Finally, we hope that this report will contribute to further promotion of the project.

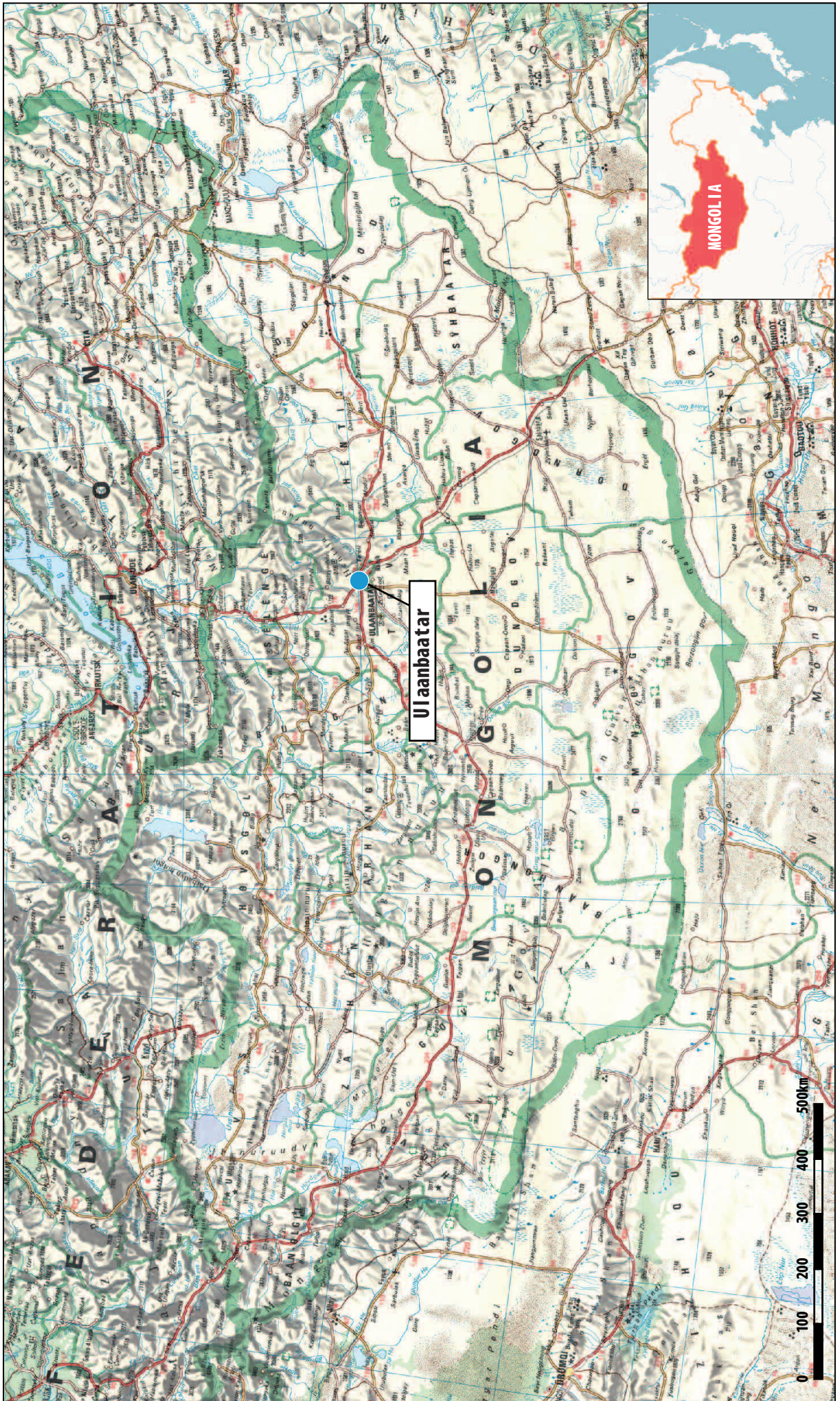
