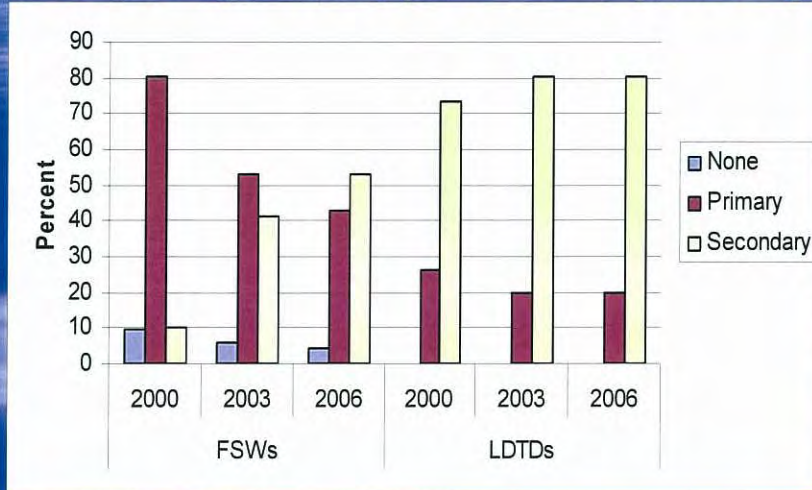

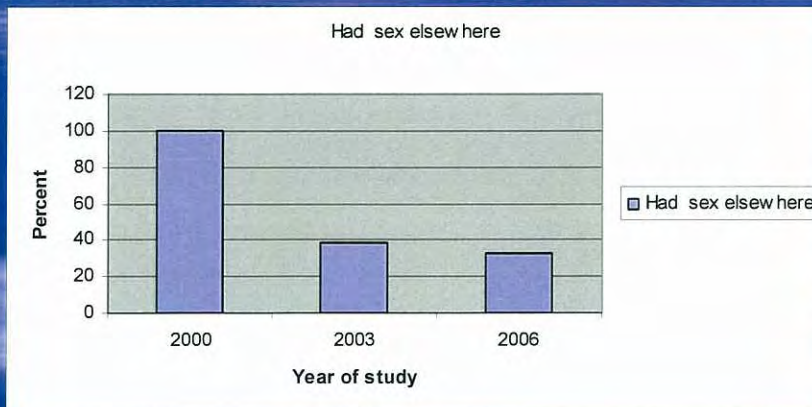
Ages of FSWs were older in 2006 than 2000 ($p < 0.001$), but unclear among LDTDs



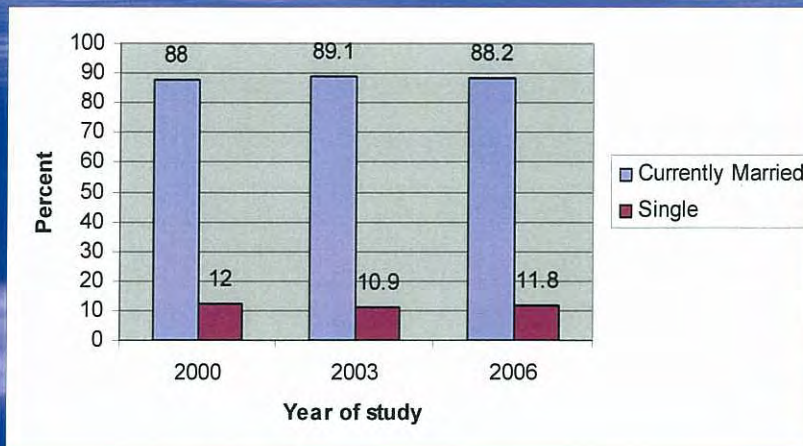
...over a half (53%) of FSWs and 80% of LDTD in 2006 had secondary or higher education: ($p < 0.001$, $p = 0.005$ respectively)



