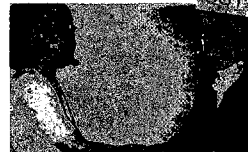

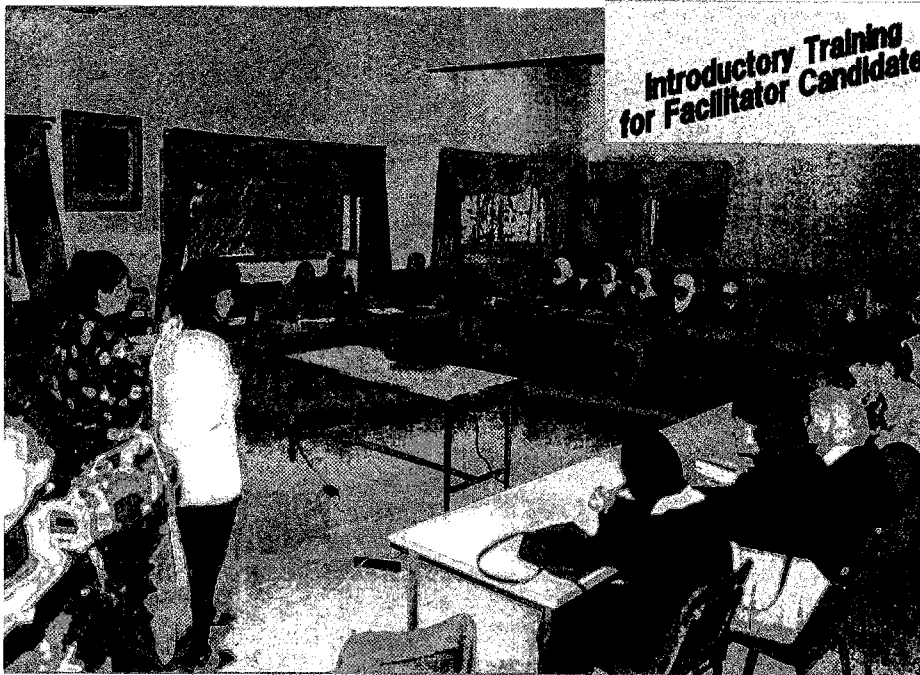

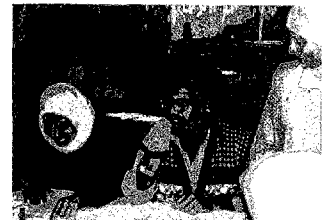

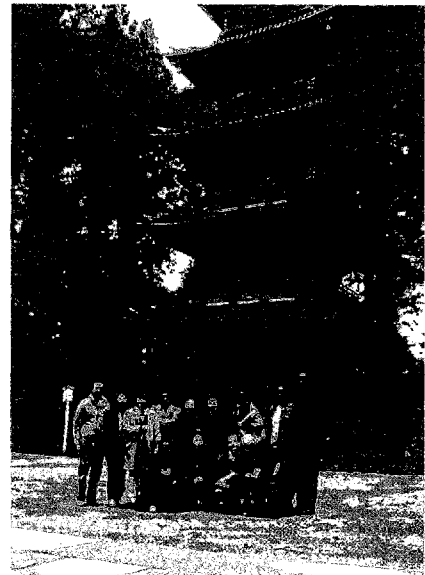

Dr. Maha Amareen, Riyada MCH center, was sent to Japan by the Project to take part in a Seminar on the Reproductive Health of Adolescents from Nov.19th to Dec.16th, 2001. The seminar, organized by JICA as a counterpart training program, provided both theoretical and practical training. As part of the practical training, Dr. Maha visited an elementary school and participated in health education. She commented that reproductive health education for adolescents, which is a new subject in Jordan, would be useful for Jordanian students.
