a Grant Aid project submitted by a recipient country is examined by the Government of Japan (the Ministry of Foreign Affairs) to determine whether or not it is eligible for Grant Aid. If the request is deemed appropriate, the Government of Japan assigns JICA to conduct a study on the request. If necessary, JICA send a Preliminary Study Team to the recipient country to confirm the contents of the request.

Secondly, JICA conducts the study (Basic Design Study), using Japanese consulting firms.

Thirdly, the Government of Japan appraises the project to see whether or not it is suitable for Japan's Grant Aid Programme, based on the Basic Design Study report prepared by JICA, and the results are then submitted to the Cabinet for approval.

Fourthly, the project, once approved by the Cabinet, becomes official with the Exchange of Notes signed by the Governments of Japan and the recipient country.

Finally, for the implementation of the project, JICA assists the recipient country in such matters as preparing tenders, contracts and so on.

2. Basic Design Study

1) Contents of the Study

The aim of the Basic Design Study (hereinafter referred to as "the Study"), conducted by JICA on a requested project (hereinafter referred to as "the Project"), is to provide a basic document necessary for the appraisal of the Project by the Government of Japan. The contents of the Study are as follows:

- a) confirmation of the background, objectives and benefits of the Project and also institutional capacity of agencies concerned of the recipient country necessary for the Project's implementation;
- b) evaluation of the appropriateness of the Project to be implemented under the Grant Aid Scheme from the technical, social and economic points of view;
- c) confirmation of items agreed on by both parties concerning the basic concept of the Project;
- d) preparation of a basic design of the Project; and
- e) estimation of costs of the Project.

The contents of the original request are not necessarily approved in their initial form as the contents of the Grant Aid project. The Basic Design of the Project is confirmed considering the guidelines of Japan's Grant Aid Scheme.

The Government of Japan requests the Government of the recipient country to take whatever measures are necessary to ensure its self-reliance in the implementation of the Project. Such measures must be guaranteed

even though they may fall outside of the jurisdiction of the organization in the recipient country actually implementing the Project. Therefore, the implementation of the Project is confirmed by all relevant organizations of the recipient country through the Minutes of Discussions.

2) Selection of Consultants

For the smooth implementation of the Study, JICA uses a consulting firm selected through its own procedure (competitive proposal). The selected firm participates the Study and prepares a report based upon the terms of reference set by JICA.

At the beginning of implementation after the Exchange of Notes, for the services of the Detailed Design and Supervision of the Project, JICA recommends the same consulting firm which participated in the Study to the recipient country, in order to maintain the technical consistency between the Basic Design and Detailed Design as well as to avoid any undue delay caused by the selection of a new consulting firm.

3. Japan's Grant Aid Scheme

1) What is Grant Aid?

The Grant Aid Program provides a recipient country with non-reimbursable funds to procure the facilities, equipment and services (engineering services and transportation of the products, etc.) for economic and social development of the country under principles in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Japan. Grant Aid is not supplied through the donation of materials as such.

2) Exchange of Notes (E/N)

Japan's Grant Aid is extended in accordance with the Notes exchanged by the two Governments concerned, in which the objectives of the project, period of execution, conditions and amount of the Grant Aid, etc., are confirmed.

3) "The period of the Grant" means the one fiscal year which the Cabinet approves the project for. Within the fiscal year, all procedure such as exchanging of the Notes, concluding contracts with consulting firms and contractors and final payment to them must be completed.

However, in case of delays in delivery, installation or construction due to unforeseen factors such as weather, the period of the Grant Aid can be further extended for a maximum of one fiscal year at most by mutual agreement between the two Governments.

4) Under the Grant, in principle, Japanese products and services including transport or those of the recipient country are to be purchased.

When the two Governments deem it necessary, the Grant Aid may be used for the purchase of the products or services of a third country.

However, the prime contractors, namely consulting, contracting and procurement firms, are limited to "Japanese nationals". (The term "Japanese nationals" means persons of Japanese nationality or Japanese corporations controlled by persons of Japanese nationality.)

5) Necessity of "Verification"

The Government of the recipient country or its designated authority will conclude contracts denominated in Japanese yen with Japanese nationals. Those contracts shall be verified by the Government of Japan. This "Verification" is deemed necessary to secure accountability of Japanese taxpayers.