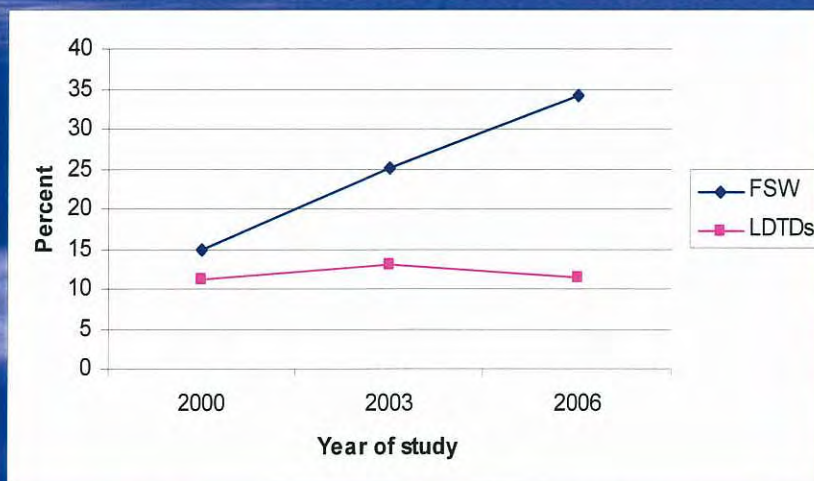
... mobility of FSWs reduced in the last 12 months ($p < 0.001$)



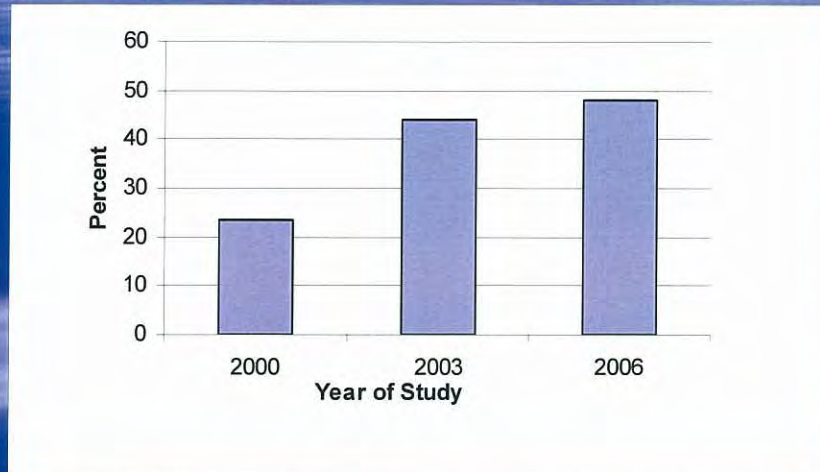
Nearly 90% LDTD are married: 2000-2006



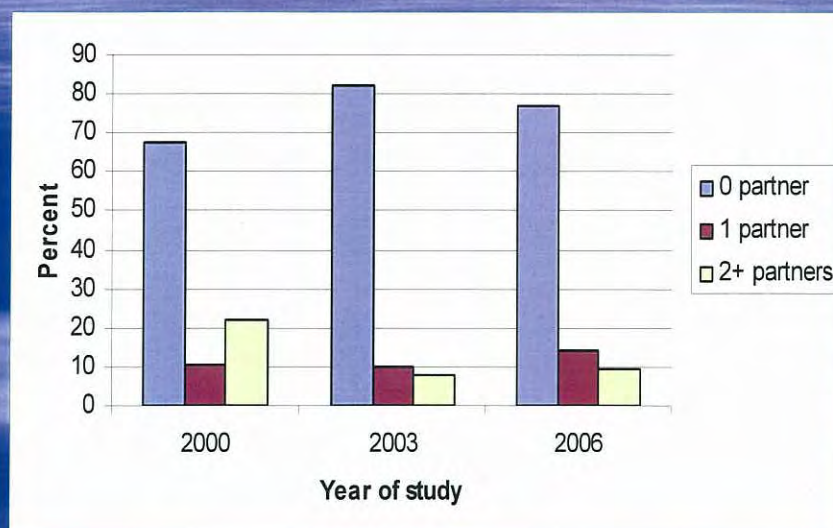
...proportion of FSWs who consumed alcohol increased ($p < 0.001$), but remained stable among LDTDs



