



PWD NGO Workshop Results of 22 may 2006

Opinions, propositions, questions:


- Can we receive the materials from this and last meetings in the form of handouts?
- Pesentation is made quite well
- It is not possible to have meetings more often, than once in a month, but this is too seldom.
- What is JICAs goal?
- Is there an open competition for submitting resource center proposals from NGOs?
- Is creation of a union a necessary condition for creating a resource center?
- What progress in activities of ministry of labor and social protection was observed by JICA since the time of the forum in 2004?
- To organize regular meetings it is necessary to allocate a contact person (JICA) that would be responsible for informing all NGOs.
- At present there already are contacts between NGOs and cooperation in reaching common goals.
- It will be difficult to organize meetings regularly, because every organization has its own activities.
- It is illogical to unite NGOs and then to leave the making of project proposal to Ministry of labor and social protection.
- NGOs do not trust the government, and the project proposal should better be done from the third party.
- May be the resource center should be created on the base of NGOs with JICAs help.
- First we need to create the Union of PWD NGOs
- From the beginning it would be better if all interested NGOs could participate in meetings
- Need to define the priorities for uniting all the NGOs
- It is necessary to discuss the idea of a Union with all the interested parties, especially regional organizations
- If not possible to organize a republican forum, may be it would be feasible to meet for all organizations of Bishkek and use the results of social questionnaire, already completed by a lot of PWD in the regions
- For effective work with the government it is necessary to meet with officials no lower than prime minister or minister
- NGOs do not trust the corrupted governmental structures, the decisions that are made are not transparent
- May be it would be better to create a resource center, belonging to the Union of NGOs, which could then cooperate with the one that will be opened with Ministry of labor and social

protection

- It is difficult to meet regularly without creating an information center first
- Before creating a resource center may be to create information center?
- Inside the Union it is necessary to create an internal structure, Leaders committee, which would then decide on the direction of Unions further work and development
- It is necessary to research the opinions of the regional NGO and to create working group for organization of the Union with their participation
- It is necessary to meet with the prime-minister and to get him to sign a decree about implementing our propositions
- To organize a meeting between NGO's it is necessary to work out an action plan and our propositions, to make a list of representatives, who will take part in a meeting
- First of all it is necessary to work out program of actions that we could undertake to increase awareness, attracting public attention to PWD problems and information exchange between NGO's





- Management of Center should be participation of
 - a) disabled people as officers of the Center
 - b) equality of representation of the whole community of disabled people
 - c) a state official and a JICA expert can join management

Activities of the Center

- a) training for disabled (professional, political and computer/ language, communication and etc.) for social workers and state officials with invitation of foreign experts
- b) organizing IL training course in Bishkek and local cities inviting resource persons from Japan, Thailand, Pakistan or Philippines
- c) organizing accessibility activities in Bishkek and local cities (choosing pilot areas – ex> area of Tsumu department store, amusement park, Erkendic and so on)
- correcting information about international standards and law of accessibility
- round table meeting between disabled people and the architectural council, municipal officials in charge of city transportation, airport officials and so on
- d) information dissemination (newsletter, leaflets, press-releases, special public campaigns, web-site and etc.)
- e) lobbying activities (public hearings and discussions of legislation, participation in sessions of state bodies related to the disabled people and etc., legal expertise and monitoring of implementation of the legislation and planned measures on support of disabled people, and etc.)
- f) public awareness and social integration (movies on disabled, articles, special events aimed at integration of the disabled people, exhibitions and etc.)
- g) problem solving round tables and meetings (state-disabled, disabled-disabled, disabled-civil society, disabled-international community and etc.)
- h) monitoring of problems of disabled people (annual monitoring, dissemination among donors, state authorities and etc.)
- i) connections with international communities of disabled people (organization of or participation in international forums, conferences and etc.)
- j) (Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and other countries)

Responsibility of JICA

- a) Long term expert - 1
- b) Short term expert - 6 (3 persons/a year, 2 weeks /a person)
- c) Equipment - Several personal computers and peripheral equipments, a fax and copy machines
- d) Expenditures for national and international training courses
- e) Expenditures for initiating contact and visiting to Central Asia (Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and other countries)

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



すきまとは

例えば、問題解決能力、適応的行動、自信のあること、好きなこと、他者への関心、できる作業などです。





これを探すのは、簡単そうで意外と難しい視点です。私たちは、「問題点」を探してそれにアプローチすること先行、アプローチは問題点を改善することはかりでなく、対象者の持っている本質の力(水が流れる力)を利用して、健康な状態を作ることが重要なことです。

介護士とUCWは、全体の状況を見ながらこの隙間をうまく利用し、対象者の川全体が流れやすくなるように働きかけます。





- ◆ モデルにした他者を通して、自分の気持ち・現状・具体的な問題点等を明確にする事ができ、整理しやすく、今後の対策を立案する良い手助けになると感じた。
- ◆ 今回、たまたまモデルを皆さんの前で書かせていただいて、様々な人からの意見を聞くことができたこともあり、大変面白かった。また、川モデルを使う前は、大した問題と思っていなかった事や、問題点の関係性を、絵に表すことにより、直感的に理解する事ができた。

ケンジさんの感想

- ◆ 赴任後1年目のころ、C/Pの関係を考えると眠れないことがあり、何か方法はないか考えていた。そのとき、「川」を描くことを知っていたら、違っていたかもしれない。
- ◆ C/Pの成長を改めて確認できた。
- ◆ 川を描いてみて、自分のJOCVとしての活動によるC/Pへの効果が整理され、確認できた。



- ・ 実際、当日に私は川モデルを書いたのですが、なかなかまとまらず、とりあえず「いつまでに絵にしたらいいかな?」ということで、文章の苦手な私には取組みやすい課題でした。
- ・ 活動を始めて1年がすぎ、さて、これからというときに、自分の中でまとめができるよかったです。
- ・ できれば、もっと前にやりたかったですね。
- ・ 各地域、そこで働く同僚達は、それぞれ違うだろうけれど、根本的な問題やこの国のシステムなどは共通していると思うし、そこをとっかきりにしたらいいか、いろんなヒントを報告書などを参考にしてきましたが、川モデルのようなものがあれば、一目瞭然だったんだろうなと思います。
- ・ 日々の活動において、当然重要なもままたなししい「衝撃感」がまったく違ったりします。本当に何が問題で、自分にできること何か、うまくまとまらず考えが常々めぐらしてしまうことがあるので、問題にぶつかったときに、その因果関係を見直すことで、自分自身気持ちに整理がつくから、不審なものに執着するより、何ができるかという可能性を考えながらの活動を考えた方が自分も楽しむと思うから。
