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## **Foreword**

This statistical compendium constitutes a part of the “Study for the Formulation of Projects of Support to the Promotion of Employment among the Youth in the Metropolitan Area of the Republic of Panama”, sponsored by Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

It consolidates the primary information obtained through the questionnaires applied to young people and employers in the district of Panama and San Miguelito. It also includes secondary information such as the statistics collected by the Office of the Comptroller General. This statistical compendium is divided into three sections as follows:

- **Survey of Young People:** includes the information obtained through the survey conducted among 1,500 young people in the district of San Miguelito in September 2002, on housing conditions, demographic aspects, labor condition, entrepreneurial development, knowledge and skills, and other aspects of young people.
- **Survey of Employers:** contains the information obtained through the questionnaire applied to 40 employers in the districts of Panama and San Miguelito, about human resources demand, and knowledge, skills and aptitudes required for the hiring of personnel.
- **Other statistical data:** includes information of San Miguelito about the characteristics of the dwelling and population, the education level, the revenues and expenditures budget of the Municipality, the economic activities therein, and the number of persons under arrest, according to the type of crime.

It is expected that this information prove useful for students, teaching staff, private persons, researchers, and, in particular, civil servants and authorities engaged in the formulation and implementation of policies and plans directed to the solution of problems and the development of the district of San Miguelito.
