



UNCRD AFRICA OFFICE WAS





- THE FOCUS OF THE COURSE IS ON TOT




THIS YEAR'S TRAINING COURSE (11TH ATC)

- WAS ORGANIZED BY UNCRD AFRICA OFFICE, IN COLLABORATION WITH AICAD/JICA AND UNDP KENYA; AND
- 29 PARTICIPANTS FROM 12 AFRICAN COUNTRIES (Botswana, Ethiopia, Gambia, Ghana, Kenya, Namibia, Nigeria, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia & Zimbabwe) ATTENDED THE TRAINING COURSE.



- NAIROBI CITY COUNCIL.



Through In-Country Training by Country



THE ADVANTAGES OF IN-COUNTRY TRAINING PROGRAMMES


- MANY REGIONAL PLANNERS CAN BE TRAINED AT THE SAME TIME;
