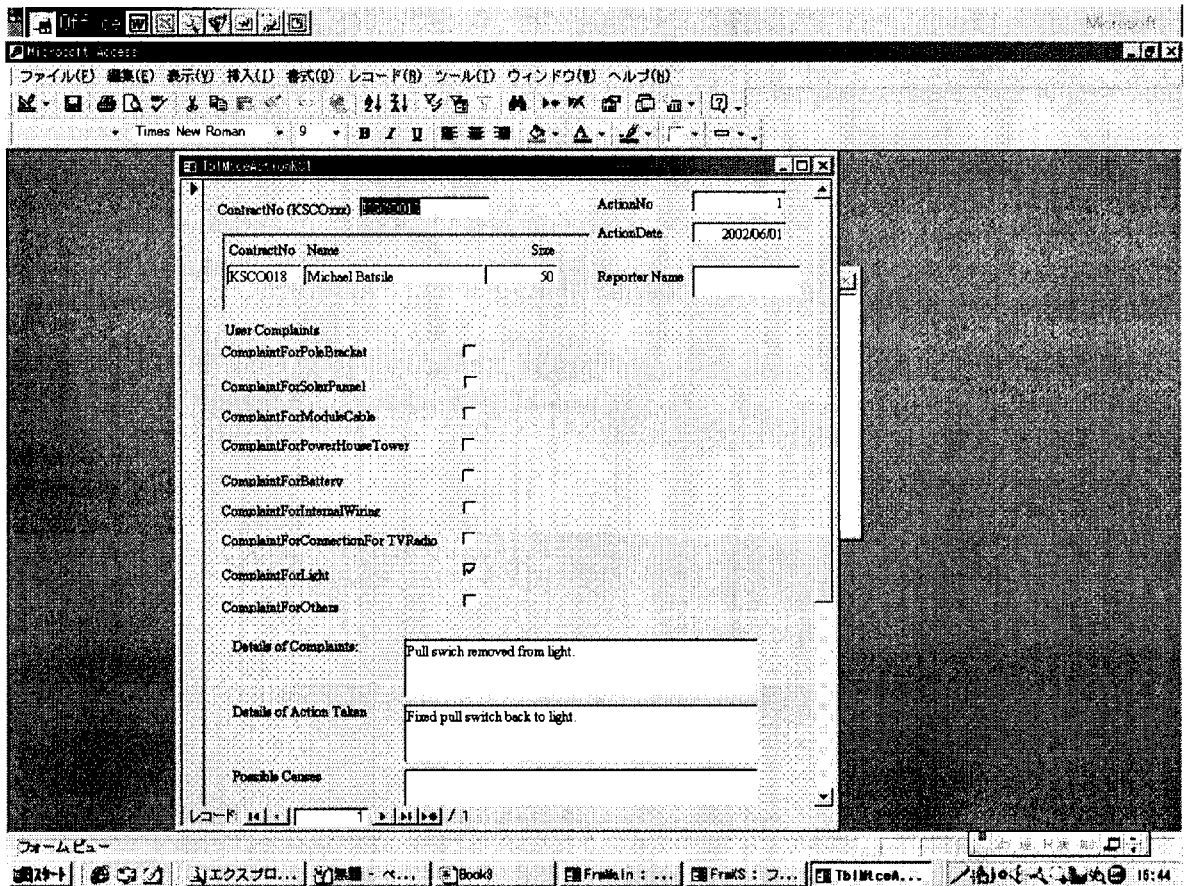

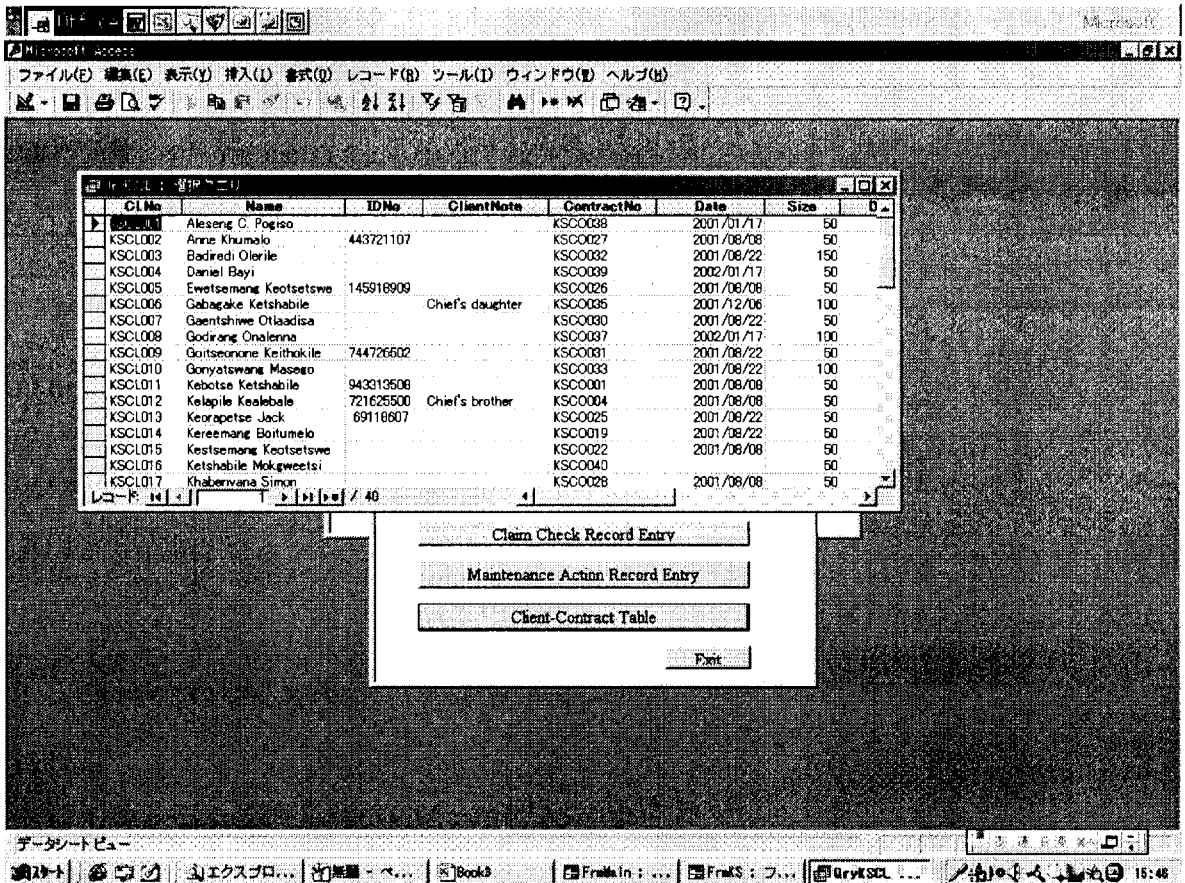

