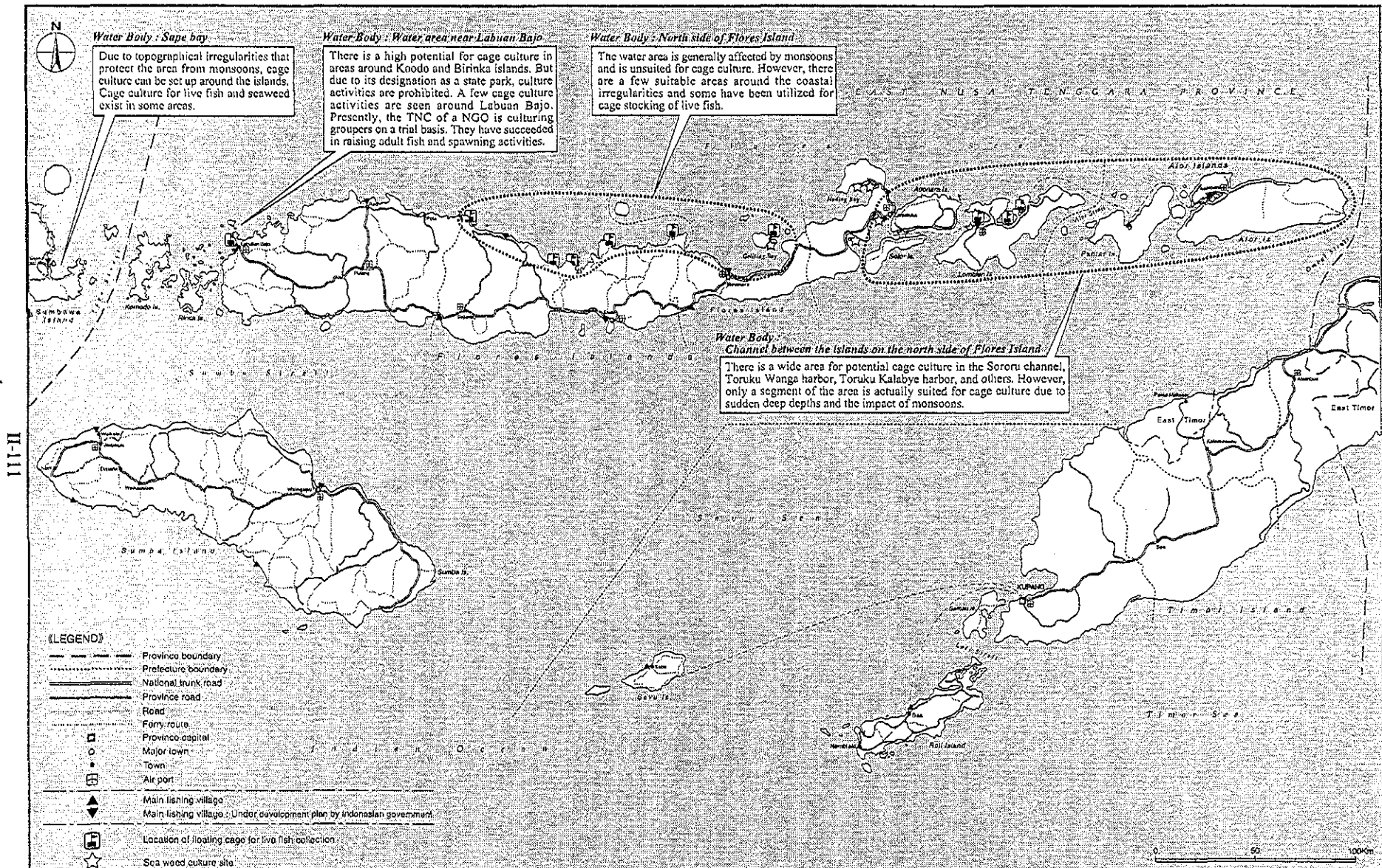


Fig. 2.5.1 Mariculture Potential Map (East Zone)

