ADOPTING THE TEN-YEAR (2006-2015) COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR GENERAL TRIAS, CAVITE AS THE LEGAL BASIS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT, NATIONAL GOVERNMENT, NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS, PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS, PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS, AND INSTITUTIONS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ITS MUNICIPAL PROJECTS, PLANS AND PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE GOOD GOVERNANCE AND SUSTAINABLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND EFFECTIVE DELIVERY OF SOCIO-ECONOMIC SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of General Trias, Cavite firmed up for the preparation of the Comprehensive Land Use and Development Plan through a consultancy contract with URBIS Philippines, Inc.;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandated the Municipal Development Council (MDC) to formulate long-term, medium-term, and annual socio-economic development plans and policies (Art. 182; Sec. 3-d to 1);

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 72, Series of 1992 enacted by President Fidel V. Ramos pursuant to Local Government Code of 1991, requires the Municipal Development Council to update their respective Comprehensive Town Plan in conformity with the existing laws and policies of the provincial and national government;

WHEREAS, the consultant reaffirmed the compliance of the Revised Ten-Year (2006-2015) Comprehensive Land Use and Development Plan of General Trias, Cavite to the 2005-2010 Cavite Provincial Physical Framework Plan (PPFP); result of the 2004 Local Government Performance Management system of DILG; regional Development Plan (2004-2010);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan empowers by the Local Government Code 1991 Sec. 447 a-2 (VII) to adopt a Comprehensive Land Use Plan (2006-2015) for the municipality in consonance to the 2005-2015 Provincial Physical Framework Plan and Provincial Land Use Plan;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan supports the provision of open spaces for the future road right of way of Cavite-Laguna Express Way and East-West Road


Now therefore, on motion of SB Member Carlos S. Viniegra II duly seconded by all members present, be it