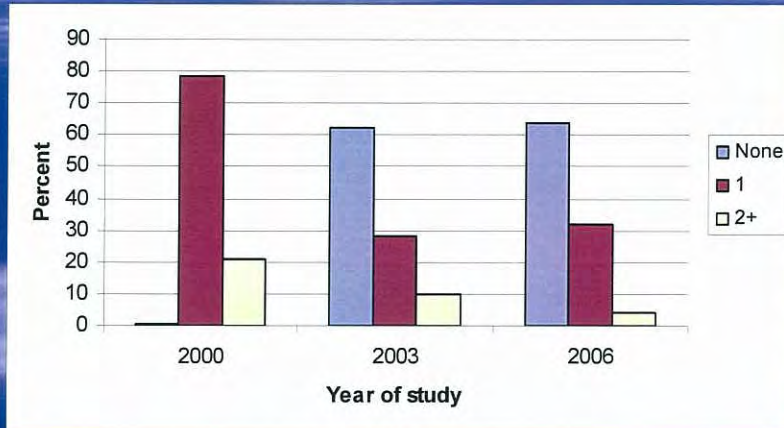
...almost a half of FSWs had condoms on hand... a statistically significantly increase in trend ($p < 0.001$)



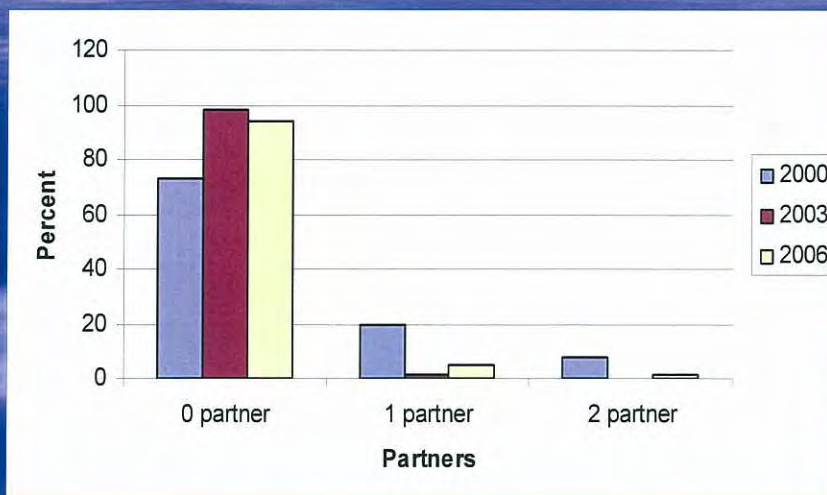
LDTDs reporting sex with FSWs in past 12 months reduced ($p=0.001$)



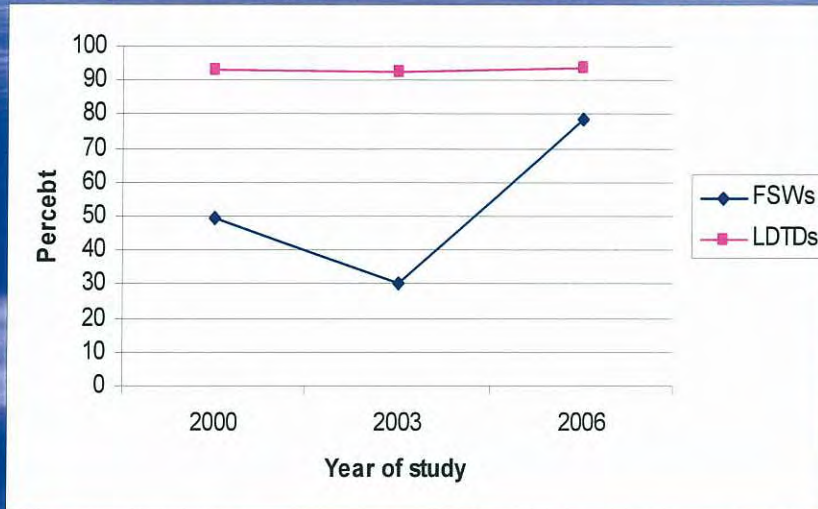
In 2006, there was decline in trend in LDTDs reporting sex with regular sex partner besides their spouses ($p < 0.001$)