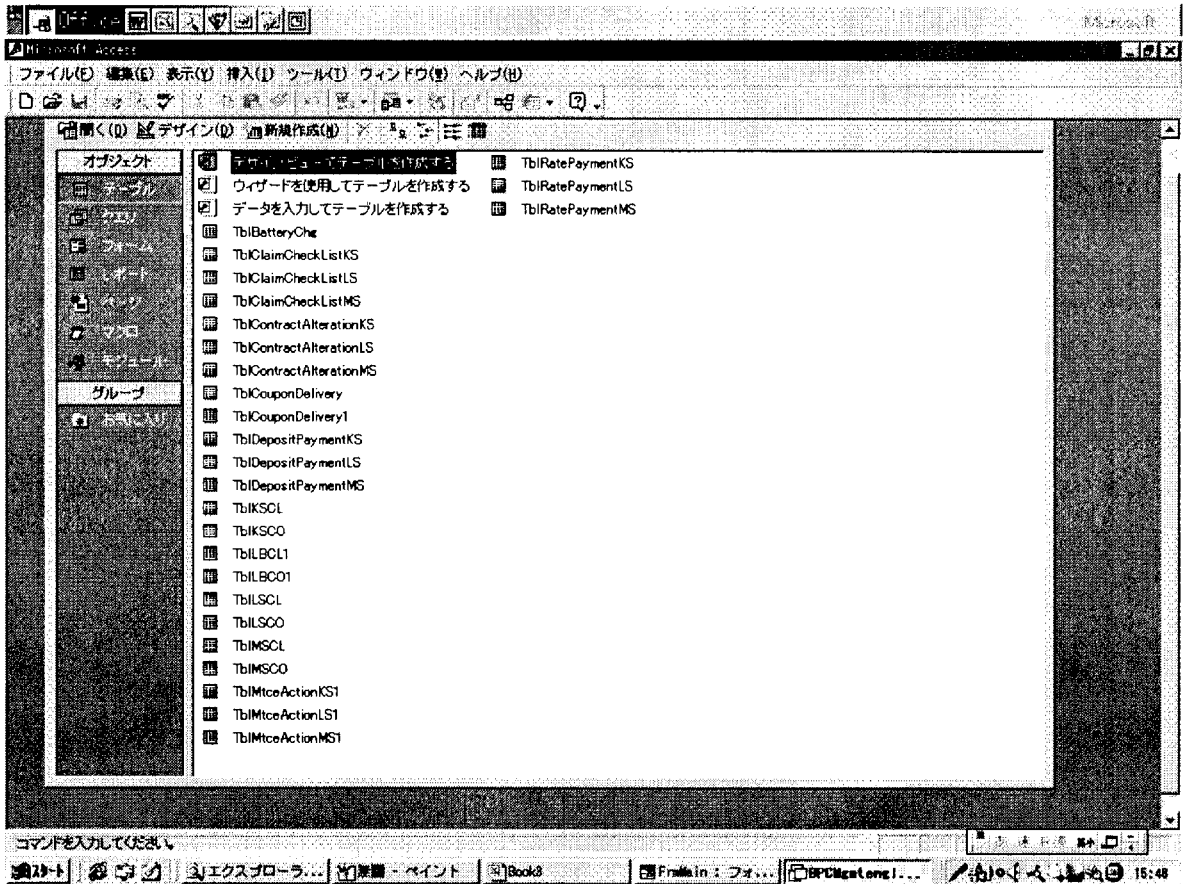


“Client-Contract Table”: you can see the updated table so entered as above.