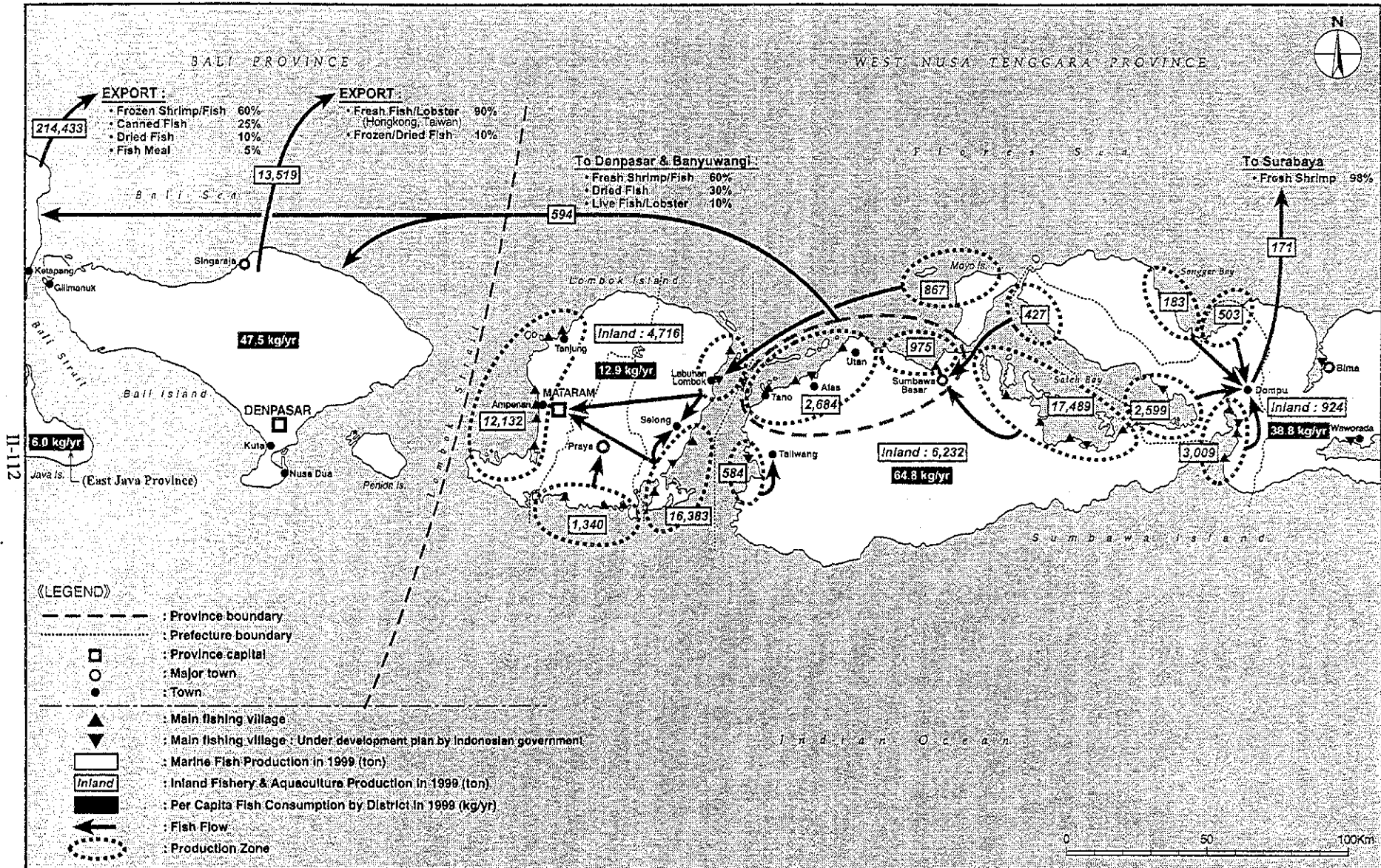
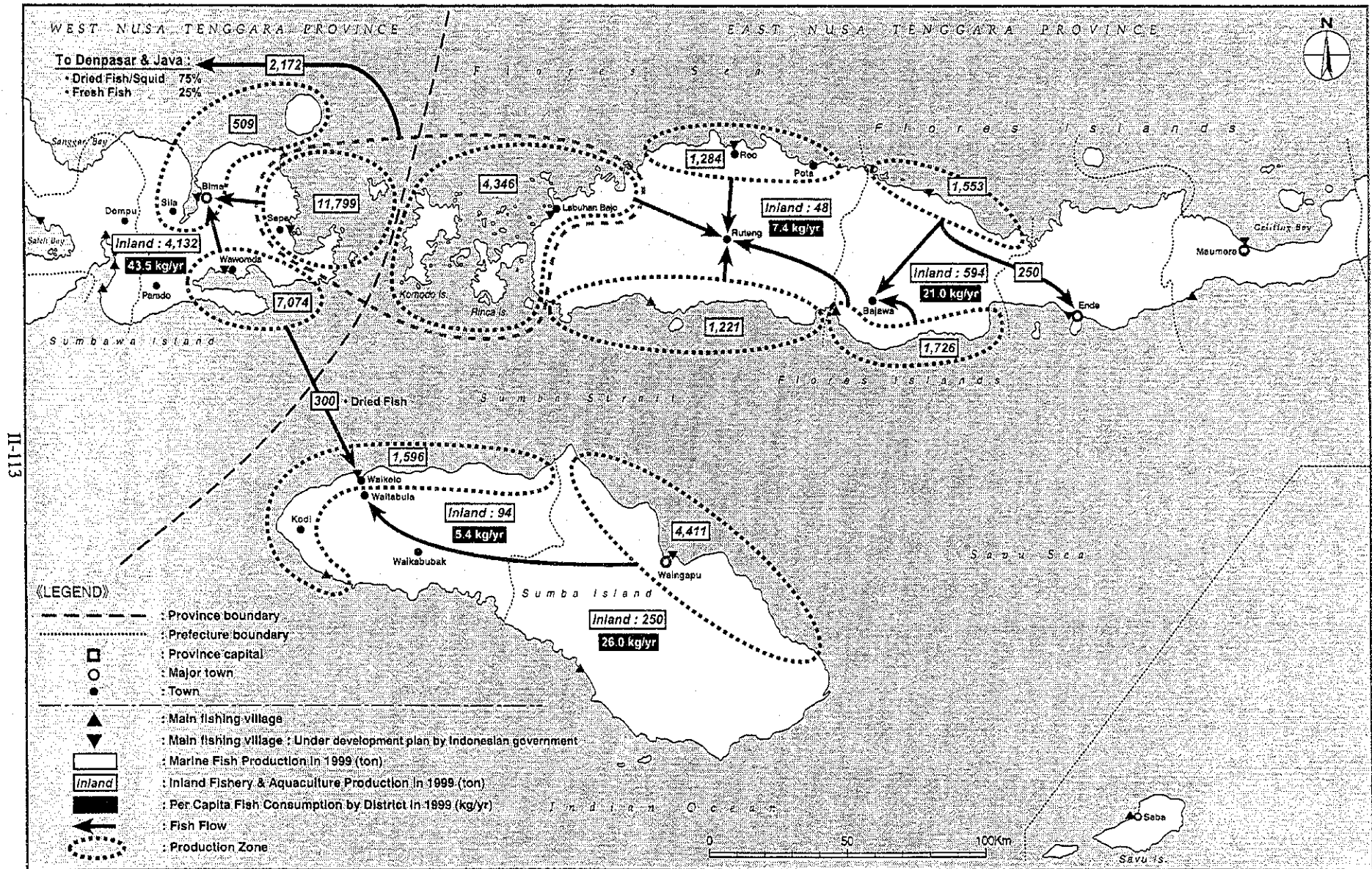


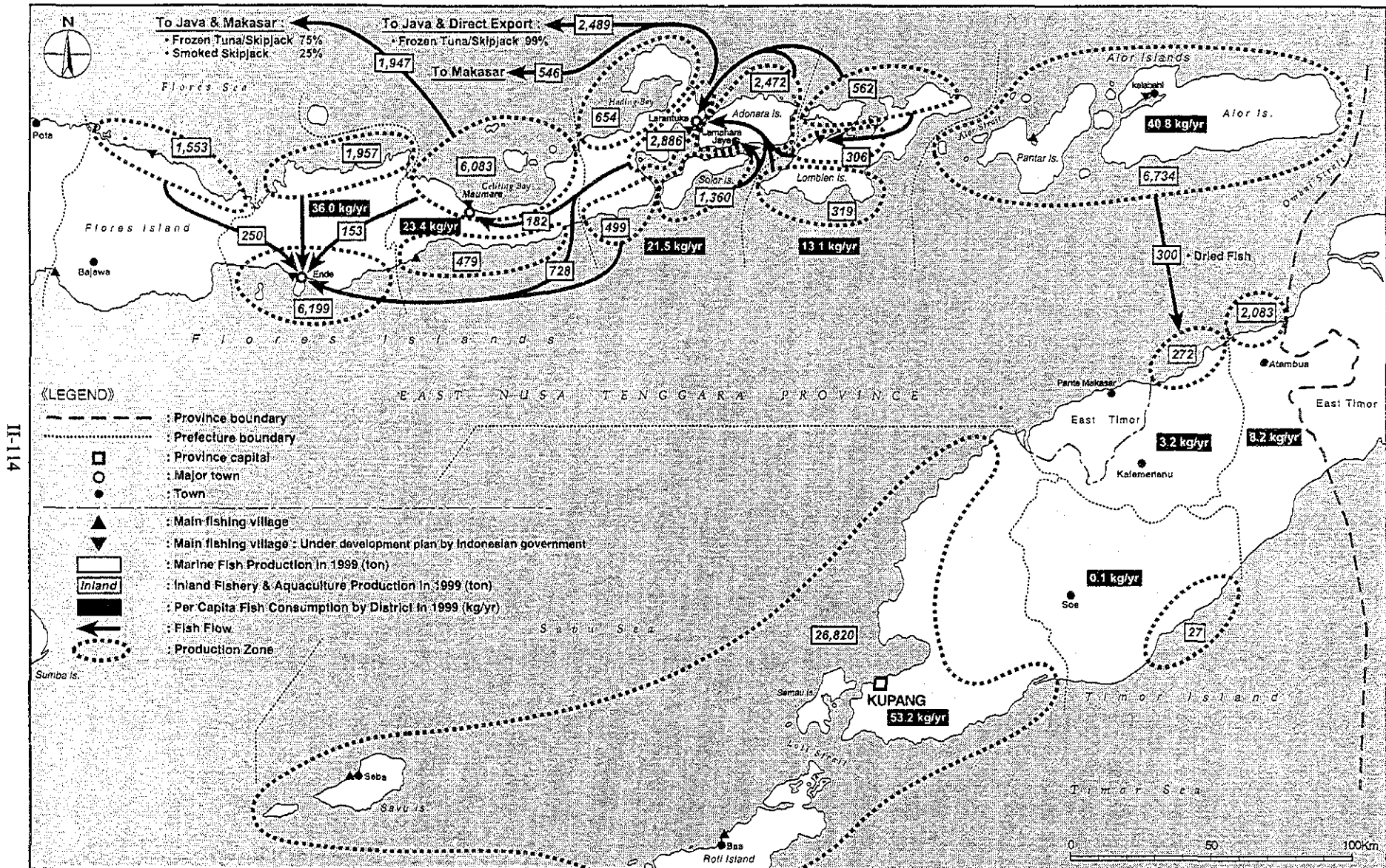
Fig. 2.6.1 Current Fish Production and Distribution (1)

