The Japan International Cooperation Agency – JICA, the JICA Alumni Association of São Paulo – ABJICA-SP and the Municipal Secretariat of Planning – SEMPLA, through the urban planners Daniel Todtmann Montandon and Felipe Francisco de Souza, firmed an agreement for the elaboration of a publication named "Land Readjustment and Joint Urban Operations".

This publication is part of the technical cooperation accord between the City Hall of São Paulo and the Japan International Cooperation Agency – JICA. Such accord was initiated in 2005, with the participation of the two urban planners of SEMPLA in the course "Urban Development (focused on Land Readjustment Measure)", carried through May until July of 2005 in the cities of Tokyo, Kyoto, Hiroshima and Nagoya in Japan.

The main objective of this publication is to debate the ideas of the Japanese method of Land Readjustment and to analyze the concepts, methods, techniques and results gotten in the international context of application of this instrument and how it can contribute in the improvement of the practice of urban planning in São Paulo, more specifically in the policy of urban development through urban interventions.

The release of the publication was made in March of 2007 and will be distributed gratuitously for all the agencies (in the municipal, state and federal instances) related to the urban planning, main universities of Brazil and some selected institutions inside Japan. This distribution is part of the action plan established, transferring the knowledge and technology in the technical cooperation role in the disciplines related to urban planning.
