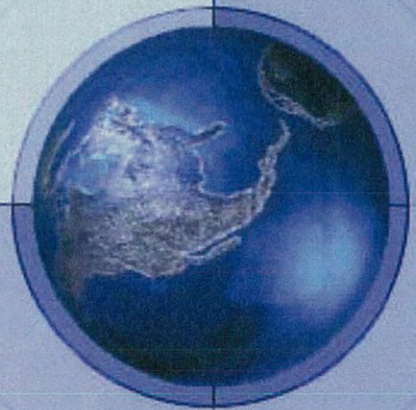

OBJECTIVES

I. Environmental Aspect

- 1) To avoid further environmental destruction***
- 2) To restore the hydrological function of peatland, particularly peatdomes***
- 3) To rehabilitate the conservation function of peatland and peatswamp forest***

II. Community Aspect

- 1) To fulfill basic rights of the community, especially transmigrant (local and migrant)***
- 2) To empower local economy through wise use of peatland***

III. Planning Aspect

- 1) To take into action endorsement of Mr. President during his visit to Central Kalimantan on August 31, 2006.***
- 2) To create mechanism of financial support for integrated action plan in the long run***

STRATEGY

- 1. Legal Basis for immediate action: Presidential Instruction bundled with Integrated Action Plan as the attachment**
- 2. Stakeholders agreement on spatial zonation as the first step towards rehabilitation and revitalitation**
- 3. Comprehensive Design based on scientific review and legally bonded**
- 4. Continuity of financial support from domestic and foreign source**
- 5. Commitment of all party**
- 6. In the longterm, legal status as "special area" according to Law 32/2004 on Regional Government.**
- 7. Defining special treatment (exception, insertion, regulation, management) if necessary to accelerate the momentum of rehabilitation efforts**

LESSONS AND MESSAGES FROM EX MRP

- 1. Hydro function of peatdomes is vital, should not be disturbed and should be the first priority for restoration**
- 2. Rehabilitation and revitalization policy is not intended to reestablish the MRP project. Ie. Paddy field area has been indicated for less than 200.000 Ha, suitability, viability and feasibility is the foundation for zonation while around 900.000 Ha area has been indicated for conservation purposes.**
- 3. Sequestration and avoidance of carbon scheme is needed to strengthen the rehabilitation and restoration action through international financial support**
- 4. Researchs, ideas, development of financial support schemes for conservation of tropical peatland forest of Central Kalimantan (ex MRP) IS WELCOME**