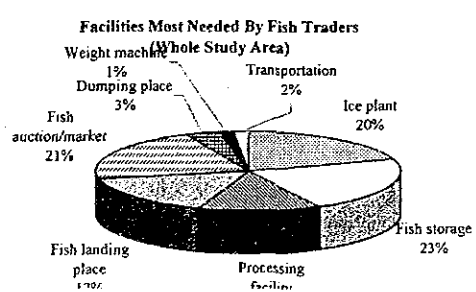
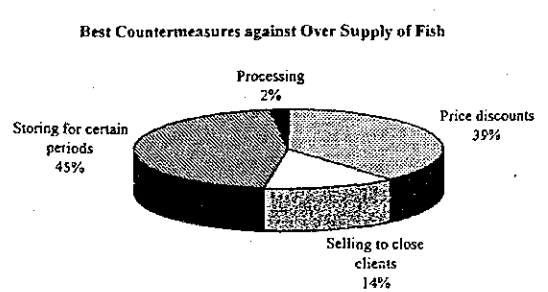
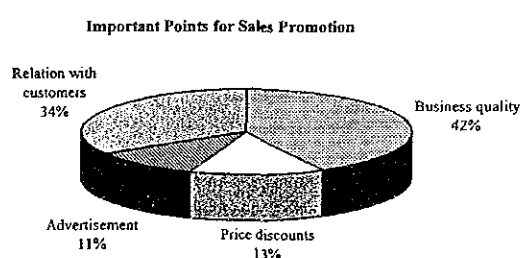
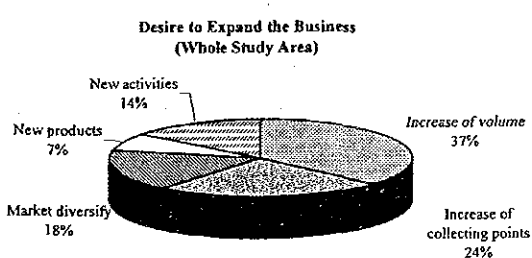
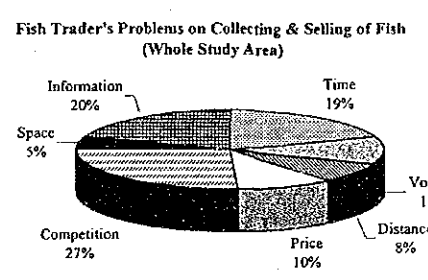
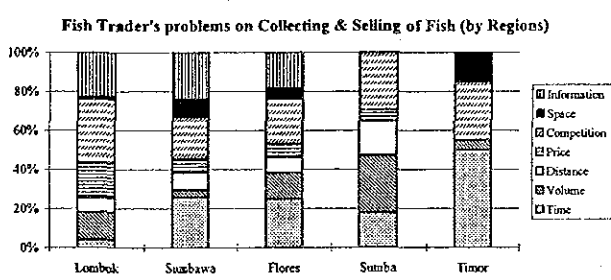
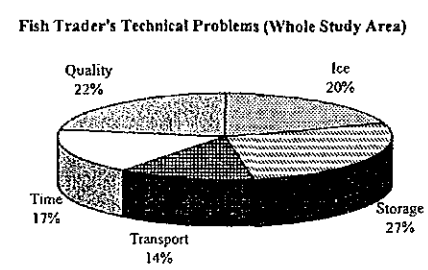
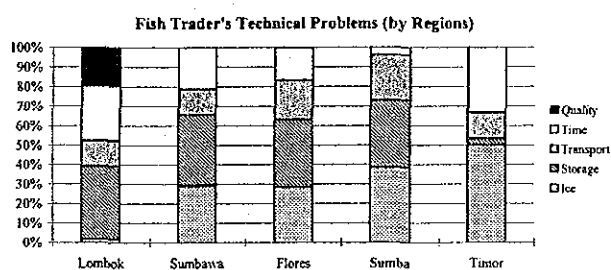
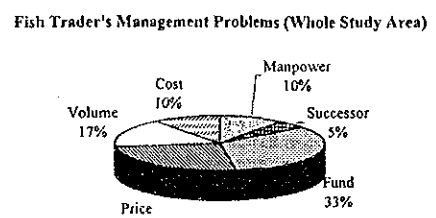
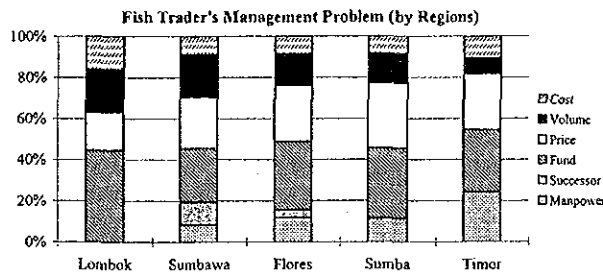
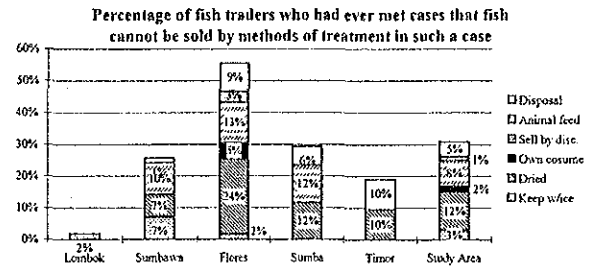
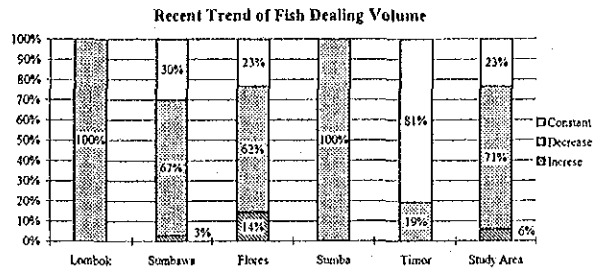
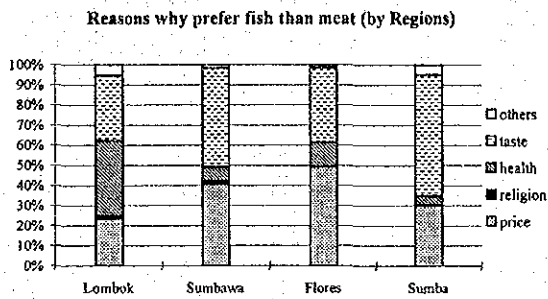
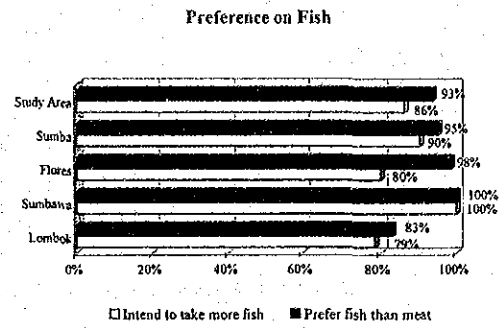
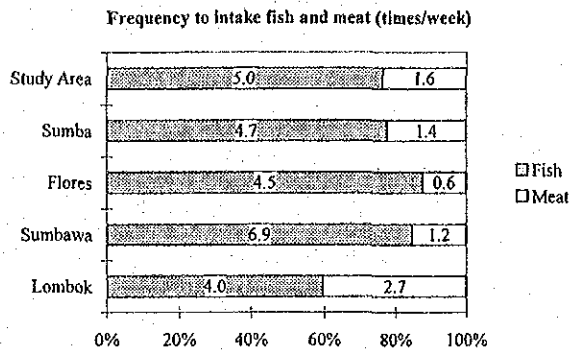
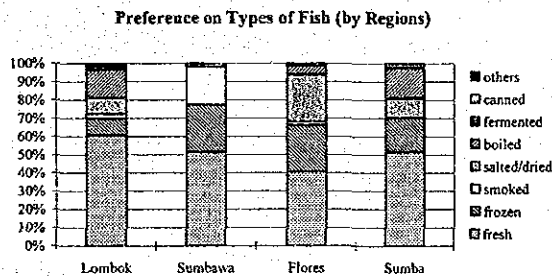
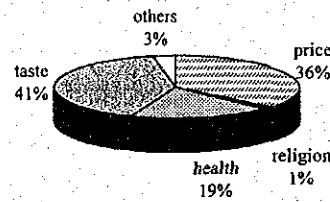


