IN INDONESIA**

I. JUSTICE REFORM

A. The recent problem which identified by ministry of justice or others agencies (government institution, NGO, donor agency) as follows :

- Point of view, mission, strategy and action plan of Attorney General's Office in short-term, mid and long-term compiled in integrated system, which concern to the level of discipline and consistent to the implementation of function and role of Attorney's Office by Human Resources.
- Limitation on the amount of APBN connected to the prosperity or minimum wages, operational cost, limitation on facility and infrastructure, and campaign program on economizing by State Minister for Effective State Apparatus (MENPAN).
- Low of quality of HRD concerned and low of quantity of Education & Training Centre, frequency of training per year, limitation on the amount of personnel who can join the training, low of comparative study to expand the understanding of perception and limitation on budget for training.
- Integrity of personality of Human Resources concerned with external and internal factor, working practice, discipline of work, intelligent character, supervision system, which concerned to the existence of appreciation of performance, reward and punishment to Human Resources behaviour.
- The elimination of corruption and serious offense of human rights which handled by Attorney's General Office which get community attention.

B. What kind of measures can be used to solve the above problems in "A"?

- Compiling point of view, mission, action plan of Attorney's General Office for short-term, mid and long-term. The existence of target achievement for 1,5 and 25 years, therefore indicator of target must be determined.
- Re-orientation of requitment system, position placement system, mutation system, supervision system and priority of training which conform to the recent needs.
- Appreciation system which follow with reward and punishment to HRD behaviour.
- Supporting Political Will from Legislative for raising the operational budget of Attorney's General Office, concerning the importance of Attorney's General Office's role in law and justice reform.

C. Reformation Policy and action program for justice reform :

- Raise of wages/allowance for Judge and Prosecutor.
- Housing Allowance/facilities for Judge and Prosecutor.
- Proper retired allowance for Judge and Prosecutor.
- Compiling Professional Ethical Code for Judge and Prosecutor.
- Formation of Professional Honor Council for Judge and Prosecutor for giving reward and punishment to disgraceful act.
- Giving appreciation for Judge and Prosecutor who has good performance.

D. The solution to handle recent problems for justice reform and the measures as follows :

- Allowance for Judge beginning from January 2001 about 3-5 times raised.
- Wages for personnel raised since January 2001.
- Recruitment of Region Prosecutor for helping to solve BLBI case.
- To probe cooperation aid with donor agencies as follows :
 - . AusAid (Australia) thru LRP (Law Reform Project)
 - . Government of New Zealand
 - . World Bank, IMF, UNDP, etc.

E. Priority Problem on justice reform :

- Development of facilities/infrastructure and Attorney's General Office in new 4 Provinces (Banten, Bangka-Belitung, Gorontalo, Maluku Utara).
- Development of management information system of Attorney's General Office Republic of Indonesia (SIMKARI) II as integrated network (on line) in all of Indonesia.
- Master Education Program (S2) or (S3) Doctor in :
Corruption, Human Rights, Terrorism, Money Laundering, Bankruptcy, Banking, Forensic and Asset Tracing (FORSAT), Criminal Investigation, Intelligent, Cyber Law, Drugs, Legal Drafter, Management Strategy, Management Planning and Japanese Language.
- Comparative Study regarding :
Organization management, Human Rights, Corruption, Criminal Affairs, Supervision System, Standardization facilities/infrastructure & Management Information System.
- Training :
Corruption, Human Rights, Terrorism, Money Laundering, Bankruptcy, Banking, Forensic and Asset Tracing (FORSAT), Criminal Investigation, Intelligent, Cyber Law, Drugs, Legal Drafter, Management Strategy, Management of Planning, Japanese Language.

