
The Team held discussions with the officials concerned of the Government of the Nigeria and conducted a field survey at the study areas.

In the course of discussions and field survey, both parties confirmed the main items described on the attached sheets. The Team will proceed to further works and prepare the Basic Design Study Report.







ATTACHMENT

1. Objective of the Project

The objective of the Project is to improve the educational environment in the schools covered by the Project through the construction of school buildings based on the concept of the Universal Basic Education Programme.

2. Project Sites

The sites of the Project to be covered by the field survey are 121 primary schools listed in Annex 1, located in Kaduna, Niger and Plateau States.

3. Items requested by the Government of Nigeria

The items requested by the Nigerian side are construction and furnishing of additional classrooms in 121 primary schools listed in Annex 1. JICA will assess the appropriateness of the request and will submit the result of assessment to the Government of Japan for approval.

4. Responsible and Implementing Organizations

- 4-1. The responsible organization is the Universal Basic Education Programme (UBE) of the Federal Ministry of Education (FME).
- 4-2. The implementing organizations are the State Primary Education Boards (SPEBs) and the Local Government Education Authorities (LGEAs) under the State Ministries of Education of Kaduna, Niger and Plateau States.
- 4-3. The organization charts of FME, UBE, SPEB and LGEA are given in Annexes 1-1~1-4 of the Minutes of Discussions signed by both parties on November 28, 2002.

5. Japan's Grant Aid Scheme

The Nigerian side understands the Japan's Grant Aid Scheme and the necessary measures to be taken by the Nigerian side, described in Annex 2.

6. Schedule of the Study

- 6-1. The consultants will proceed for the Basic Design Study in Nigeria until December 26, 2003.
- 6-2. JICA will prepare a draft report of the Basic Design Study in English and dispatch a mission in order to explain its contents around March, 2004.

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6-3. In case the contents of the report is accepted in principle by the Government of Nigeria, JICA will complete the final report and send it to the Government of Nigeria by May, 2004.

7. Other Relevant Issues

7-1. Selection of schools to have additional classrooms constructed under the Project

- (1) The schools to have additional classrooms constructed under the Project will be selected from those described in Annex 1 in accordance with the criteria described in Annex 3.
- (2) The schools to have additional classrooms constructed under the Project will be decided by the Japanese side through the further study in Japan.
- (3) The schools to have additional classrooms constructed under the Project shall have the Team's field survey by December 26, 2003. This means that schools where the site survey is canceled for any reason will be excluded from the Project.

7-2. Components of the Project

- (1) Construction of ordinary classrooms and provision of educational furniture will be prioritized in the Project. The necessity of teachers' office, store room, toilet and water supply facility will be carefully examined. Library, laboratory, other purpose-rooms or teaching materials will not be included in the Project.
- (2) Number of ordinary classrooms per school will be re-examined with the result of the field survey.

7-3. Design and specification

The design and specification of facilities and equipment will be based on the Nigerian UBE standards but may be modified from the viewpoint of maintenance and construction cost.

7-4. Allocation of teachers and administration staff

The Nigerian side will allocate sufficient number of teachers and administrative staff to satisfy the increased number of facilities for the smooth implementation of the Project.

1. Contents of the draft report

The Nigerian side has agreed and accepted in principle the contents of the draft report proposed by the Team. The Nigerian side has understood that the cost estimate written in the draft report is provisional and would be further examined by the Japanese side.

2. Japan's Grant Aid Scheme

The Nigerian side has understood the Japan's Grant Aid Scheme and the necessary measures to be taken by the Nigerian side described in Annex 2 of the Minutes of Discussions signed by both parties on November 20, 2003.

3. Final Report

JICA will provide the Nigerian side with the final report of this B/D by the end of May 2004.

4. Other relevant issues

4-1. Component covered by the Project

Both sides have agreed to the components covered by the Project as described in Annex I .

4-2. Major Works covered by the Nigerian side

The Nigerian side has assured to complete following preparation works before the commencement of the construction work by the Japanese side.

- 1) To clear, level and reclaim the construction sites when needed
- 2) To provide utility spaces for construction work
- 3) To secure access to the sites

4-3. Proper Use and Maintenance

Both sides have understood that proper use and maintenance of the facilities and equipment would be indispensable for their lifelong use.

4-4. Allocation of necessary budget and personnel

The Nigerian side has agreed to allocate necessary budget and personnel (person in charge, teachers and administrative/general staff) for proper operation and maintenance of the facilities and equipment covered by the Project. The Nigerian side has further agreed to allocate sufficient number of qualified teachers to schools which will be covered by the Project (hereinafter referred to as "the Project schools").

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4-5. Soft Component Services

For sustainable and effective use and maintenance of facilities and equipment, the Nigerian side has requested JICA that the Soft component services by the consultant are included in the scope of work of the Project so that the Nigerian side would be able to develop and establish its own maintenance system or sustainable and effective use and maintenance of facilities and equipment.

4-6. Allocation of necessary budget and personnel for "OJT".

Japanese side is prepared to carry out training courses for the people who will be involved in O&M of the Project schools, according to "Soft Component Services" described above. In the preparation of the OJT, the Nigerian side has agreed to assign a necessary number of personnel including the coordinators (facilitators) at the beginning of the Project and also agreed to organize taskforces which would play a leading role in O&M, by the completion of the model schools.

4-7. Land for the Project

The Nigerian side has assured that any relocation of the present settlers in the project site is not necessary at all. The Nigerian side has also confirmed that the Certificate of Occupancy for the Project schools shall be prepared in advance of the Exchange of Notes (E/N).

4-8. Details of the Facilities and Equipment.

Both sides have agreed that the final decision on the details of facilities and equipment would be made by the Japanese side after a final check in Japan.