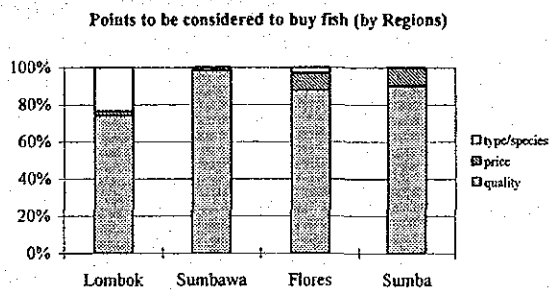
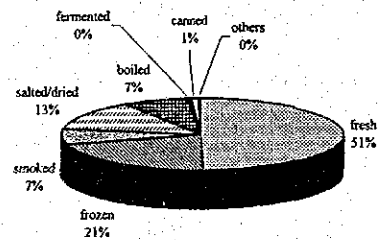
Fig. 2.6.2 Fish Traders Survey on Their Problems and Needs



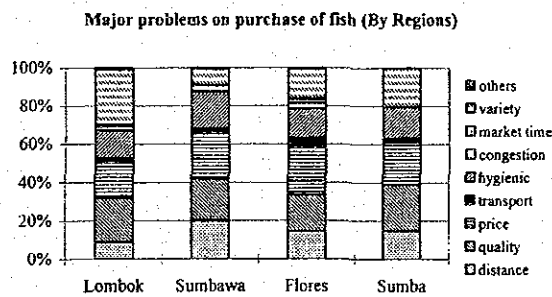
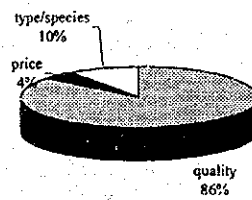

