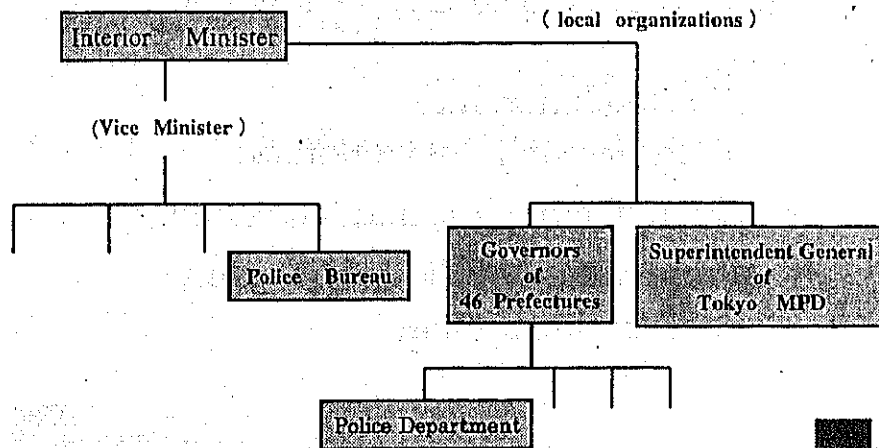

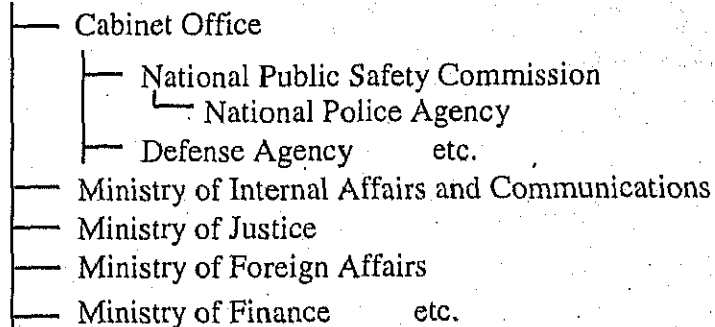

- ◇ Under the jurisdiction of the Prime Minister
  - No commands from the Prime Minister
- ◇ Chairperson (state minister = cabinet member)
- ◇ 5 other members appointed by the prime minister with the consent of the Houses of the Parliament

## National Public Safety Commission (Part2)

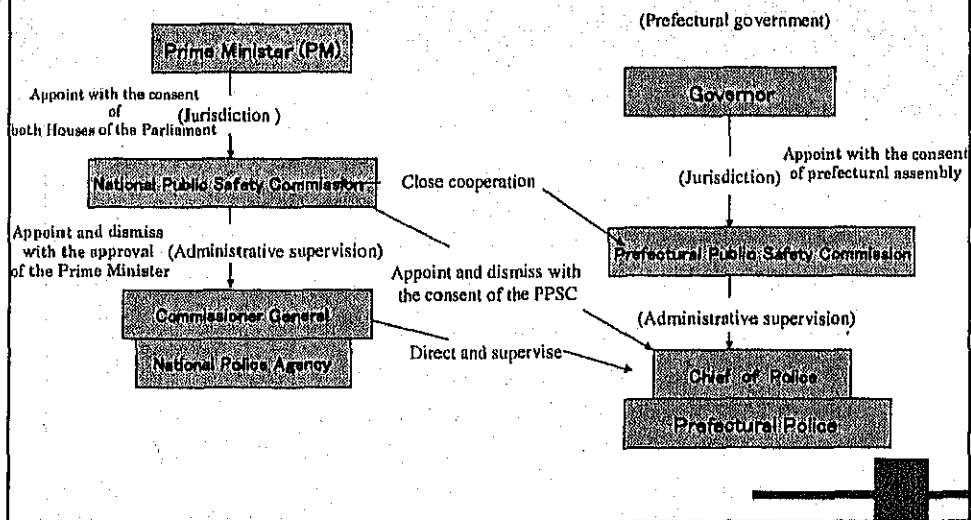
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- ✦ Administrative supervision over NPA through formulating basic policies and regulations
  - ◇ Appoints the Commissioner General of NPA and the Superintendent General of Tokyo MPD with the approval of the Prime Minister
  - ◇ Appoints the chiefs and senior officials of 47 Prefectural Police with the consent of Prefectural PSCs
  - ◇ No directions to individual cases except for internal disciplinary inspection

