In 1964, it was upgraded to 1500 bedded hospital with expansion of 'new specialists' wards and extension of new buildings.

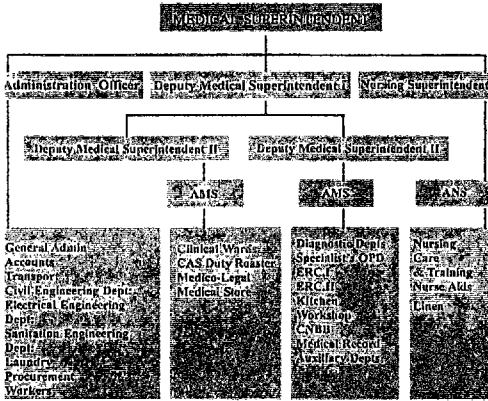

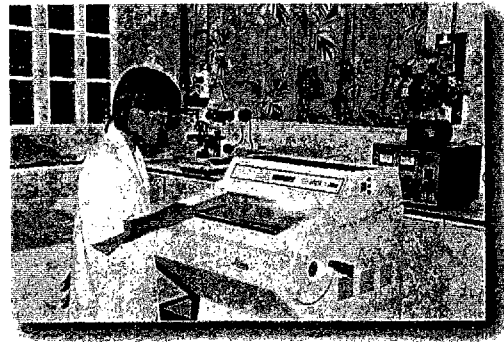
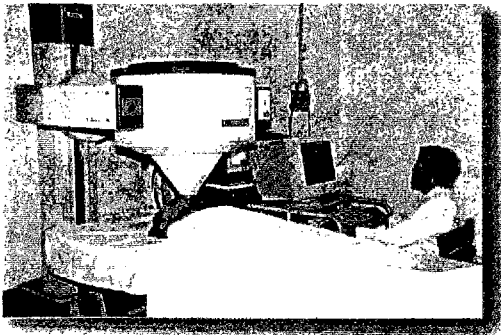
ORGANIZATIONAL SET - UP

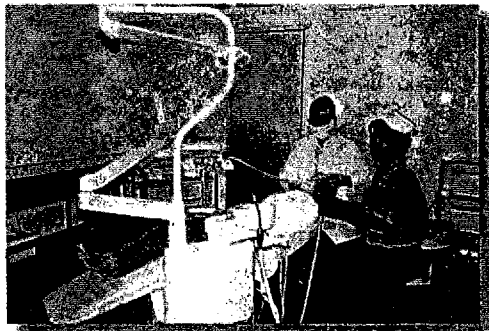


Surgical Operations by O.T.H. [2001]

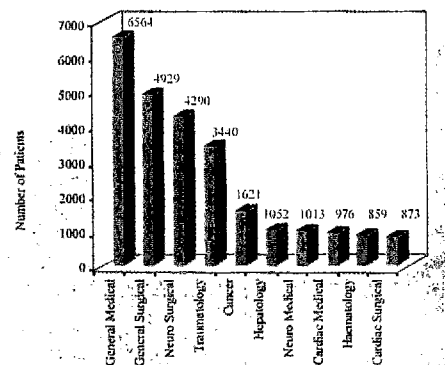

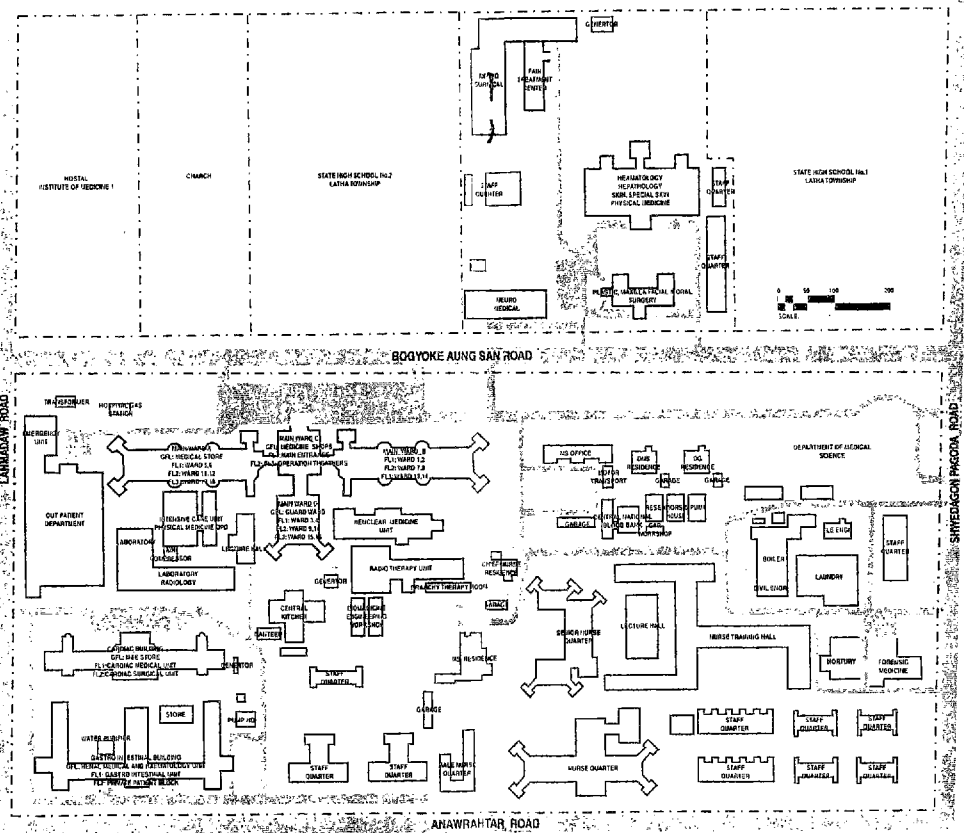

TEN LEADING SPECIALITY OF YGH ADMISSIO [2001]



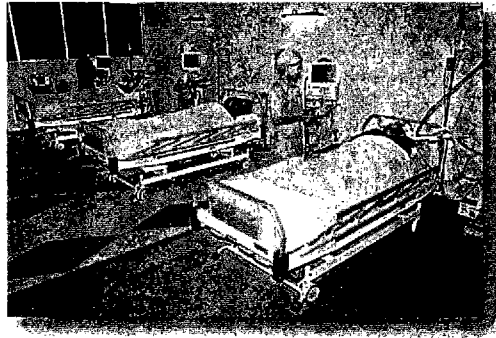


Layout of Yangon General Hospital