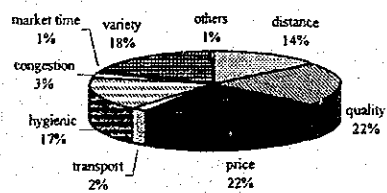


Fig. 2.6.3 Consumer Survey on Preference of Fish

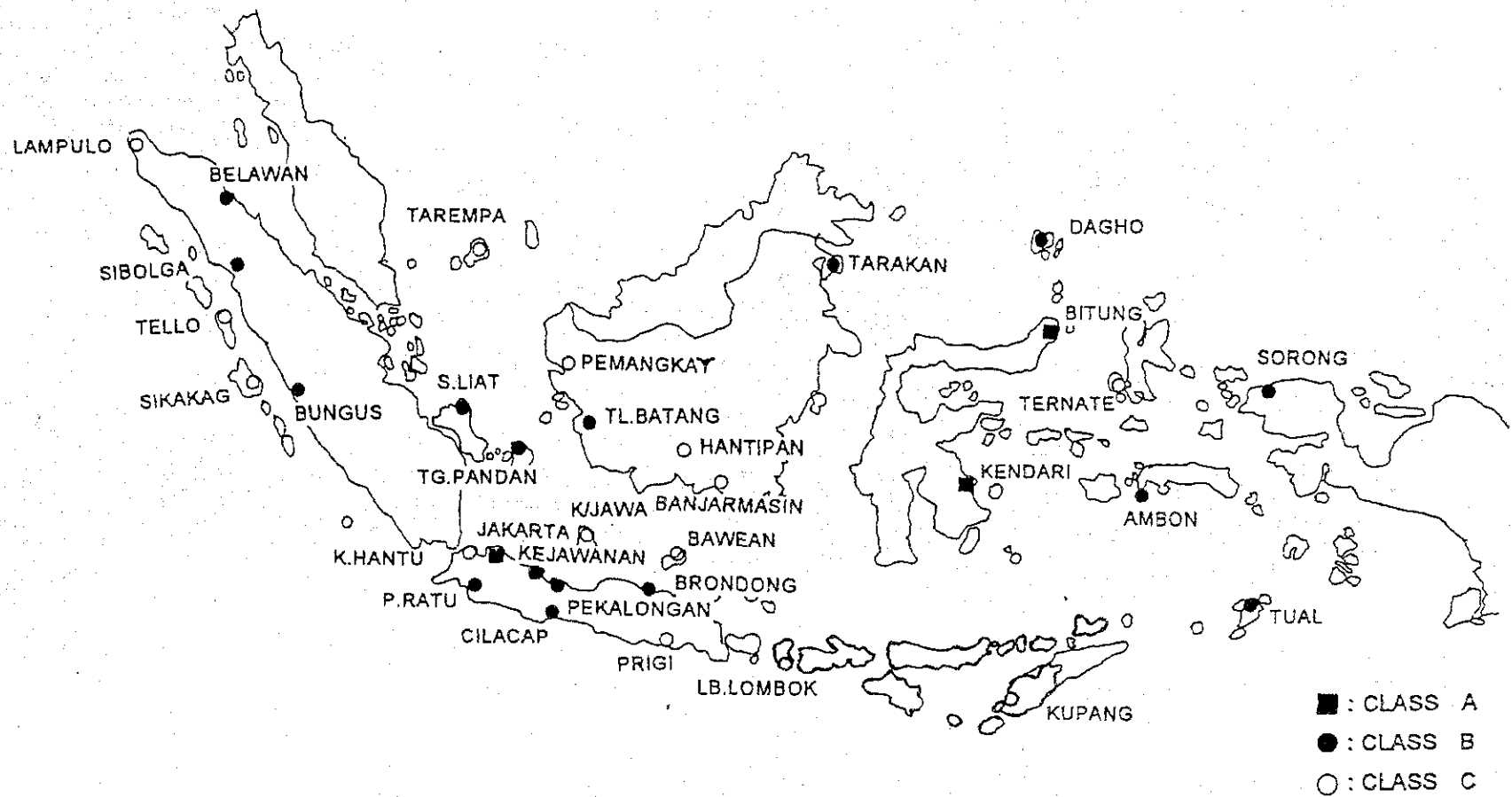
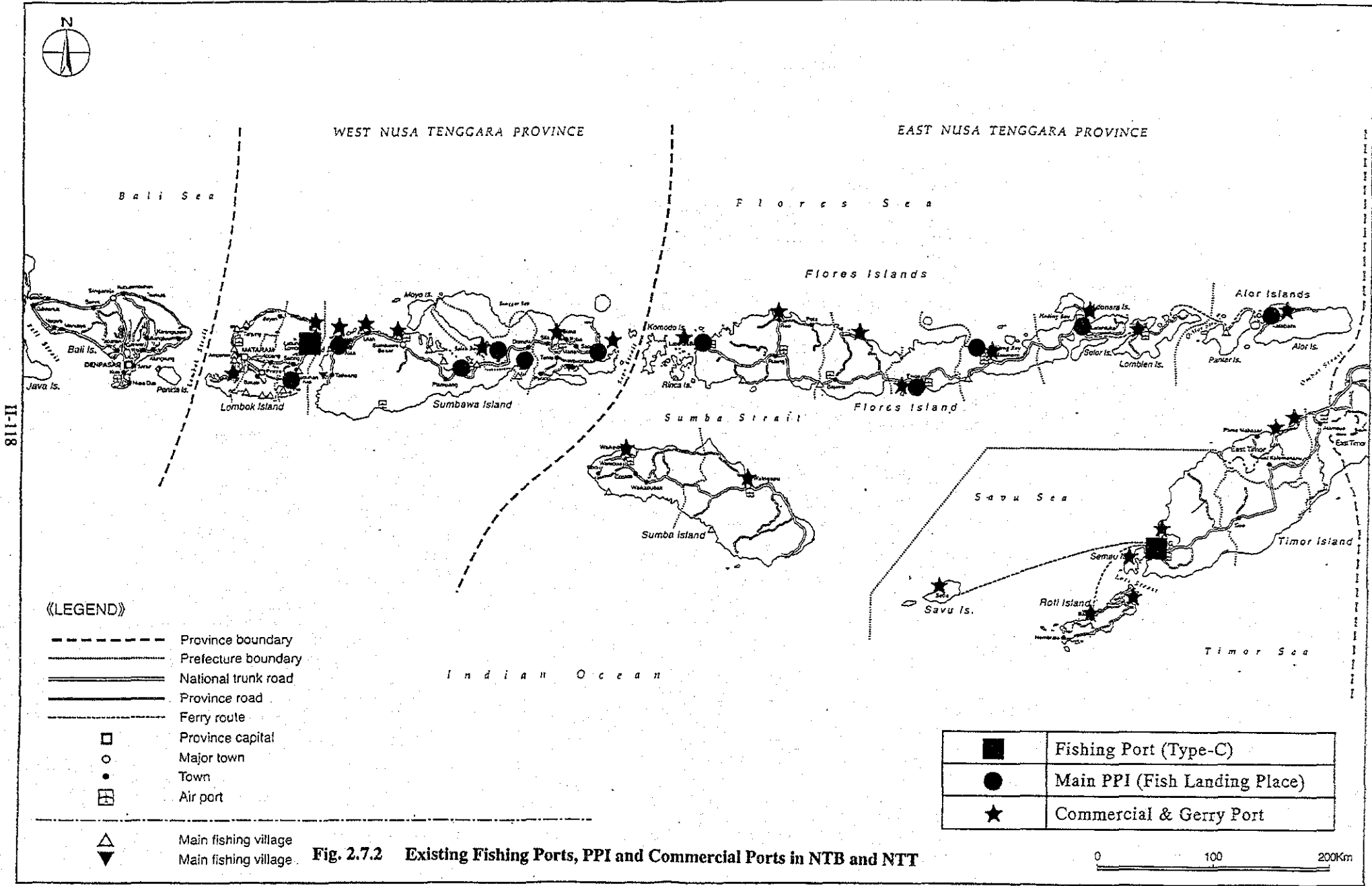


Fig. 2.7.1 Fishing Ports in Indonesia (Class A, B and C)