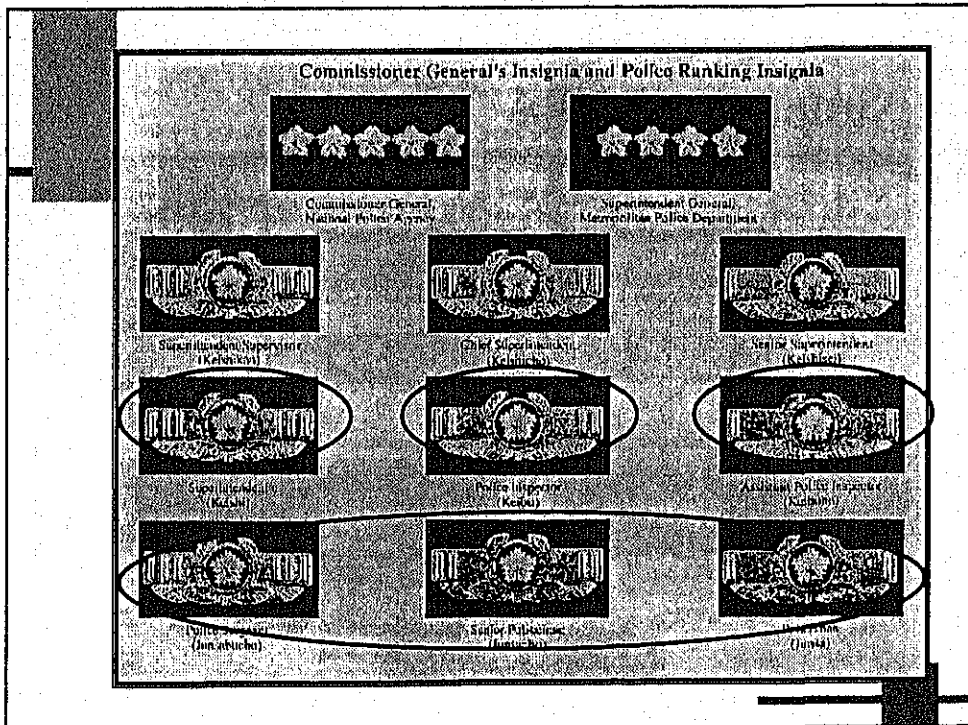

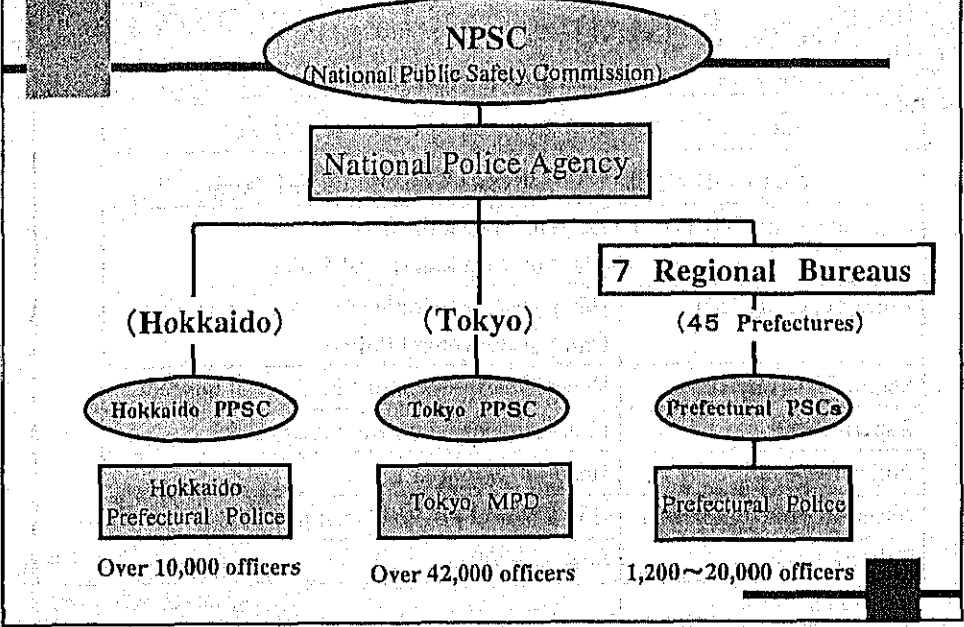

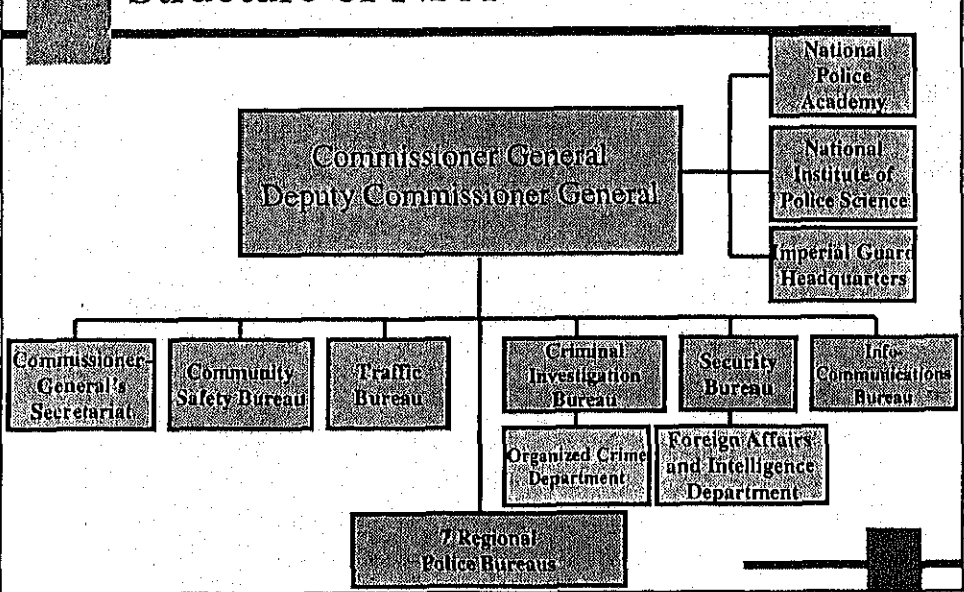

- ✧ 5 or 3 members appointed by Governors  
with the consent of the Prefectural Assembly
- ✧ Chairperson is elected among the members

