RESULTS OF SOCIOECONOMIC SURVEY


JICA Study Team conducted a comprehensive questionnaire-based survey to assess the current socioeconomic conditions of the local communities in the Jordan Rift Valley area. The objectives of this survey are:


- (i) To provide a comprehensive view of the living conditions, work patterns, sources of income, modes of adaptation, needs and priority of the local population in the Study area;
- (ii) To assess the degree of people's satisfaction for public services; and,
- (iii) To clarify constrains and potentials for future development programs and projects.


Based on the questionnaire designed by the JICA Study Team, the field research was carried out in November 2005 by a group of experienced specialists headed by Dr. Nader Said (Director of Development Studies Programme, Birzeit University). Data entry and analysis were also undertaken by Dr. Said's group under the supervision of the JICA Study Team. In formulating the Jericho Regional Development Plan, the Study Team further analyzed and fully utilized the results of this survey.

This socioeconomic survey targeted 505 samples in twelve local communities in the Jordan Rift Valley area, which were grouped into the five regions, i.e., Jericho, Al 'Auja, Tubas, areas surrounding Tubas, and Jordan Valley villages of Nablus. The following is the details of the target communities.

Degree of Satisfaction by Type of Facilities (Health)


Location and access to the public health posts are satisfactory for users.

Respondents are not satisfied with services of the hospitals.














- Respondents in area surrounding Tubas are not satisfied in both quantity and quality of water management.






- 63.5% of the respondents are using gas stove for cooking and heating.
