The JICA Study Team for the Development Study for the Improvement of Quality and Access of Basic Education in the Union of Myanmar (hereinafter referred to as the "Study") prepared Progress Report 3 and submitted it to the Department of Educational Planning and Training, Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as the "DEPT") on 21 August 2003. Subsequently the DEPT, in close cooperation with JICA, convened the seventh Workshop on 25 August 2003 in Yangon. The DEPT invited the following Myanmar authorities and international donor agencies to the Workshop: Department of Basic Education No.1; Department of Basic Education No. 2; Department of Basic Education No. 3; Myanmar Education Research Bureau (MERB); Institute of Education (IOE); Yankin Education College (YEC), Thingangyur Education College (TEC); Hlegu Education College (HEC); Yankin Education College Practicing School (YECPS), Basic Education Middle School (1) Lammadaw, UNICEF and Pestalozzi Foundation. The Workshop was also attended by the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and the JICA Study Team. The list of attendants is presented as Annex. During the meeting, participants discussed the contents of Progress Report 3 and steps towards the "Strengthening CCA (SCCA)" Project. Main discussions are summarized as follows:

- 1 The DEPT first acknowledged the receipt of 30 copies of Progress Report 3 as per the Scope of Work.
- 2 The DEPT expressed its gratitude to JICA for the great efforts to develop the CCA-based teacher's guides that would highly improve Myanmar's education.
- The DEPT announced that it had already formed the editing committee for the teacher's guides and that the committee will start editing the teacher's guides in January 2004. The DEPT raised some important issues to be reflected in the teacher's guides, particularly those of Social Studies (History) and Moral and Civics: (1) national unity of Myanmar, (2) culture and tradition of Myanmar, and (3) diverse geographical conditions of Myanmar. The DEPT was also concerned with teaching aids, especially for Basic Science, and asked the JICA Study Team to tackle this aspect, too, once the teacher's guides were authorized, possibly under the SCCA project.
- DBE 1 appreciated the dedicated works by MBESS to create the teacher's guides. With regard to the presentation about educational philosophy and psychology, he commented (1) that "knowledge is constantly added" should be a more appropriate expression than "knowledge is constantly changing" and (2) that the sentence "the result of learning is not

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