- ◇ Has the authority to issue licenses for drivers, entertainment business and firearms possession
- ◇ No directions to individual cases except for internal disciplinary inspection

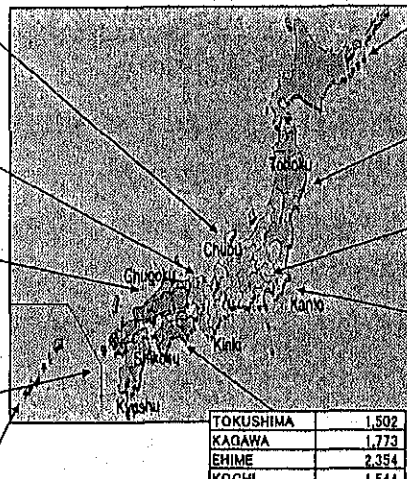

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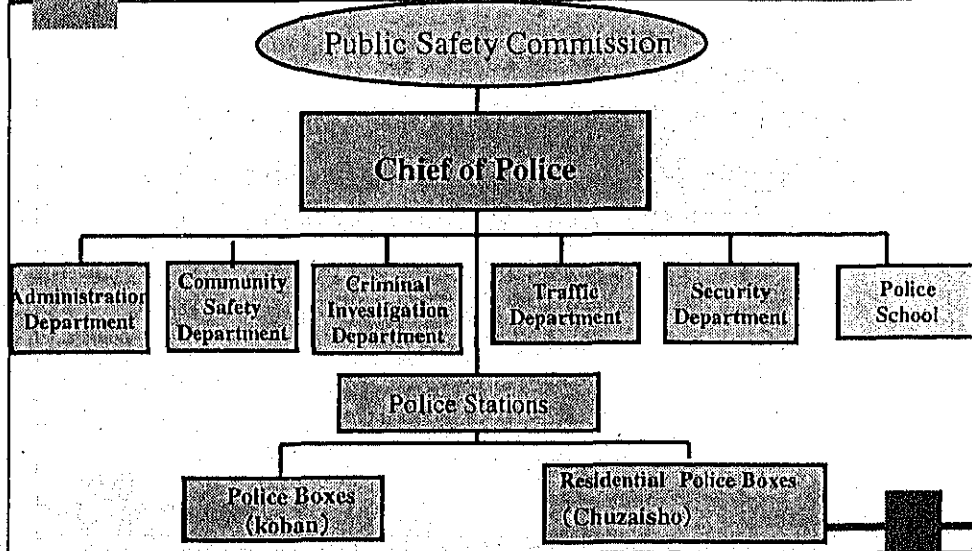

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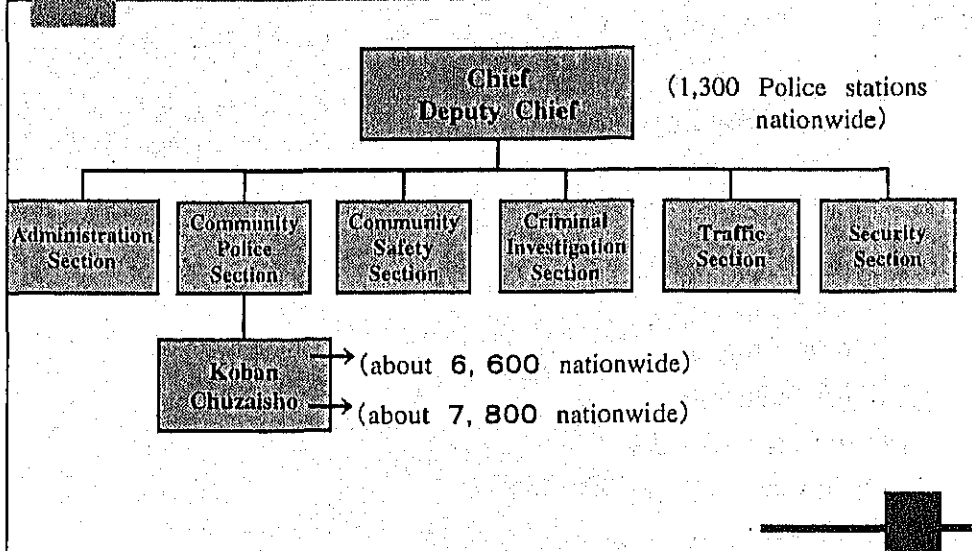