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- 6) Undertakings required to the Government of the recipient country
- a) to secure a lot of land necessary for the construction of the Project and to clear the site;
 - b) to provide facilities for distribution of electricity, water supply and drainage and other incidental facilities outside the site;
 - c) to ensure prompt unloading and customs clearance at ports of disembarkation in the recipient country and internal transportation therein of the products purchased under the Grant Aid;
 - d) to exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and fiscal levies which may be imposed in the recipient country with respect to the supply of the products and services under the verified contracts;
 - e) to accord Japanese nationals whose services may be required in connection with the supply of the products and services under the verified contracts such as facilities as may be necessary for their entry into the recipient country and stay therein for the performance of their work;
 - f) to ensure that the facilities constructed and products purchased under the Grant Aid be maintained and used properly and effectively for the Project; and
 - g) to bear all the expenses, other than those covered by the Grant Aid, necessary for the Project.
- 7) "Proper Use"
The recipient country is required to maintain and use the facilities constructed and equipment purchased under the Grant Aid properly and effectively and to assign the necessary staff for operation and maintenance of them as well as to bear all the expenses other than those covered by the Grant Aid.
- 8) "Re-export"
The products purchased under the Grant Aid shall not be re-exported from the recipient country.
- 9) Banking Arrangement (B/A)
- a) The Government of the recipient country or its designated authority should open an account in the name of the Government of the recipient country in a bank in Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank"). The Government of Japan will execute the Grant Aid by making payments in Japanese yen to cover the obligations incurred by the Government of the recipient country or its designated authority under the verified contracts.
 - b) The payments will be made when payment requests are presented by the Bank to the Government of Japan under an Authorization to Pay (A/P) issued by the Government of recipient country or its designated authority.

Annex-4: UNDERTAKINGS BY THE GOVERNMENT

1. To secure the facilities necessary for the Project;
2. To clear the facilities for the Project prior to the commencement of the renovation;
3. To provide proper access road to the Project sites;
4. To provide facilities for distribution of electricity, water supply, telephone trunk line and drainage and other incidental facilities outside the sites;
5. To repair main heating system in the facilities, if necessary;
6. To undertake incidental outdoor works, such as gardening, fencing, exterior lighting, and other incidental facilities in and around the Project sites, if necessary;
7. To ensure prompt unloading and customs clearance of the products purchased under the Japan's Grant Aid at ports of disembarkation in the Recipient Country;
8. To exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and fiscal levies which may be imposed in the Recipient Country with respect to the supply of the products and services under the verified contracts;
9. To accord Japanese nationals whose services may be required in connection with the supply of the products and services under the verified contracts such facilities as may be necessary for their entry into the Recipient Country and stay therein for the performance of their work;
10. To bear commissions, namely advising commissions of an Authorization to Pay (A/P) and payment commissions, to a bank of Japan for the banking services based upon the Banking Arrangement (B/A);
11. To provide necessary permissions, licenses, and other authorization for implementing the Project, if necessary;
12. To ensure that the facilities constructed and equipment purchased under the Japan's Grant Aid be maintained and used properly and effectively for the Project; and
13. To bear all the expenses, other than those covered by the Japan's Grant Aid, necessary for the Project.

MINUTES OF DISCUSSIONS
ON BASIC DESIGN STUDY ON THE PROJECT FOR IMOROVEMENT OF COMMUNITY
BASED REHABILITATION CENTER IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA
(EXPLANATION ON DRAFT REPORT)

In September, 2001, the Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter referred to as "JICA") dispatched a Basic Design Study Team on THE PROJECT FOR IMOROVEMENT OF COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION CENTER (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") to BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA, and through discussion, field survey, and technical examination of the results in Japan, JICA prepared a draft report of the study.

In order to explain and to consult the Government on the components of the draft report, JICA sent to the Government the Draft Report Explanation Team(hereinafter referred to as " the Team "), which is headed by Mr. Morimoto Yasuhiro, Deputy Director, Second Project Management Division, Grant Aid Management Department, JICA, from January 10, 2002 to January 26, 2002.

As a result of discussions, both parties confirmed the main items described on the attached sheets.

ATTACHMENT

1. Components of the Draft Report

The Government agreed and accepted in principle the components of the draft report explained by the Team.

2. Japan's Grant Aid scheme

The Government understands the Japan's Grant Aid Scheme and the necessary measures to be taken by the Government as explained by the Team and described in Annex-3 and Annex-4 of the Minutes of Discussions signed by both parties on September 19, 2001.

3. Schedule of the Study

JICA will complete the final report in accordance with the confirmed item and send it to the Government by March, 2002.

4. Other relevant issue

4-1. The Government will secure necessary budget for the operation and maintenance of the 17 CBR Centers, and sufficient number of personnel for the Project.

4-2. The Government promised that vehicles procured in the Project would be used exclusively for the Project, that is, to use them transportation of disabled persons and home visiting staff, and that the CBR Centers would keep operation records properly.

4-3. The Government confirmed to prepare the facility of CBR Center in Sokolac by the end of May, 2003.

4-4. For the sake of the technology transfer related to the Project, the Government pointed out the need for dispatch of Japanese experts as well as technical training of counterpart personnel in Japan. The Government also understood that another official request on technical cooperation should be submitted through diplomatic channels.

4-5. The Government will undertake the followings:

4-5-1. To clear the facilities for the Project prior to the commencement of renovation;

4-5-2. To provide, operate and maintain facilities for distribution

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of electricity, water supply, telephone, heating system and drainage outside the sites;

4-5-3. To construct entrance gates of the CBR Centers in Novi Grad and Sipovo;

4-5-4. To obtain building permit for the CBR Centers.
