AKIRA NISHIMURA Leader JICA Study Team Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Japan International Cooperation Agency Study Team for "The Study for Establishment of State Base Maps for GIS in the Republic of Macedonia" (hereinafter referred to as "JICA Study Team"), and State Authority for Geodetic Works (hereinafter referred to as "SAGW") held a meeting concerning the Inception Report of "The Study for Establishment of State Base Maps for GIS in the Republic of Macedonia" on the 2nd day of April 2004, from 9:00 to 10:45 at a meeting room of SAGW office.

JICA Study Team explained about the followings based on the Inception Report.

- a) The objectives of the Study.
- b) The Basic policies of the Study.
- c) The Implementation method of the Study.
- d) The Results of the Study.
- e) The schedule of the Study.

JICA Study Team answered the questions raised by SAGW as follows.

- 1. Q) Will the work for aerial triangulation be carried out in Macedonia?
 - A) It will also be done in Macedonia as a part of transfer technology, although the actual work will be executed in Japan by JICA Study Team.
- Q) What kind of software for aerial triangulation will JICA Study Team use?
 A) "Image station software" will be used for aerial triangulation.
- 3. Q) Tell us about the concept and method of "pricking".
 - A) (They were explained by JICA Study Team.)
- 4. Q) Dose SAGW has an opportunity to be trained for GPS survey?A) Training for GPS observation will be done in Macedonia prior to the GPS survey.
- 5. Q) How many parties will be required for GPS survey?
 - A) JICA study team requests SAGW to organize 6 parties and 2 experts shall supervise those parties.
- 6. Q) How many SAGW staff will be necessary for technology transfer on digital photogrammetry and GIS?
 - A) The specific number of the staff will be fixed after further discussion with SAGW considering the number of equipment which will be brought by JICA.
- 7. Q) When will JICA Study Team commence the technology transfer for digital plotting and compilation for production of 7 map sheets mentioned on Scope of work?.
 - A) It will start at the beginning of October, 2004.

The conclusions of the discussions were as follows:

1. In principle SAGW agreed on the Inception Report prepared by JICA Study Team.

- 2. SAGW requested the followings to JICA Study Team:
- (1) Transfer technology for digitization of aerial films by film scanner shall be executed.
- (2) Counterpart personnel shall take opportunities of training course in Japan in the field of personnel/organization management, changing of the reference ellipsoid and cartography.

(3) Required equipment for technical transfer shall be provided to SAGW just after each technology transfer in Macedonia, not after completion of the study.

AKIRA NISHIMURA Leader JICA Study Team Japan International Cooperation Agency The Japan International Cooperation Agency Study Team for "The Study for Establishment of State Base Maps for GIS in the Republic of Macedonia" (hereinafter referred to as the "JICA Study Team"), and the State Authority for Geodetic Works (hereinafter referred to as "SAGW") held a meeting on October 18, 2004.

The contents and result of the meeting were as follow:

The Study for Establishment of State Base Maps for GIS in the Republic of Macedonia is being conducted by the JICA Study Team as technical cooperation between the Macedonian and Japanese Governments.

The production of 89 out of 205 map sheets in Macedonia shall be done at a scale of 1:25,000 in digital format (Spatial Data Infrastructure) as well as technical transfer for field survey and digital photogrammetry work.

It is realized that the Project on Environmental Conservation in Ohrid Lake supported by the World Bank requires a multi-purpose Geographic Information System (GIS). Construction of a 1:25,000 digital geographic database and the GIS are urgently needed.

SAGW intends to contribute the database for the World Bank Project in Ohrid. However, some parts are not covered by the JICA Project. Accordingly, SAGW would like to make a request for the following additional works.

- 1. Consulting services for the construction of multi-purpose GIS database
- 2. Establishment of GIS database covering the Ohrid Lake watershed area only in Macedonian territory.

(Quantity of the additional works) Additional area for establishment of spatial data infrastructure Area for production of land use and environment database Map printing

2144.91km²(16sheets) 3,555.88km² (30sheets) 16sheets (500 sets) (see attached figures)

In addition, SAGW is certain that the dissemination of maps to the public and map users, e.g. governmental organizations, is indispensable for making them understand the importance of maps and making the most of the newly developed geographic information. Therefore, SAGW would highly appreciate it if JICA would accept the following works on map dissemination;

3. Assistance in an event for environmental maps made by primary school students in an area of

Macedonia

4. Preparation of a plan for the promotion of maps to the public and map users (The promotion activities shall be implemented in Japan fiscal year 2005 according to the plan.)