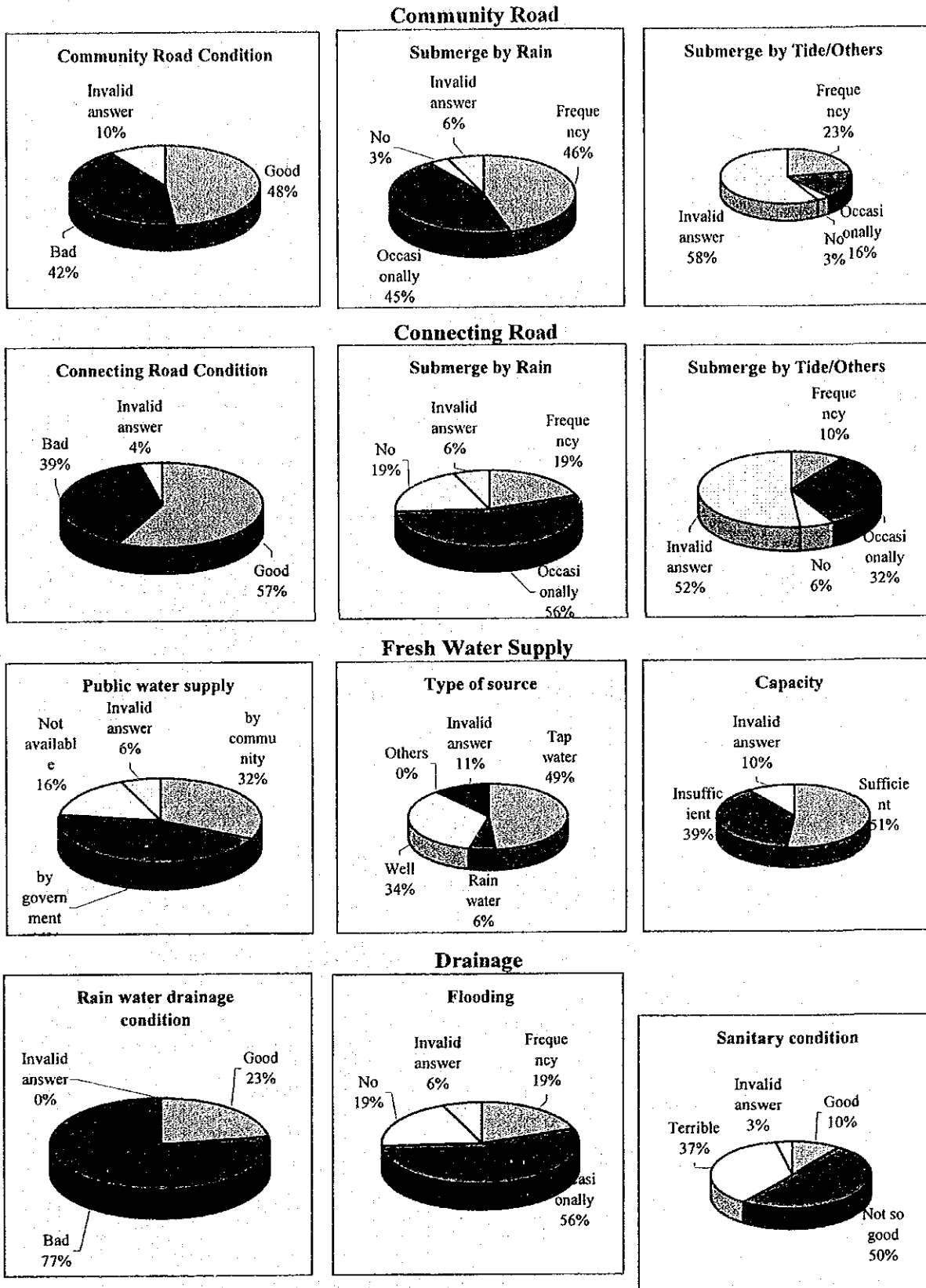

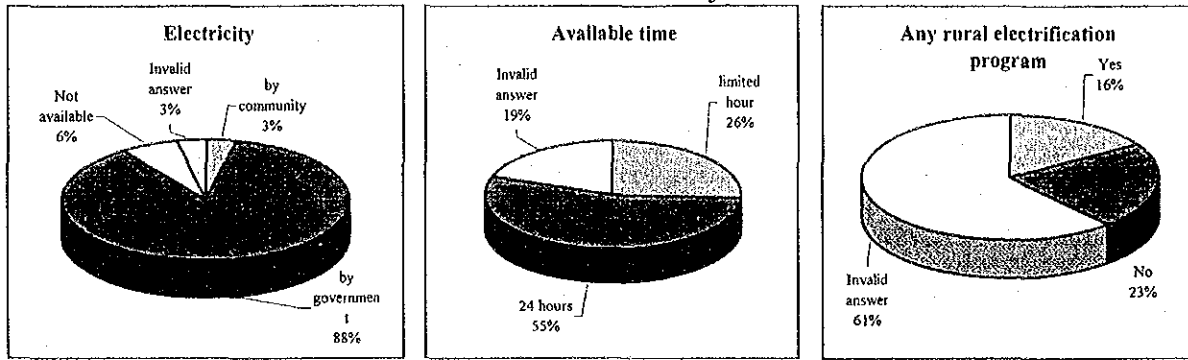

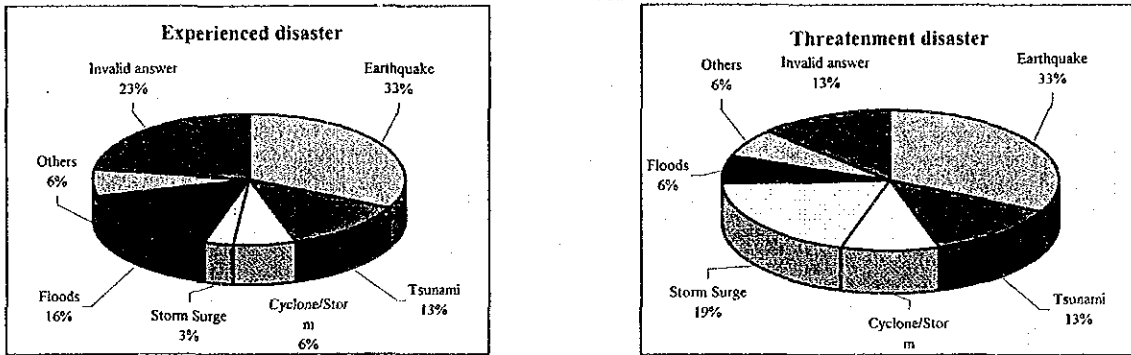

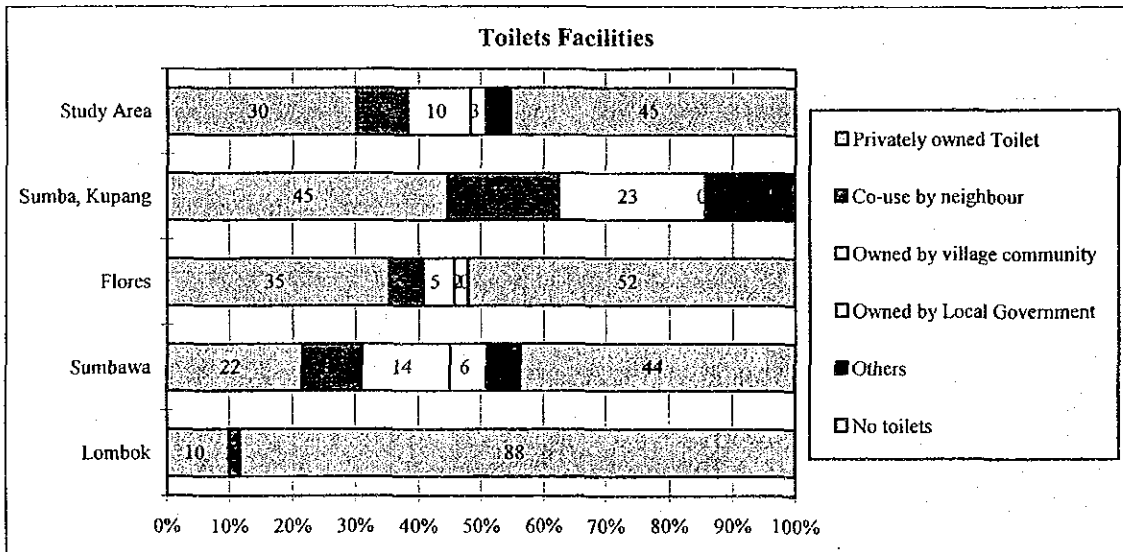