II. DEVELOPMENT OF CAPACITY

A. The requirement and appointing system/examination for Judge and personnel as follows :

- Candidate of Judge has been chosen thru selected examination of Attorney's General with requirement minimum education in Master of Law, maximum age 26 years old, Indeks Performance (IP) 2.4, Height for Man 160 and Women 155, follow test : written, psikotest, computer, sports/health, interview. After accepted, therefore the candidate for Prosecutor has to work for about 2-3 years as administration staff in Attorney's General Office.
- Candidate of administration staff has been chosen thru selected examination of Attorney's General with requirement of minimum Senior High School graduation, maximum age 26 years old, Indeks of Performance (IP) 6.5, Height for Man 160, Man 155, follow test : written, computer, sports/health, interview. After accepted, the candidate works as administration staff in Attorney's General Office.

B. Training System for Prosecutor and others personnel.

- Training for Prosecutor and others personnel done at Training & Education Centre Attorney's General Office at Jl. HM Hasono, Ragunan, Jakarta Selatan.
- Candidate of Prosecutor to be Prosecutor has to follow PPJ (Education of Prosecutor Formation) at Training & Education Centre Attorney's General Office for 4 months.
- Training for Prosecutor consist of technical training including functional position; ADUM, SPAMA, Technical Training & Education, Pidsus, Pidum, Datun, Supervision, HAKI, Human Rights, etc.

C. Recent Problem which identified in development of capacity (quality) among Prosecutor and other justice staff :

- Establishment of Institution for Judiciary (PTIK) :
Facility for integrated education for qualified Prosecutor.
- S2 (Master) and S3 (Doctor) Education in :
Corruption, Human Rights, Terrorism, Money Laundering, Bankruptcy, Banking, Forensic and Asset Tracing (FORSAT), Criminal Investigation, Intelligent, Cyber Law, Drugs, Legal Drafter, Management Strategy, Management of Planning and Japanese Language.
- Comparative Study :
Management Organization, Human Rights, Corruption, Criminal Affairs, Supervision System, Standardization for facility/infrastructure and Management Information System.
- Training :
Corruption, Human Rights, Terrorism, Money Laundering, Bankruptcy, Banking, Forensic and Asset Tracing (FORSAT), Criminal Investigation, Intelligent, Cyber Law, Drugs, Legal Drafter, Management Strategy, Management of Planning and Japanese Language.

III. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE WHICH EXIST NOW (LAW AND JUSTICE) FROM OTHER DONOR AGENCIES.

The assistance which exist now as follows :

In the year 2002 the Attorney's General of Republic of Indonesia get soft loan assistance for Project SIMKARI II/Management Information System for Attorney General Office Phase II) for computerization on line to attorney's general office in all of Indonesia, the assistance from Spain amount USD. 20.000.000,- besides rupiah counterpart budget in APBN 2002 amount Rp. 20.000.000.000,-.

IV. OUTLINE OF THE PROSECUTION SYSTEM

A. Organization and Function of Attorney General :

Attorney General is a governmental institution in prosecution and legal monopoly, single prosecution in Indonesia which headed by an Attorney General and Deputy of Attorney General and Junior Attorney General.

B. Organization and Function of Attorney General :

1. Factor and strength of Attorney General :

- Spreading in each provinces in 26 Kejati and 340 Kejari, and branches in subdistricts and 2 representative office in Bangkok and Hongkong.

2. Level of Personnel in Attorney General :

- Eselon I : Deputy Attorney General

Public Prosecutor is the only one who can do single prosecution system and give and to trial criminal case in the court.
- D. Criminal Judicial System (criminal process for investigation to correctional):

District Court is a first level court. Appeal Effort against District Court Decision submit to High Court and for the jurisdiction submit to the supreme court.
- E. Public Prosecutor in criminal case :

In criminal case only the Public Prosecutor (legal monopoly) can delegate and trial the case at single prosecution and implementation the execution of the court decision.
- F. The role of Public Prosecutor and Civil/Commercial Case :

Prosecutor is not as Public Prosecutor in case of Civil/Commercial but as a State Defender Prosecutor) can representing government institution in civil case and also can propose bankrupt case on company for the public interest.