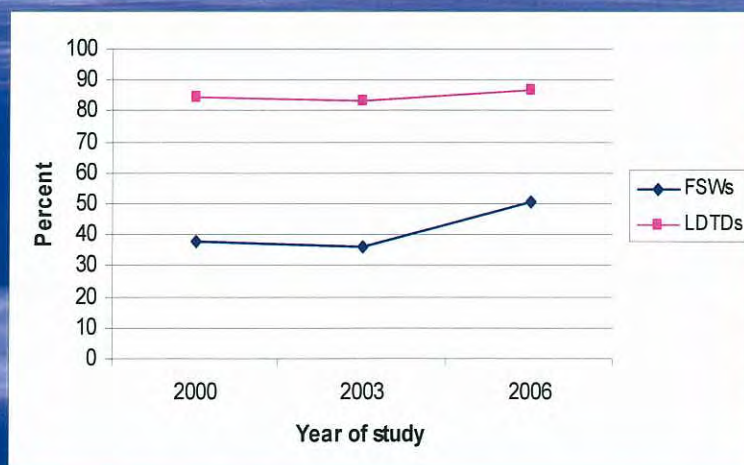
Sex with non-regular/non-sex worker has reduced statistically Significantly among LDTDs ($p < 0.001$)



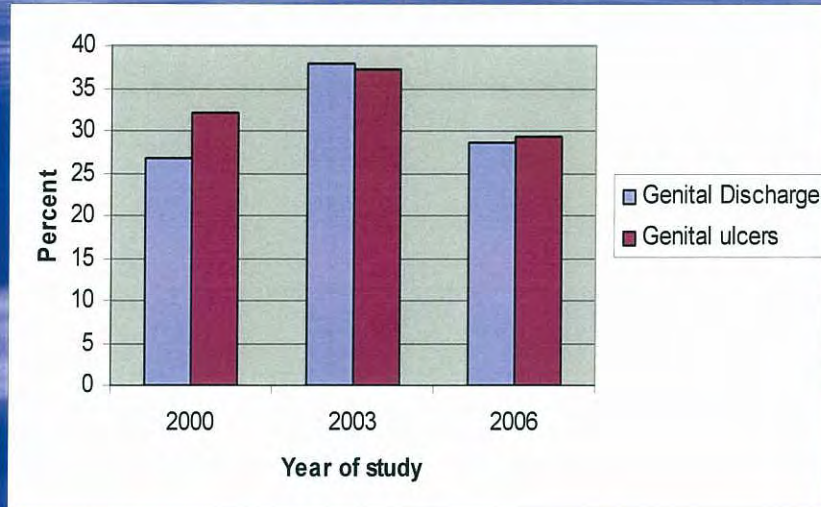
Statistically significant trend in condom use at last sex with a paying partner among FSWs was observed ($p < 0.001$)



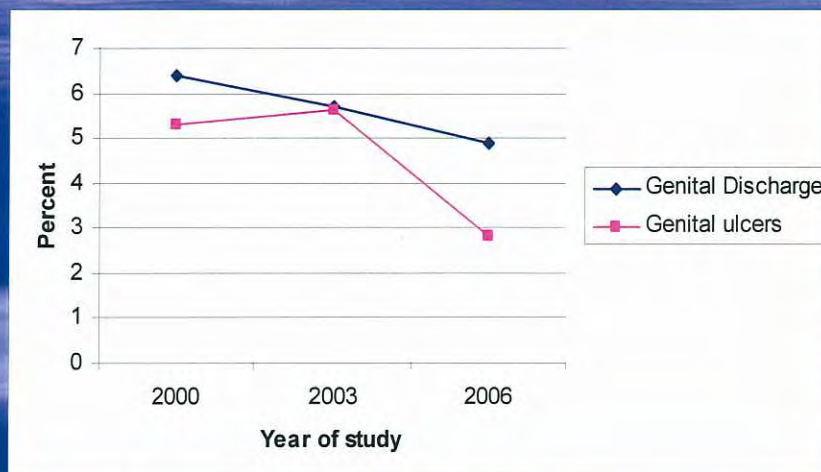
Consistent condom use in paying sex increased significantly ($p < 0.001$) for FSW last 30 days, but not among LDTDs last 12 months



Prevalence rates of STI symptoms among FSWs last 12 months remained stable



.... proportion of LDTDs reporting STIs declined ($p=0.017$)



Summary in trends among FSW

- Increase in:
 - alcohol consumption,
 - having condom on hand
 - condom use at last sex
 - consistent use with both paying and non-paying sexual partners
 - number undergoing VCT.
 - complete knowledge of HIV

Summary for LDTDs

- Reduction
 - Extramarital relationships
 - STIs especially genital ulcers

Proportion tested for HIV significantly reduced in LDTDs and increased in FSWs ($p < 0.001$)