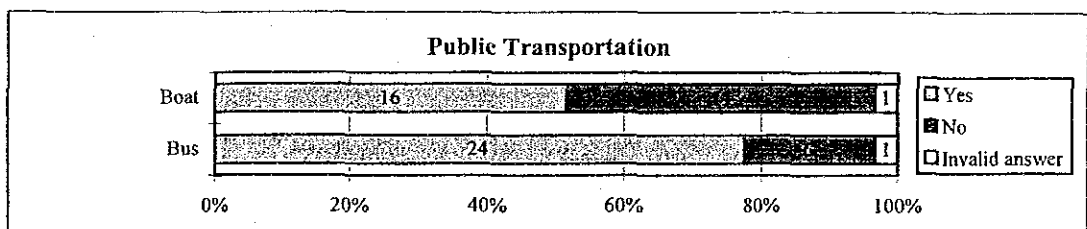
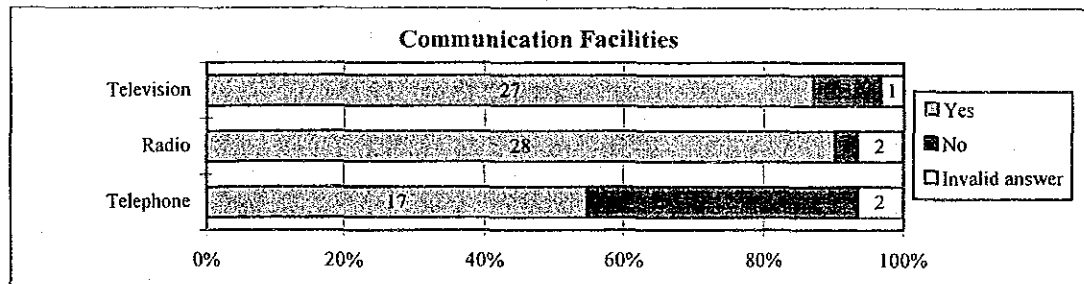
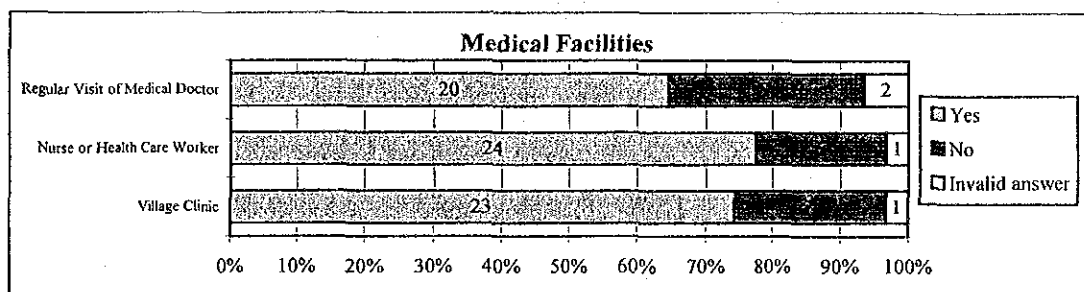
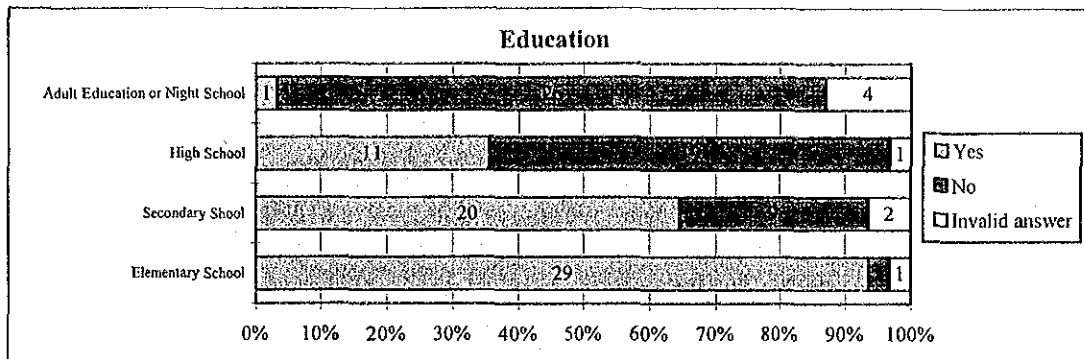

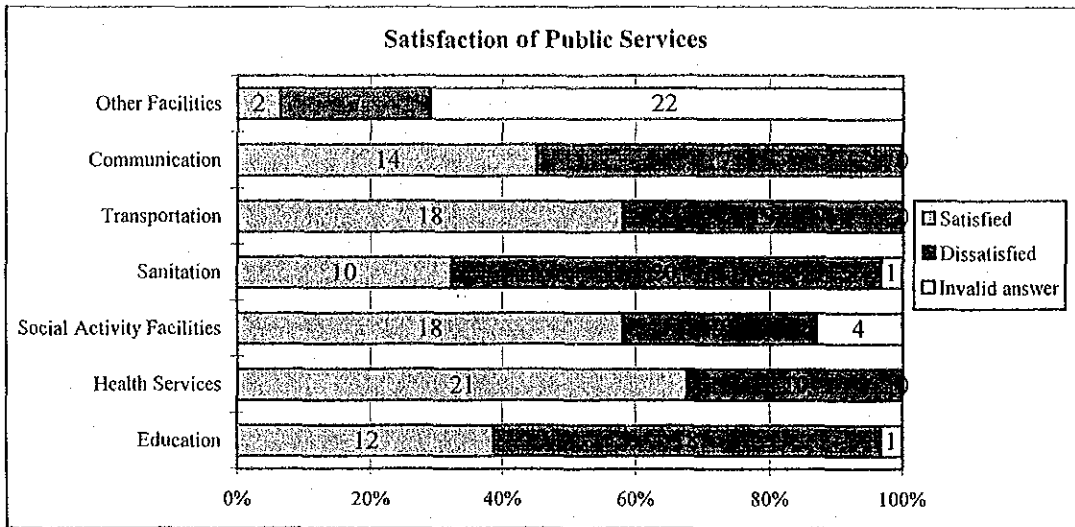
Fig. 2.7.4 Toilet Facilities

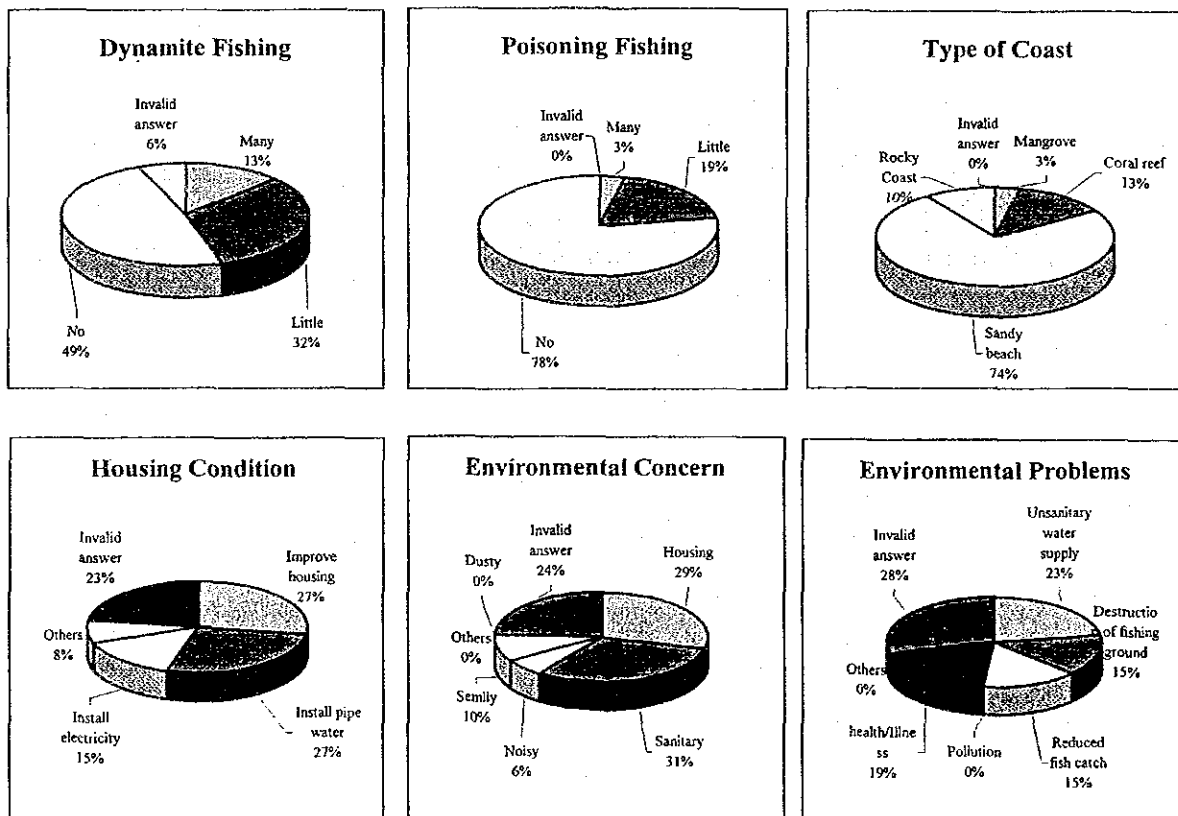
**Fig. 2.7.5 Existing Situation of Public Services**





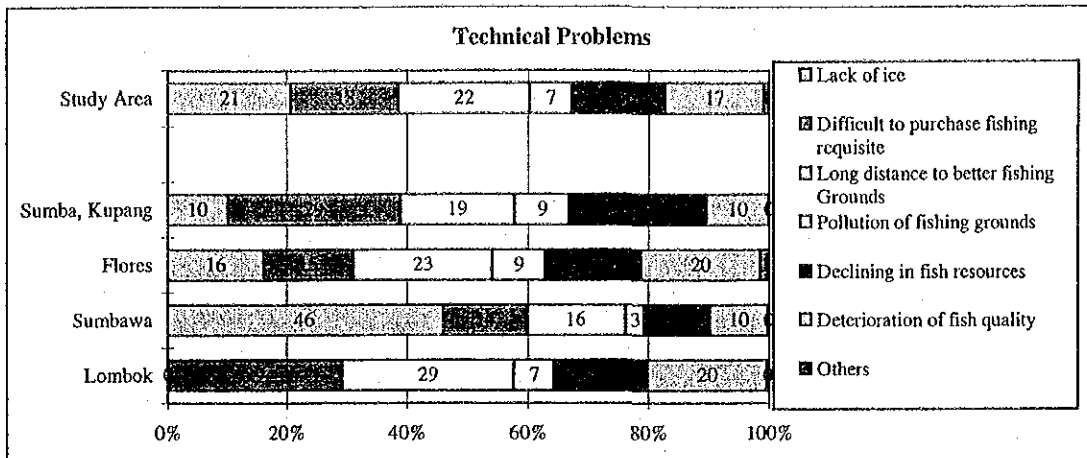

Fig. 2.7.6 Level of Satisfaction of Public Services



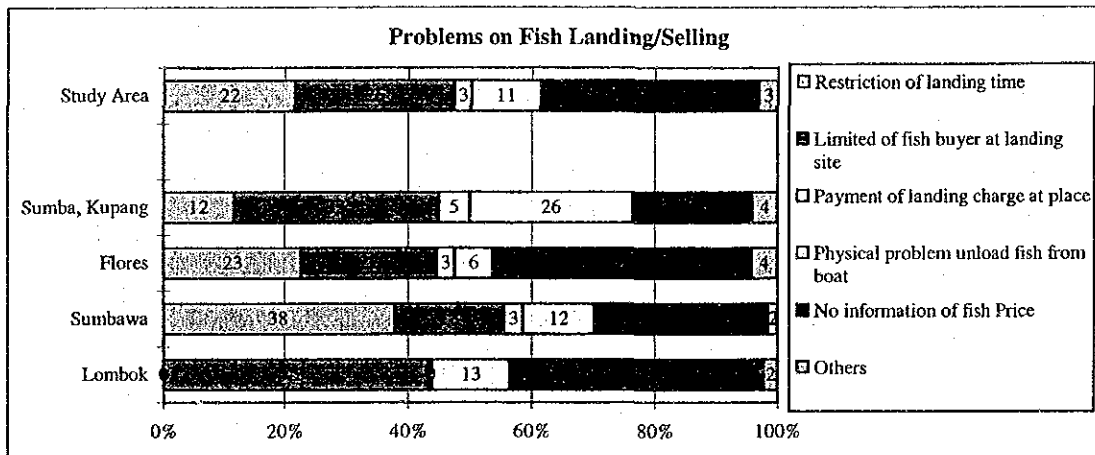

Fig. 2.7.7 Environmental Matters



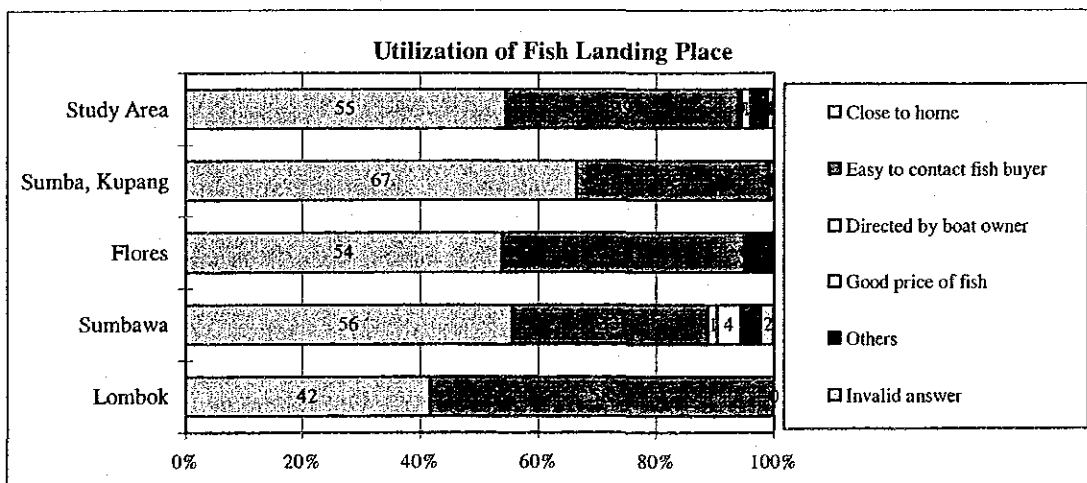
